SHIRE OF MILDURA

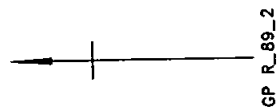

SHIRE OF MILDURA

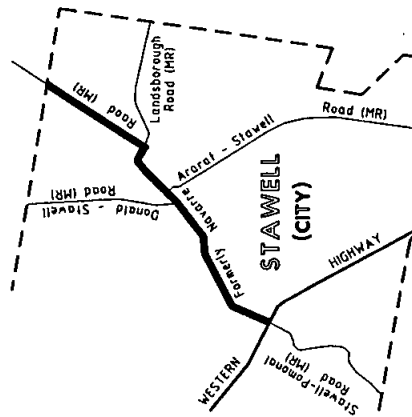

(ii) courses which a university named in Schedule 1 of the *Post-Secondary Education Act 1978* to which the College is declared to be affiliated under section 39 of that Act certifies to be comparable in standard to courses of study leading to the award of, as the case may be, degrees or diplomas at universities.

(ab) offer courses of study undertaken by research leading to post-graduate degrees and confer such degrees subject to section 38 of the *Post-Secondary Education Act 1978* and such conditions as are specified in Orders in Council made under section 38 (2) of that Act."

(b) after paragraph (s) insert:

"(t) make an appointment styled as Professional, if—

(a) at the time the appointment is made, a regulation under section 39 of the *Post-Secondary Education Act 1978* is in force declaring the College to be affiliated to a university named in Schedule 1 of that Act; and

(b) the appointment is endorsed as approved by the Council of that university.

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(u) from time to time enter into an agreement with the governing body of any university or other post-secondary education institution under which that university or institution and the College will become affiliated to each other and make such arrangements and do all such things which are necessary or convenient to be made or done to give effect to the terms of any such affiliation agreement."
