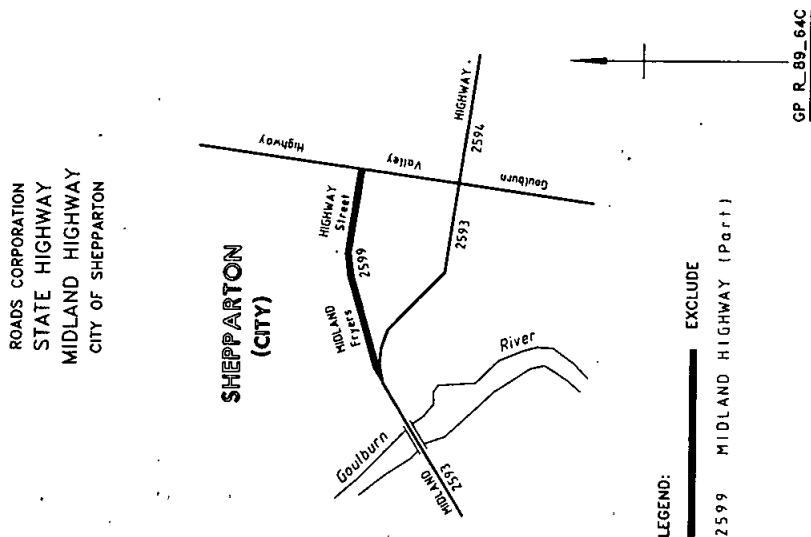

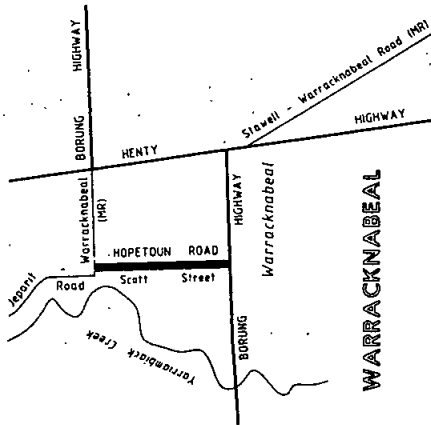

SHIRE OF WARRACKNABEAL



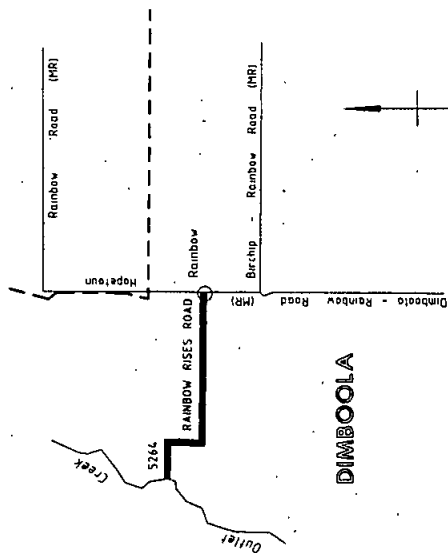
