COBURG CITY COUNCIL

Local Law No. 8

Street Traders and Collectors

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Coburg made a Local Law for the following purposes:

- (a) To regulate the use of streets and public places by persons dealing in goods;
- (b) To regulate the practice of soliciting and collecting of gifts of money or subscriptions; and
- (c) To repeal By-Law Nos 106 and 129.

The general purport of Local Law No. 8 is as follows:

1. To regulate persons who deal in goods in or within any street, vacant land, land which they do not ordinarily occupy or public place by requiring a permit to be obtained, and by exempting from the need to obtain a permit, persons who sell periodicals (or offer periodicals for sale) or who deal in goods because of a permit issued under an Act or another Local Law.

2. To regulate persons who deal in goods with the authority of a permit issued under the *Hawkers and Pedlars Act 1958*, by prohibiting them from dealing in goods other than on a Monday-Saturday (inclusive) between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m.

3. To regulate the selling (or offering from sale) of raffle tickets or soliciting or collecting of gifts of money or subscriptions in streets or from residence to residence by requiring a permit to be obtained.

4. To provide for offences if a person contravenes or fails to comply with the Local Law.

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Local Law No. 10
Development Control (Siting)

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Coburg made a Local Law for the following purpose:

1. To prescribe minimum requirements applying to—
 - (a) an allotment; and
 - (b) the siting of any Class 1, 2 or 10 building on an allotment; and
2. To revoke By-Law Nos 69, 112 and 127.

The general purport of Local Law No. 10 is as follows:

1. To adopt Column 3 of Table 11.6 to the Victoria Building Regulations 1983 as expressing the minimum siting requirements applying to an allotment and the siting of any Class 1, 2 and 10 building on an allotment.
2. To vary Table 11.6 by imposing a minimum setback from frontage of six metres for any Class 1, 2 or 10 building.

Local Law No. 12
Regulation of Noise

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Coburg made a Local Law for the following purpose:

1. To regulate the—
 - (a) emission of unreasonable noise; and
 - (b) operation and use of amplification equipment and loud hailers within the municipal district; and
2. To revoke By-Law No. 130.

The general purport of Local Law No. 12 is as follows:

1. To prohibit the emission of noise from a road or land if, in the opinion of an authorised officer, that noise is unreasonable (and to exempt persons to whom specified provisions in the *Environmental Protection Act 1970*, or Regulations made under the Act, apply).
2. To regulate the operation and use of amplification equipment and loud hailers when used for the purposes of soliciting custom.
3. To provide for offences if a person contravenes or fails to comply with the Local Law.

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Local Law No. 13
Streets and Roads (Parking)

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Coburg made a Local Law for the following purpose:

1. To regulate the use of—
 - (a) to regulate parking within the municipal district; and
 - (b) to make provision for—
 - (i) resident parking schemes; and
 - (ii) parking by disabled drivers.

The general purport of Local Law No. 13 is as follows:

1. To regulate the parking of vehicles in parking areas located other than on carriageways.
2. To enable the creation and administration of resident parking schemes.
3. To prohibit persons not holding a permit from parking in a parking space set aside for disabled persons.
4. To provide concessions for holders of a disabled person's parking motorist permit.
5. To provide for offences if a person contravenes or fails to comply with the Local Law.

A copy of the Local Law may be inspected at the Council Office, Bell Street, Coburg during office hours.

Local Law No. 14
Streets and Roads (Traffic)

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Coburg made a Local Law for the following purpose:

- (a) to regulate the permanent closure of roads;
- (b) to regulate the temporary closure of roads;
- (c) to regulate the erection and maintenance of obstructions and barriers on roads;
- (d) to prevent injuries to persons and damage to property;
- (e) to allow the implementation of traffic diversion experiments; and
- (f) to regulate the use of roads by heavy motor vehicles.

The general purport of Local Law No. 14 is as follows:

1. To provide for a procedure for the permanent closure of roads, and prohibit persons

from driving a vehicle onto a road which has been permanently closed.

