



EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The Department of Employment and Training is seeking a retrospective Administrative Arrangements Order to reconstrue references to the Executive Director, Occupational Training Board to references to the Executive Director, Occupational Training Bureau from 1 July 1991 to 25 February 1992, inclusive, and then as references to the Executive Director, Vocational Training Bureau with effect on and from 26 February 1992.

In 1990 the Vocational Education and Training Act was made and the *Industrial Training Act* 1975 was repealed, thus abolishing the Industrial Relations Commission. The position of President of the Industrial Training Commission was subsumed into the newly established State Training Board, renamed Executive Director, Occupational Training Bureau and became a prescribed office under the Public Service Act.

The Order in Council making the position of Executive Director a prescribed office was incorrectly titled Executive Director, Occupational Training Board. This error was not detected until now when arrangements were being made to rename the office, Executive Director, Vocational Training Bureau.

The error needs to be rectified by a retrospective Administrative Arrangements Order because powers delegated to the Executive Director under the *Vocational Education and Training Act* 1990 relating to the vocational training of apprentices may be jeopardised by the defect.

The Administrative Arrangements Act 1983 makes provision under section 5 (1) (b) (i) to make retrospective Administrative Arrangements Orders.


