Planning and Environment Act 1987 GEELONG REGIONAL PLANNING SCHEME

Notice of Approval of Amendment Amendment R26, Part 1A

The Minister for Planning and Environment has approved Amendment R26, Part 1A to the Geelong Regional Planning Scheme.

The amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the *Government Gazette*.

The amendment:

- 1. clarifies the operation and intent of the heritage controls,
 - 2. corrects spelling mistakes in the ordinance,
- 3. rezones an existing Geelong and District Water Board depot in Carr Street, South Geelong from Residential A to Public Purposes (Existing)—4—Waterworks and Sewerage Trusts/Authorities,
- 4. rezones a residential lot in Corinella Street, Bell Post Hill, from Public Open Space (Existing)—B—Public Park, to Residential A Zone. This small, undeveloped area is no longer needed for parkland, as developed parkland nearby satisfies local open space requirements.

A copy of the amendment can be inspected, free of charge, during office hours at the offices of the Geelong Regional Commission, Fifth Floor,