2. To provide for a procedure for the temporary closure of roads, and prohibit persons from driving a vehicle onto a road which has been temporarily closed.

3. To provide a procedure for the placement of obstructions and barriers on a road so as to block or restrict the passage or access of vehicles, and to prohibit persons from driving onto a road on which such obstructions or barriers have been placed.

4. To provide a procedure for the placement of obstructions and barriers on a road to prevent injury to persons or damage to property, and prohibit persons from driving a vehicle onto a road on which such obstructions or barriers have been placed.

5. To provide a procedure for the placement of obstructions and barriers on a road to enable a procession, public ceremony or function to be held, and to prohibit persons from driving a vehicle onto a road on which such obstructions or barriers have been placed.

6. To provide a procedure for the placement of obstructions and barriers on a road to enable a traffic diversion experiment to be conducted, and to prohibit persons from driving a vehicle onto a road on which such obstructions or barriers have been placed.

7. To provide for a declaration of shopping malls, and to regulate persons driving vehicles into shopping malls.

8. To provide a procedure for the prohibition on, or restriction of, heavy motor vehicles from using roads or by-passes, and to regulate persons driving heavy motor vehicles on roads to which the prohibition or restriction applies.

9. To provide for offences if a person contravenes or fails to comply with the Local Law.

Local Law No. 15

Environmental Health (Refuse Collection and Disposal)

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Coburg made a Local Law for the following purpose:

1. (a) to provide for the use and control of receptacles for the deposit and collection of refuse and rubbish;

(b) to prescribe the size and shape of materials to be used in the construction of such receptacles; and

(c) to prevent and regulate the deposit of refuse and rubbish upon streets and other lands and places under the control of the Council; and

2. To revoke By-Law No. 120.

The general purport of Local Law No. 15 is as follows:

1. To prohibit the deposit of household refuse, rubbish and other waste on certain land.

2. To provide for the collection of household refuse from refuse receptacles, and to regulate the construction, number and storage of, and placement of waste in, refuse receptacles.

3. To enable Council to undertake the collection of rubbish and refuse (other than household refuse), and to regulate the collection of such rubbish and refuse.

4. To regulate the placement of waste containers (or skips) in certain locations.

5. To regulate the design and maintenance of containers used for the storage of trade waste.

6. To provide for offences if a person contravenes or fails to comply with the Local Law.

Local Law No. 16

Camping

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Coburg made a Local Law for the following purpose:

1. To regulate camping on—

(a) roads; and

(b) land; and

2. To revoke By-Law No. 115.

The general purport of Local Law No. 16 is as follows:

1. To prohibit the occupation and use of tents, caravans and annexes on roads and in public places.

2. To regulate the owners and occupiers of land allowing others to occupy tents, caravans and annexes on that land, by requiring a permit to be obtained (and by exempting persons holding a planning permit or a licence issued under the *Caravans Parks and Movable Dwellings Act 1988* from the need to obtain a permit).

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3. To provide for offences if a person contravenes or fails to comply with the Local Law.

Local Law No. 17

Services and Information

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Coburg made a Local Law for the following purpose:

To provide for the performance of services and supply of information by Council.

1. To enable Council to perform services and supply information.
2. To enable Council to require payment of the fee for any service provided or information supplied.
3. To enable Council to exclude or limit its liability before performing the service of supplying information.
4. To provide for offences if a person contravenes or fails to comply with the Local Law.

