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PROCLAMATIONS

Drugs, Poisons and Controlled Substances Act 1981

PROCLAMATION

I, J. Davis McCaughey, Governor of Victoria, acting with the advice of the Executive Council, make the following Proclamation:

(1) This Proclamation is made under section 12 (2) of the *Drugs, Poisons and Controlled Substances Act 1981*.

(2) The objective of this Proclamation is to further restrict the availability of BENZODIAZEPINES by scheduling such substances a drugs of dependence.

(3) Part 1 of Schedule Eleven to the *Drugs, Poisons and Controlled Substances Act 1981* is amended as follows:

- (a) by adding the following items respectively to column 1 and column 3 immediately before the item relating to AMPHETAMINE:
"ALPRAZOLAM 0-5"; and
- (b) by adding the following items respectively to column 1 and column 3 immediately before the item relating to BENZOXAZOCINES:
"1, 4-BENZODIAZEPINES not included elsewhere in this Part 10-0"; and
- (c) by adding the following items respectively to column 1 and column 3 immediately before the item relating to 4-BROMO-2, 5-DIMETHOXYAMPHETAMINE:
"BROMAZEPAM 3-0"; and
- (d) by adding the following items respectively to column 1 and column 3 immediately before the item relating to 1-CHLORO-1-PHENYL-2-AMINOPROPANE:
"CHLORDIAZEPOXIDE 5-0"; and
- (e) by adding the following items respectively to column 1 and column 3 immediately after the item relating to 1-CHLORO-1-PHENYL-2-METHYLAMINO-PROPANE:
"CLOBAZAM 5-0"; and
- (f) by adding the following items respectively to column 1 and column 3 immediately before the item relating to CLONITAZENE:
"CLONAZEPAM 2-5"; and
- (g) by adding the following items respectively to column 1 and column 3 immediately before the item relating to DIETHYLPROPION:
"DIAZEPAM 2-0"; and
- (h) by adding the following items respectively to column 1 and column 3 immediately after the item relating to FENTANYL:
"FLUNITRAZEPAM 0-5"; and
- (i) by adding the following items respectively to column 1 and column 3 immediately before the item relating to N-FORMYLAMPHETAMINE:
"FLURAZEPAM 3-0"; and
- (j) by adding the following items respectively to column 1 and column 3 immediately before the item relating to LYSERGAMIDE:
"LORAZEPAM 0-5"; and
- (k) by adding the following items respectively to column 1 and column 3 immediately after the item relating to NICOMORPHINE:
"NITRAZEPAM 1-0"; and
- (l) by adding the following items respectively to column 1 and column 3 immediately before the item relating to NORACYLMETHADOL:
"7-NITRO-1, 4-BENZODIAZEPINES not included elsewhere in this Part 2-5"; and
- (m) by adding the following items respectively to column 1 and column 3 immediately before the item relating to OXYCODONE:
"OXAZEPAM 10-0"; and

(n) by adding the following items respectively to column 1 and column 3 immediately before the item relating to THEBACON:

"TEMAZEPAM

3-0".

RULES OF THE COUNCIL OF LEGAL EDUCATION (AMENDMENT No. 1) 1990

In pursuance of the authority in this behalf conferred upon the Council of Legal Education by the *Legal Profession Practice Act 1958*, the Council makes the following Rules:

1. These Rules may be cited as the "Rules of the Council of Legal Education (Amendment No. 1) 1990".
2. In these Rules the *Rules of the Council of Legal Education 1985 are called "the Principal Rules".
3. Rule 44 (2) of the Principal Rules is repealed and the following substituted:

Schedule H

- (2) (a) Every Interstate practitioner who pursuant to Rule 46 (1) has elected to appear in person in Court shall also one month (or such lesser time as in any particular case the Board may determine) before the first day of the said sittings make and file with the Secretary of the Board an affidavit of qualification in the form prescribed by these Rules so far as applicable to his case.

- (c) Every Overseas practitioner shall also one month (or such lesser time as in any particular case the Board may determine) before the first day of the said sittings make and file with the Secretary of the Board an affidavit of qualification in the form prescribed by these Rules so far as applicable to his case.

4. Rule 46 of the Principal Rules is repealed and the following substituted:

Appearance in Court

- (1) Subject to Rule 46 (2), every person applying to be admitted shall appear in person in Court.
- (2) An Interstate practitioner applying to be admitted may in giving the notice prescribed pursuant to Rule 44 (1) (c) elect not to appear in person in Court.
- (3) Every Interstate practitioner electing not to appear in person in Court shall take the oaths required by section 5 (2) of the *Legal Profession Practice Act 1958* before the principal registrar of the Supreme Court of another State or of a Territory or before such other officer of such Court as may be designated by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Victoria.
- (4) The Certificate of the Board or the Order of the Court on which every person applying to be admitted relies shall be produced to the Court.
- (5) Except by leave of the Court, no motion for admission shall be made except on the first day of the sittings.

