#### Fisheries Act 1968 FISHERIES NOTICE No. 29/1993

#### FISHERIES (ROCK LOBSTER OPENING) NOTICE No. 29/1993

#### Title

1. This Notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Rock Lobster Opening) Notice No. 29/1993.

#### Commencement

2. This Notice comes into operation on 15 November 1993.

### Objective

3. The objective of this Notice is to bring forward the opening of the Rock Lobster season by 12 hours in order to facilitate the orderly and safe start to the season.

#### Authorising provision

4. This Notice is made under section 80 of the Fisheries Act 1968.

#### Restriction on leaving wharf, jetty or piers

5. A person operating a registered fishing boat licensed to take crayfish for sale must not leave the wharf, pier or jetty with any crayfish pot or crayfish coff on board the boat between the hours of 12.00 midnight on 14 November 1993 and 12.00 noon on 15 November 1993.

### Permission to leave or set pots and coffs in the water during the close season

6. A person operating a registered fishing boat licensed to take crayfish for sale may leave or have any crayfish pot or crayfish coff immersed or set in any Victorian waters between the hours of 12.00 noon and 12.00 midnight on 15 November 1993.

## Replacement of Regulation 9 (3) (b) of Fishing (Crayfish) Regulations 1989

7. The provisions of this notice replace the provisions of regulation 9 (3) (b) of the \*Fishing (Crayfish) Regulations 1989 for the duration of this Notice.

#### Penalty

8. Any person who contravenes this Notice is liable to a penalty of 20 penalty units.
