WATER ACT 1989

I, Charles Geoffrey Coleman, as Minister administering the *Water Act* 1989 make the following Order:

APPOINTMENT OF THE CITY OF WANGARATTA ORDER 1993

1. This Order is called the Appointment of the City of Wangaratta Order 1993.

2. This Order is made under the powers conferred by Division 2, Part 6 of the *Water Act* 1989 and all other available powers.

3. This Order takes effect on 1 July 1993.

4. In this Order:

“Act” means *Water Act* 1989;

“Former Authority” means the Springhurst Water Board, constituted by Order in Council dated 1 July 1984.

5. On and from the date on which this Order takes effect the City of Wangaratta is appointed to take over the whole of the property, rights, liabilities, obligations, powers and functions under the Act of the Former Authority including the management and control of the existing water districts named below—

Springhurst Urban,

Springhurst Waterworks.

6. The Former Authority is abolished.

(a) This is an Order referred to in section 98 (2) (a) of the Act.

(b) Under section 100 (2) (a) of the Act, the affected Authorities have applied to me for this Order to be made.

(c) Under section 100 (2) (b) of the Act, I have consulted with the Minister administering the *Local Government Act* 1989.

(d) Under section 100 (3) of the Act, I have obtained the written consent of the Minister administering the *Local Government Act* 1989, and the Shire of Wangaratta.

(e) Under section 98 (2) (a) of the Act, I have agreed to the terms and conditions with the Former Authority and the City of Wangaratta.
