FITZROY PLANNING SCHEME
Notice of Approval of Amendment
Amendment L25

The Minister for Planning and Housing has approved Amendment L25 to the Local Section of the Fitzroy Planning Scheme.

The amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the *Government Gazette*.

The amendment allows redevelopment of part of the St. Vincent's Hospital site in Fitzroy without a permit provided the development is in accordance with certain plans referred to in the amendment. The plans include provision for a 12 level hospital building, an energy services building and a new laneway between Alma Street and Nicholson Street.
