No. 93/1993 (1) Sections 1, 2 and 6 come into operation on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

(2) Subject to sub-section (3), the remaining provisions of this Act come into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.

(3) If a provision referred to in sub-section (2) does not come into operation before 31 March 1994, it comes into operation on that day.

No. 94/1993 This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

## Casino Control Act 1991 DESIGNATION OF LAND FOR THE TEMPORARY SITE FOR THE MELBOURNE CASINO

**DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 128p**

The Governor in Council under section 128p of the *Casino Control Act 1991*, on the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister for Gaming and the Honourable the Treasurer, declares that Subdivision 8 of Division 3 of Part II of the *Stamps Act 1958* and Heading VIII of the Third Schedule to the Act do not have effect and must be taken never to have had effect in relation to—

- (a) the lease to be granted by the Minister for Finance under the provisions of the *Land Act 1958* and the *Casino Control Act 1991* in favour of Crown Casino Limited for the Melbourne Casino site; and
- (b) the Management Agreement dated 20 September 1993 between the Minister for Gaming and Crown Casino Limited but only to the extent that the Agreement relates to an obligation to grant a lease of the Melbourne Casino site—

and that these provisions of the *Stamps Act 1958* be read and construed to accord with this Declaration.

**TEMPORARY CASINO LEASE**  
 Declaration Under Section 128p

The Governor in Council under section 128p of the *Casino Control Act 1991*, on the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister for Gaming and the Honourable the Minister for Roads and Ports, declares that section 50 (2) of the *Port of Melbourne Authority Act 1958* shall be read and construed as authorising the Port of Melbourne Authority to grant a lease for the purposes of a Casino to be operated under the provisions of the *Casino Control Act 1991* and the *Port of Melbourne Authority Act 1958* has effect and must be taken always to have had effect accordingly.

**CASINO CONTROL ACT 1991**

The Governor in Council under section 128c of the *Casino Control Act 1991*, on the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister for Gaming—

- (a) revokes the approval of the plan for the Melbourne Casino site dated 3 August 1993 and published in the *Government Gazette* of 5 August 1993;
- (b) revokes the approval of the plan for the temporary casino site dated 12 October 1993 and published in the *Government Gazette* of 14 October 1993;
- (c) approves the plan for the Melbourne Casino site numbered C.P.112471A and the plan for the temporary casino site numbered LEGL./93-223 lodged in the Central Plan Office, Survey and Mapping, Victoria being plans of survey, signed by the Surveyor-General.

ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS  
ORDER (No. 131) 1993

1. This Order is called the Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 131) 1993.

2. This Order is made under the powers conferred by section 3 of the *Administrative Arrangements Act* 1983 and under every other available power.

3. This Order takes effect on and from the date of this Order.

4. In respect of the item in the Schedule a reference to the Old Body in any provision of an Act, a Statutory instrument specified in Column 2 or in any statutory or other instrument made under any provision of an Act specified in Column 2 or in respect of any contract, agreement or other matter specified in Column 2 shall be construed as a reference to the New Body.

5. Where—

(a) before this Order takes effect a transaction happened in relation to the Old Body, then—

(b) this Order does not affect the validity or continuity of the transaction, and the transaction shall continue and may be completed in relation to the New Body in the same way as it would have been

continued and may have been completed in relation to the Old Body as if this Order had not been made.

6. In this Order—

“The Act” means the *Administrative Arrangements Act* 1983;

“Body” means Minister, Department, Administrative Office or Officer;

“Instrument” includes contract and agreement;

“Old Body” and “New Body” means respectively the Bodies specified in Column 1 and Column 3 of the item in the Schedule;

“Schedule” means the Schedule to this Order;

“Transaction” includes—

- (a) agreement, bond, contract, deed or other consensual arrangement whatsoever;
- (b) action, appeal, arbitration, prosecution or other legal proceeding whatsoever;
- (c) assignment, charge, lease, mortgage, transfer or other dealing with property whatsoever;
- (d) loan, guarantee, indemnity or other dealing with money whatsoever;
- (e) approval, consent, delegation, direction, licence, Order, permit, requirement or other authority whatsoever;
- (f) notice; and
- (g) any other act, entitlement or liability in the law whatsoever.

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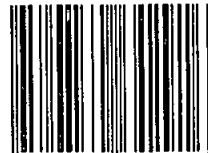
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