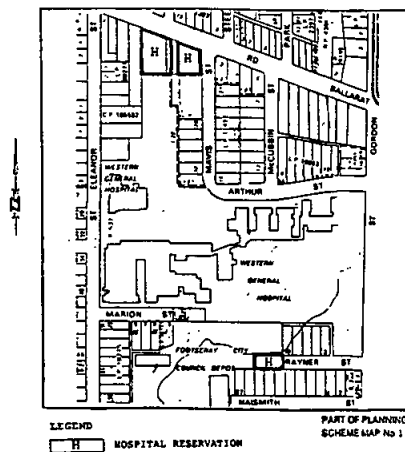

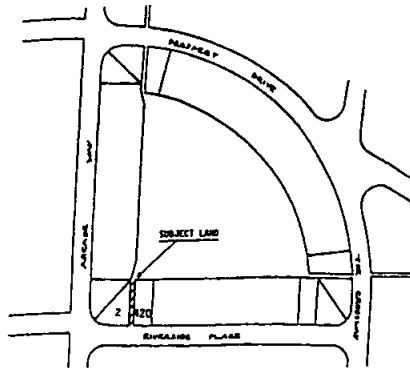
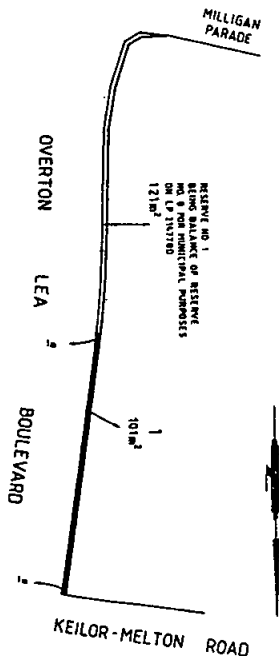
Sale of Tree Reserve, Overton Lea Boulevard, Sydenham

Notice of Discontinuance and Sale of Right of Way between Lot 420 (LP13092) and Lot 2 (LP138818) Riverside Place, East Keilor

The Council of the City of Keilor after advertising its intention, advising statutory authorities and owners and occupiers of any land abutting the tree reserve and shown on the plan hereunder resolved at its ordinary meeting held on 20 October 1992:

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Keilor resolved at its meeting held on 10 November 1992, that Council, having formed the opinion that the Right of Way located between Lot 420 (LP13092) and Lot 2 (LP138818), Riverside Place, East Keilor is no longer required for the purposes for which it was intended, resolve that the land be sold by private treaty in accordance with section 528 (2) of the Local Government Act 1958.

- 1. That pursuant to the provisions of section 189 of the Local Government Act 1989, Council discontinue and sell by private treaty a portion of the tree reserve located at the intersection of Keilor-Melton Road and Overton Lea Boulevard, Sydenham as shown on the attached plan.
- 2. That notwithstanding the discontinuance Melbourne Water shall have easement rights over all of the subject land for drainage and sewerage purposes."



- (a) Statutory Authorities and the Mayor, Councillors and Citizens of the City of Keilor shall continue to have and possess the same right, title, power, authority or interest in, or in relation to the whole of the land shown on the above plan as it had or possessed prior to such discontinuance with respect to or in connection with any drains or pipes laid or erected in or over such land for the purpose of drainage or sewerage.
- (b) The land in the said road, subject to any right, title, power, authority or interest shall vest in the municipality and be retained by it until sold by private treaty.

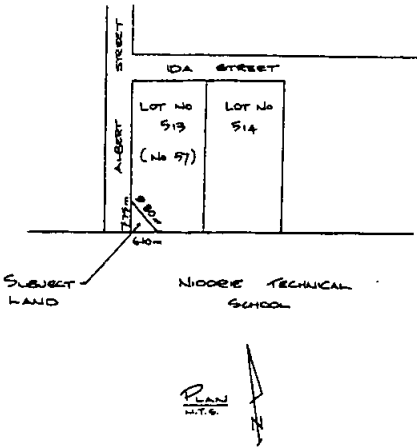

Proposed Local Law
Stables Local Law

Notice is given that at a meeting of the Council of the City of Melbourne held on 16 November 1992, the Council resolved to propose to make a Local Law titled "Stables Local Law" pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Act 1989.

The purposes and general purport of the proposed Local Law are:

- (a) regulate and control the use of stables;
- (b) provide for the registration and inspection of stables;
- (c) ensure the maintenance and cleanliness of stables; and
- (d) maintain the amenity of the environment.

