DECLARATION OF PROHIBITED PERIOD

In pursuance of the powers conferred by section 3 sub-section (2) of the *Forests Act 1958*, I, Rod Incoll, delegated officer for Her Majesty's Minister for Conservation and Environment in the State of Victoria, hereby declare the Prohibited Period in respect to the fire protected areas (other than State Forest, National Park and Protected Public Land) within the municipality nominated in the schedule hereunder:

Schedule 1

The Prohibited Period shall commence at 0100 hours on Monday, 16 December 1991 and end at 0100 hours on Friday, 1 May 1992 (unless varied) in the following municipality:

BUNURONG SANCTUARY ZONE
MARINE RESERVE PROCLAMATION AND
RULES

Notice of Decision

I, Steven Marshall Crabb, Minister for Conservation and Environment, hereby give notice as follows:

In January and February this year three Regulatory Impact Statements were released to the public for comment in relation to a proposed proclamation and rules to be made under section

79A of the *Fisheries Act 1968* to apply to an area to be known as the Bunurong Marine Park.

Public comments were invited on the Regulatory Impact Statements. Twenty-eight submissions were received and have been considered as required by the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1962*.

Having considered the comments made and having taken into account other circumstances, I have decided that the proclamation and rules under section 79A of the *Fisheries Act 1968* should be made with the following modifications:

1. The proclamation and the rules forming part of the proclamation are restricted in application to the area known as the Sanctuary Zone and as a consequence the name of the proclamation and rules has changed from Bunurong Marine Park to Bunurong Sanctuary Zone Marine Reserve.

2. The taking of flora from the Sanctuary Zone is now included in the rules and not as stated in documentation released for public comment by order under the *Flora and Fauna Guarantee Act 1988*.

3. The application of rules to the Eastern and Western Conservation Zones has been deferred pending further review of section 79A of the *Fisheries Act 1968*.

4. Other minor amendments required to be made as a consequence of the decisions above.

No additional restrictions in relation to the area have been added to the proposed rules.
