- (i) to provide for the administration of the Council's powers and functions.







Notice of Amendment to a Planning Scheme Amendment L75

The Shire of Hastings has prepared Amendment L75 to the Hastings Planning Scheme. The amendment proposes to rezone land generally at the south-west corner of Eramosa Road West and Graf Road, Somerville from Low Intensity Commercial and Public Purposes (Commonwealth Government) to Residential 2.

The existing zoning is considered to be inappropriate for the following reasons:

The land at 67 Eramosa Road West is owned by the Australian Overseas Telecommunications Corporation who have advised that it is surplus to their needs.

The Shire of Hastings Commercial Centres Strategy commented that the Low Intensity Commercial zone is incompatible with the existing character of the area, and intended use of adjacent land. It concluded that the most appropriate use of the land is for residential purposes and recommended Council take measures to rezone it accordingly.

The findings of the Strategy were supported by the Somerville Outline Development Plan which recommended that the subject land be rezoned to Residential 2.

The proposed rezoning will be more compatible with adjoining residential land to the south, west and north, and may result in development which is more sympathetic to the existing historic residence "Mandalay". The recent decision by Council to retain the District Business zone to the east will ensure that there is

sufficient commercially zoned land for Somerville's future needs and the proposed amendment will not prejudice future options for the development of this land.

The Shire of Hastings has prepared Amendment L95 to the Local Section of the Hastings Planning Scheme.

The amendment affects land reserved for public use within the area contained within the former Chapter 3 of the Planning Scheme (Conservation Plan). It includes open space and parks (currently shown on planning scheme maps as "Recreation and Conservation"), and land reserved for other public purposes including schools, water supply catchments, drainage and sewerage, etc. (now shown by the use, e.g. Primary School, Reservoir, etc.).

As a part of a previous Amendment L51 the former Chapter 3 provisions relating to Reserved Land were deleted in favour of retaining Clause 170 of the former Chapters 1 and 2. However, this has resulted in a discrepancy as the definitions of Reserved Land in Clause 170 do not correspond with the definitions shown on the former Chapter 3 Maps.

Amendment L95 therefore proposes to correct this discrepancy by amending the former Chapter 3 planning scheme maps in accordance with the definitions for Reserved Land contained in Clause 170. This will include:

All areas shown as Recreation and Conservation will be changed to the appropriate Public Open Space Reservation, e.g. Emu Plains Recreation Reserve and Racecourse will become POS-C.

All land reserved for other purposes will be changed to the appropriate Public Purposes Reservations, e.g. Devilbend Reservoir which is currently shown simply as "Reservoir" will now be PP-3 (Melbourne Water).

In one instance land will be rezoned from Rural Conservation (SE) to PP-PS reservation to formalise the existing and future use and development of land by the Balnarring Primary School. The school has been established at its current site for a number of years and it is appropriate that it should now be rezoned to the appropriate reservation.

The proposed amendment will only reflect existing and future use of sites and (with the exception of the Balnarring Primary School) does not propose to change the ability to use or develop the land. It will also ensure consistency in the designation of Reserved Land in all areas of the Shire, and in doing so will assist in improving and simplifying the Planning Scheme for the benefit of all users.


VICTORIA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY FOOTSCRAY CAMPUS NORTH