The proposed Local Law re-enacts the provisions of the previous By-law controlling stables which was repealed on 31 October 1992. The Local Law requires that all buildings and vacant land within the municipality of the City of Melbourne used for the stabling of horses must be registered with the Council. It empowers the Council to be able to inspect premises or vacant land used for stabling horses at any time and ensure appropriate conditions exist for the animals stabled.

Written submissions relating to the proposed Local Law by any person affected by it may be made under section 223 of the *Local Government Act* 1989 and must be received by the Council within 14 days after the publication of this public notice.

The Council has determined that the Community and Cultural Services Committee will consider any written submissions received within this time, and hear any persons who may wish to be heard in support of their written submission, either in person or by a person acting on their behalf. Persons making written submissions should clearly state whether they wish to be heard in support of their submission. Persons being heard may address the Committee only in respect of matters which support their written submissions.

Submissions should be addressed to the Town Clerk, Town Hall, Swanston Street, Melbourne, 3000.

Persons making submissions will be notified in writing of the Council's decision and reasons for the decision following consideration of the submissions.

Miscellaneous Amendments Local Law 1992
No. 17 of 1992

Notice is given that at a meeting of the Council of the City of Melbourne held on 16 November 1992, the Council made a Local Law titled Miscellaneous Amendments Local Law 1992 (No. 17 of 1992) pursuant to the provisions of the *Local Government Act* 1989.

The objective of the Local Law is to amend—

- (a) the Naming of Roads and Numbering of Premises Local Law 1992 (No. 10 of 1992); and
- (b) the Parking Local Law 1992 (No. 12 of 1992).

Naming of Roads and Numbering of Premises Local Law (No. 10 of 1992)

Clause 7 of this Local Law relates to the Council resolving to give, approve or allot a name to any new road, but does not make provision for the allocation of a name to an existing but as yet unnamed road. The amendment deletes the word "new" where appearing in Clause 7.

Parking Local Law 1992 (No. 12 of 1992)

This Local Law is to be amended in Clause 7 by the addition of a sub-clause (3)—

"7. (3) The Council may cause to be erected and maintained in any road or on premises adjacent thereto any sign authorised to be displayed under the *Road Safety Act* 1986, the *Local Government Act* 1989, any corresponding succeeding Act, any Regulation or Local Law."

The proposed amendment allows the Council to erect and maintain parking signs on buildings.

A power previously provided under section 535 (10) of the *Local Government Act* 1958.

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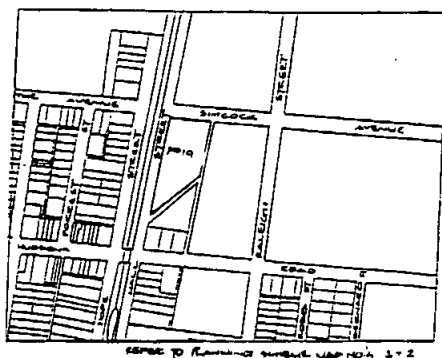

Notice of Amendment to a Planning Scheme
Amendment L36

The City of Nunawading has prepared Amendment L36 to the Nunawading Planning Scheme.

The amendment affects land located at 423-425 Springvale Road, Forest Hill, described as Lot One on Lodged Plan 44315.

The amendment proposes to change the Local Section of the Nunawading Planning Scheme by inserting a site specific provision (being subclause 115-7) in the Residential "C" Zone to allow the existing use of the land as a liquor shop. The shop is currently known as Alf's Discount Liquor.

