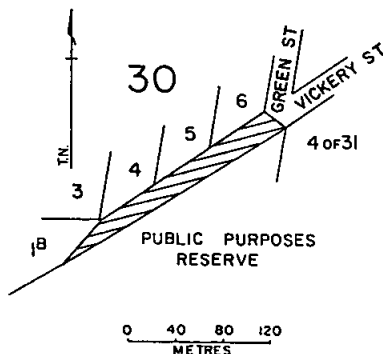

conditions and standards within caravan parks
and in particular—

the development of standards for facilities
and services that ensure the health and safety
of caravan park users;

the development of consistent planning
standards to be applied by councils;

codification of construction and installation
standards for movable dwellings located in
caravan parks.

A Regulatory Impact Statement which sets out
the costs and benefits associated with the
introduction of the proposed Regulations has
been prepared. The statement is inconclusive in
its outcome because on the data available, it has
not been possible to state with certainty that the
nett benefits to the community outweigh the nett