5. Schedule C of the Principal Rules is repealed and the following substituted:

**ROAD SAFETY (VEHICLES)
REGULATIONS 1988**

Approval of Certain Side Projections

I, David O'Sullivan, delegate of the Roads Corporation, under regulation 807 of the Regulations, give approval for a vehicle carrying agricultural products or an indivisible load to be used on a highway with the load projecting more than 15 centimetres laterally beyond the extreme outer portion of either side of the vehicle if the width of the vehicle lawfully exceeds the limit of 2.5 metres specified in regulation 714 of the Regulations in accordance with a permit issued under regulation 720 or 724 of the Regulations.

In this approval—

“agricultural products” means products of agriculture that cannot be packed with reasonable convenience or economy so as to be carried on a vehicle that complies with the dimension limits prescribed in regulation 714 of the Regulations;

“indivisible load” means a load that cannot reasonably be divided into two or more items for road transport and cannot be carried on an appropriate vehicle that complies with the dimension limits prescribed in regulation 714 of the Regulations;

“The Regulations” means the Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 1988.

REGULATIONS FOR THE CARE,
 PROTECTION AND MANAGEMENT OF
 THE KALINDA URBAN BUSHLAND
 RESERVE

I, Steven Marshall Crabb, Minister for Conservation and Environment in and for the State of Victoria, do hereby make the following Regulations:

Title

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Kalinda Urban Bushland Reserve Regulations 1990.

Commencement

2. These Regulations come into operation on 14 November 1990.

Authority

3. These Regulations are made under the powers in section 13 (1) (b) of the *Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978*.

Definitions

4. For the purposes of these Regulations—

"Reserve" means the Crown Land in the Parish of Warrandyte temporarily reserved for Public Purposes (Urban Bushland) by Order in Council of 16 March 1988 and notice in the *Government Gazette* of 23 March 1988, together with the land in the said parish deemed to be reserved for the mentioned purposes as shown hatched on plan marked "K/21.2.90" attached to Department of Conservation and Environment correspondence No. Rs 13715.

"Committee" means the Council of City of Ringwood appointed as Committee of Management under section 14 (2) of the *Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978* with full power and authority to enforce these Regulations.

Regulations

5. The Reserve shall be open to the public from sunrise to sunset, free of charge.

6. No person shall—

- (a) enter or remain in the Reserve who may offend against decency as regards dress, language or conduct or who may behave in a disorderly, unseemly or offensive manner, or create or take part in any disturbance;
- (b) carry, use or discharge any firearm, air rifle or any other weapon in the Reserve;
- (c) interfere with, mark, deface or damage any buildings, gates, fences, barriers, seats, signs or any other improvement in the Reserve;

- (d) leave or deposit any glass bottle, tin, can, waste paper, refuse or any other rubbish except in receptacles provided for the purpose in the Reserve;
 - (e) sell or offer to sell or hire any article or commodity while in the reserve or from any building therein;
 - (f) cause, suffer or permit any dog belonging to him or her or in his or her charge to enter or remain in the Reserve unless such dog is at all times controlled by a chain, cord or leash;
 - (g) enter or remain in the Reserve while in a state of intoxication;
 - (h) disturb, interfere with or destroy any native animal, or bird or its lair or nest in the Reserve;
 - (i) pick, remove, destroy or otherwise interfere with or damage or have in his or her possession any wildflower, plant, shrub, tree or other vegetation found in the Reserve;
 - (j) remove any soil or other material from the Reserve;
 - (k) act in any manner on the Reserve which would render that person liable to prosecution under the Summary Offences Act.
7. No person shall, without consent in writing of the Committee—
- (a) light or cause to be lit any fire in the Reserve except in any properly constructed fireplace provided for that purpose;
 - (b) organise or take part in any public entertainment or any organised game or sport in the Reserve;
 - (c) drive any vehicle within the Reserve;
 - (d) put or allow to remain in the Reserve any sheep, horses or other animals except as hereinbefore provided;
 - (e) camp nor erect or place any building, tent, caravan, booth or other structure in the Reserve.
8. Nothing in these Regulations shall operate to prevent or restrict any servants, agents, representatives or employees of the Committee in the proper execution of their duty or work in the Reserve.

Penalties

9. Every person infringing these Regulations in any respect shall be liable to expulsion from the Reserve in addition to the penalties prescribed in section 13 of the *Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978*.