The amendment proposes that use and development of the land be in accordance with a Development Plan approved by the responsible authority and agreement under section 173 of the *Planning and Environment Act 1987*. 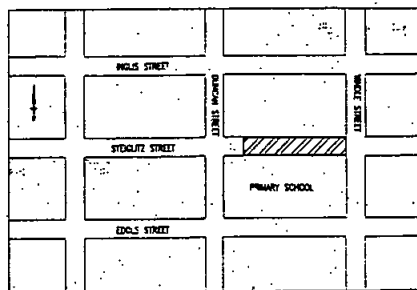



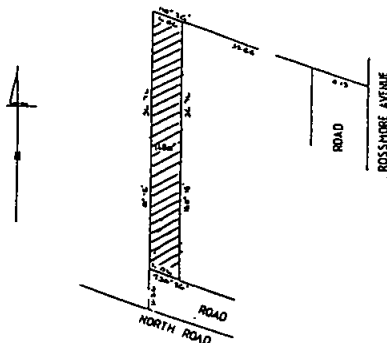

Local Law No. 4—Building Regulations

The purpose of this Local Law is to prescribe minimum requirements for the control of the siting of buildings and the number of buildings that may be erected on an allotment.

Local Law No 5—Municipal Reserves

The purpose of this Local Law is to regulate the use of reserves within the municipal district.

Local Law No. 6—Administration, Enforcement and Penalties

The purpose of this Local Law is to provide for the administration and enforcement of and prescribe penalties for contravention of Local Laws made by Council.

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Local Law No. 7—Camping

The purpose of this Local Law is to regulate camping on roads and other public places.

Local Law No. 8—Streets and Roads (General Regulations)

The purpose of this Local Law is to regulate the exhibition of merchandise on pavements, placement of seats, tables and chairs on pavements, the exhibition of advertising signs, vehicle advertising, protruding materials, shopping trolleys, skateboards, dog litter, street furniture, electoral advertising, naming of roads, allocation of property numbers, control of vegetation on or over roads, obstructions on roads, requirements for vehicle crossings and requirements to adequately provide fences to contain animals.

Local Law No. 9—Recreational Vehicles

The purpose of this Local Law is to regulate the use of recreational vehicles on land within the municipal district.

Local Law No. 10—Environmental Health (Animals and Birds)

The purpose of this Local Law is to regulate for the keeping of a variety of animals including dogs, horses and cattle, other animals, domestic birds and poultry, pigeons, bees, rodents and reptiles. This Local Law is generally intended to ensure that animals kept within residential or rural residential areas do not cause a nuisance to other owners in the area. This Local Law does not apply to a person who occupies a farm which is rated as such.

Local Law No. 11—Environmental Health (Refuse Disposal)

This Local Law provides for control of depositing of waste outside properties and the general disposal of household refuse. This Local Law also requires waste to be contained in adequate containers and prohibits without a permit the installation of waste containers within a street boundary.

Local Law No. 12—Streets and Roads (Traffic)

The purpose of this Local Law is to provide for a number of measures associated with control of activities on road reserves, including permanent closures, temporary closures, erection of obstructions and barriers, prevention of injury to persons and damage to property, processions and public ceremonies and functions, traffic diversion experiments, declaration of shopping malls, control of heavy

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motor vehicles, installation of speed limits.

Local Law No. 13—Control of Vehicles

The purpose of this Local Law is to deal with vehicles on or adjacent to the roadway including unregistered and abandoned vehicles, power to impound vehicles, power to dispose of abandoned vehicles, prohibiting of painting or repairing vehicles on the road, control of advertising vehicles for sale.

Local Law No. 14—Municipal Buildings

The purpose of this Local Law is to provide for the control of public activities in municipal offices, municipal buildings, and public convenience. It is intended to ensure the proper standards of conduct are observed within municipal facilities at all times.

Local Law No. 15—Parking

This Local Law provides for the control of parking, particularly the establishment of fixed term parking areas and the issue of infringements related to offences against fixed term parking areas.

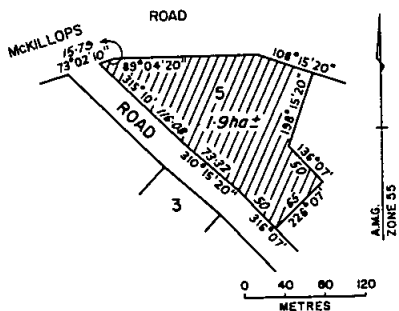
