STATE REVENUE OFFICE Stamps Regulations 1992

In accordance with the provisions of the Subordinate Legislation Act 1962 notice is given of the proposal to make regulations under sections 16, 130 and 167 of the Stamps Acts 1958 and section 18 of the Cattle Compensation Act 1967 and section 18 of the Swine Compensation Act 1967 to be known as the Stamps Regulations 1992.

A Regulatory Impact Statement has been prepared as required by the Subordinate Legislation Act.

The objectives of the proposed regulation are to ensure the assessment of stamp duty in the most efficient and equitable manner and more specifically:

prescribe the means by which stamp duty or other fees may be paid and the manner of denoting or impressing duty paid upon instruments; and

the means by which persons may apply for registration under the various provisions of the Act; and

the form and content of various applications, returns, statements or declarations required under the various provisions of the Act.

The Regulatory Impact Statement concludes that the proposed regulations provide the most effective and efficient means of achieving these objectives.
