Notice of Approval of Amendment
Amendment L15

The Minister for Planning and Housing has approved Amendment L15 to the Eltham Planning Scheme.

The amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the *Government Gazette*.

The amendment makes the use *Major Utility Installation* prohibited in the Landscape Interest C Zone.

However, these changes have not altered the key provisions of the regulations that were the subject of the Regulatory Impact Statement.
