MINISTERIAL DIRECTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 307

Transfer of Land, Easements, Works, Property, Powers, Rights, Liabilities, Obligations and Officers and Employees with respect to the Koo-Wee-Rup Flood Protection District from the Rural Water Commission of Victoria to the Dandenong Valley and Westernport Authority

Whereas under the provisions of Schedule 5 of the Water Act 1989 the Koo-Wee-Rup Flood Protection District will form part of the District of the Dandenong Valley and Westernport Authority as on and from 1 November 1990.

And whereas under the provisions of section 307 of the Water Act 1989 I am empowered to make the following directions. Now therefore I, Steven Marshall Crabb, Minister for Conservation and Environment direct the Rural Water Commission of Victoria (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission") to transfer to the Dandenong Valley and Westernport Authority (hereinaster referred to as "the Authority") all land, easements, works, property, powers, rights, liabilities, obligations and officers and employees with respect to the Koo-Wee-Rup Flood Protection District.

Now therefore I, Stephen Marshall Crabb. Minister for Conservation and Environment direct that:

- 1. There shall be transferred from the Commission to the Authority as on and from 1 November 1990 (hereinafter referred to as "the operative date")-
 - (i) all rights and liabilities in those lands or easements owned by, vested in or existing in favour of the Commission including any lands or easements in the process of being acquired as at the operative date which are used or intended to be used by the Commission for the purpose of providing a flood protection service to the Koo-Wee-Rup area;
 - (ii) all claims in tort, contract, Workers Compensation and Workcare relating to the transfer of land, easements, works and assets, property, powers, rights, liabilities and obligations from the Commission to the Authority except any responsibility arising out of negligence on the part of the Commission as it relates to flooding which occurred within the Koo-Wee-Rup Flood Protection District on 11 and 12 October
- (iii) all powers, obligations and rights of the Commission in relation to the provision by it of a flood protection service to the Koo-Wee-Rup area;

- (iv) the ownership of the flood protection works hereinbefore described:
- (v) the officers and employees of the Commission whose names are set forth hereunder shall cease to be officers and employees of the Commission and shall become officers and employees of the Authority.