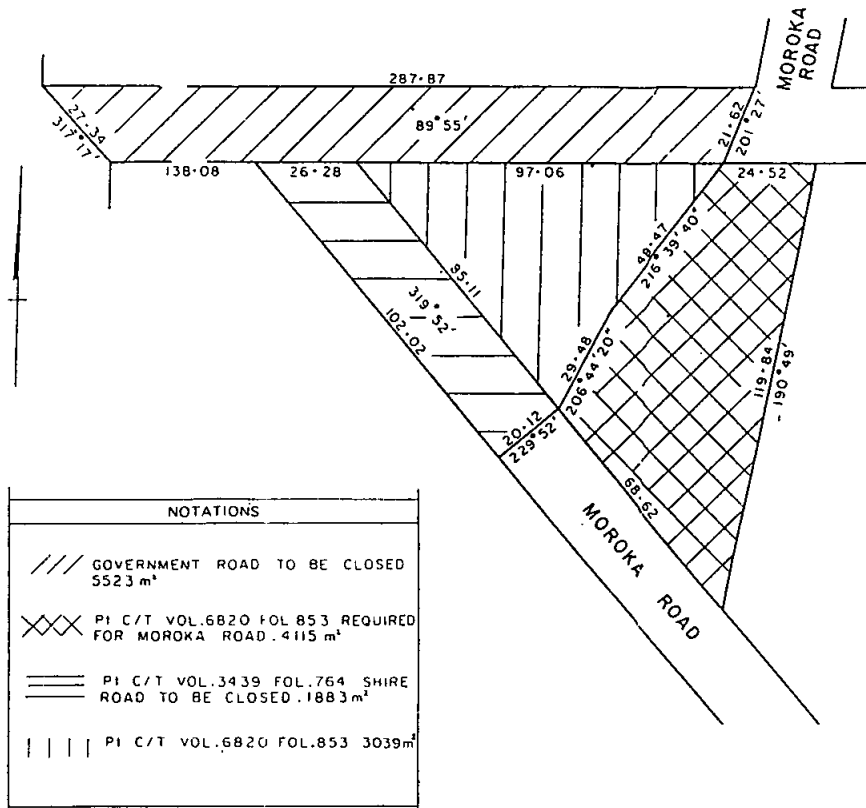

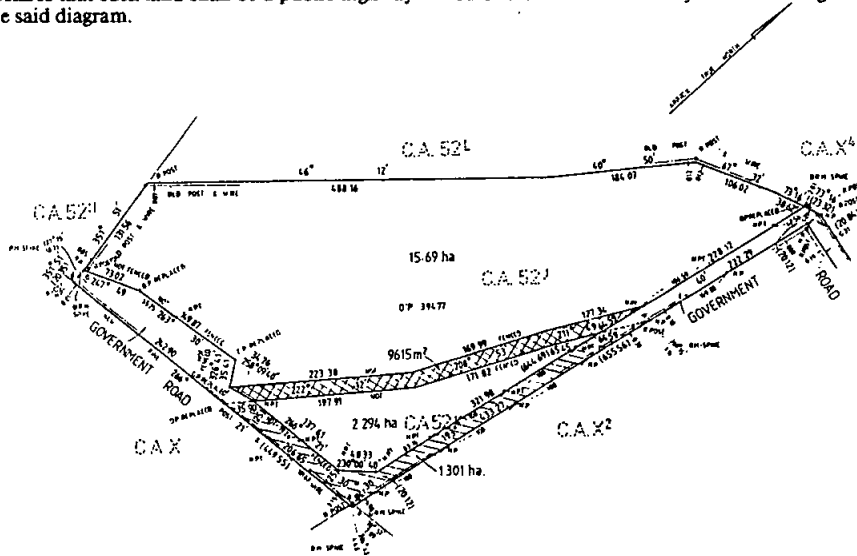

2. The increased district so formed is known as the Tarwin River Management District.

4. The Tarwin River Management District is under the jurisdiction and control of the Tarwin River Management Board.

The Tarwin River Management Board is comprised of twelve (12) Commissioners and of those two (2) shall be elected by the Council of the Shire of Woorayl and one (1) each shall be elected by the Councils of the Shires of Korumburra, South Gippsland, Mirboo, Narracan, Warragul and Morwell and four (4) shall be appointed by the Minister for Conservation and Environment.

6. The Commissioners of the Tarwin River Improvement Trust continue in office until 14 December 1990 and then shall be replaced by the Commissioners elected and appointed to the Tarwin River Management Board as stipulated in paragraph 5 of this Order.

7. The Tarwin River Management Board is the successor in law of the Tarwin River Improvement Trust and all property, powers, rights, liabilities and obligations of and all matters and things (not otherwise provided for) made or done by or on behalf of the Tarwin River Improvement Trust in respect of its District so extended vest in and attach to and are deemed to have been made or done by or on behalf of the Tarwin River Management Board.

Further, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council as provided by section 42 of the *River Improvement Act 1958* specifies that the principal moneys owing on overdraft of the Tarwin River Management Board do not exceed forty thousand dollars (\$40 000).
