WATER ACT 1989

I, Geoff Coleman, Minister for Natural Resources, make the following Order:

AMENDMENT OF ENTITLEMENTS OF WATER AUTHORITIES ORDER 1993

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Amendment of Entitlements of Water Authorities Order 1993.
- 2. This Order is made under Division 1 of Part 4 of the *Water Act* 1989 and all other enabling powers.
 - 3. In this Order-
 - "Act" means the Water Act 1989.
 - "The Authorities" means all those Authorities under the Act listed below—

Coliban Region Water Authority Rutherglen Water Board Robinvale Water Board Sunraysia Water Board Swan Hill Water Board Shire of Tallangatta Shire of Yarrawonga Rural City of Wodonga Shire of Numurkah Shire of Alexandra Mansfield District Water Board Goulburn Water Board Mooroopna Water Board Mid Goulburn Regional Water Board Bright District Water Board City of Wangaratta Shire of Bet Bet Borough of Kerang Latrobe Region Water Authority Shire of Korong Macalister Water Board Campaspe Region Water Authority Shire of Cobram Shire of Nathalia Shepparton Water Board Tungamah Shire Water Board 'Corporation" means the Rural Water "The Entitlements" means the entitlements of the Authorities referred to in paragraphs (aa), (a), or (b) of section 35 (2) of the Act contained or granted in or which arise by virtue of any Orders in Council, to water in the Waterways.

"The Waterways" means the following:

storage

Murray River (or River Murray) and associated storages

King River and associated storages Ovens River downstream of junction of Buffalo River

Broken River and associated storages
Broken Creek and associated storages
Goulburn River and associated
storages downstream of Eildon
storage and including Eildon

Campaspe River and associated storages downstream of Eppalock storage and including Eppalock storage

Loddon River and associated storages
Thomson River downstream of
Cowwarr Weir storage and
including Cowwarr weir storage

Macalister River downstream of Glenmaggie storage and including Glenmaggie storage.

- 4. (a) The Entitlements of the Authorities are amended to provide that each Authority must make payment to the Corporation at the rate set in Schedule 1 for water taken by that Authority under the Entitlements.
- (b) The payment for the financial year 1992–93 will be calculated in accordance with the estimated average annual volume as set out in Schedule 1 which is deemed to be taken by each Authority. Any Authority which can to the satisfaction of the Corporation demonstrate that the water taken in the 1992–93 financial year was less than the estimated average annual volume may have its 1993–94 financial year payment adjusted accordingly. Where this adjustment cannot be resolved between the

Corporation.

Corporation and any Authority the matter is to be determined by the Minister.

- (c) The payment for the 1992-93 financial year will be by way of one instalment due and payable to the Corporation within 28 days of the date specified in any notice issued to the Authority by the Corporation.
- (d) Upon default of payment by an Authority within 28 days of the date specified in any notice issued by the Corporation pursuant to Clause 4 (c), an Authority will be charged interest in accordance with section 281 (1), (1A), (1B) and (1c) of the Act.
- (e) The payment structure for the financial year 1992-93 for each Authority is set out in Schedule 1.
 - 5. This Order takes effect on and from the

date on which it is published in the Government Gazette.

- 6. (a) This is an Order made under section 44 of the Act; and
- (b) The application for the amendment of entitlements made by this Order was made by the Rural Water Corporation with the support of the Minister for Finance.
- (c) Under section 42 (2) of the Act I consider that the Amendment of Entitlements made by this Order is not likely to have any significant impact in terms of the matters required to be considered under section 40 of the Act.
