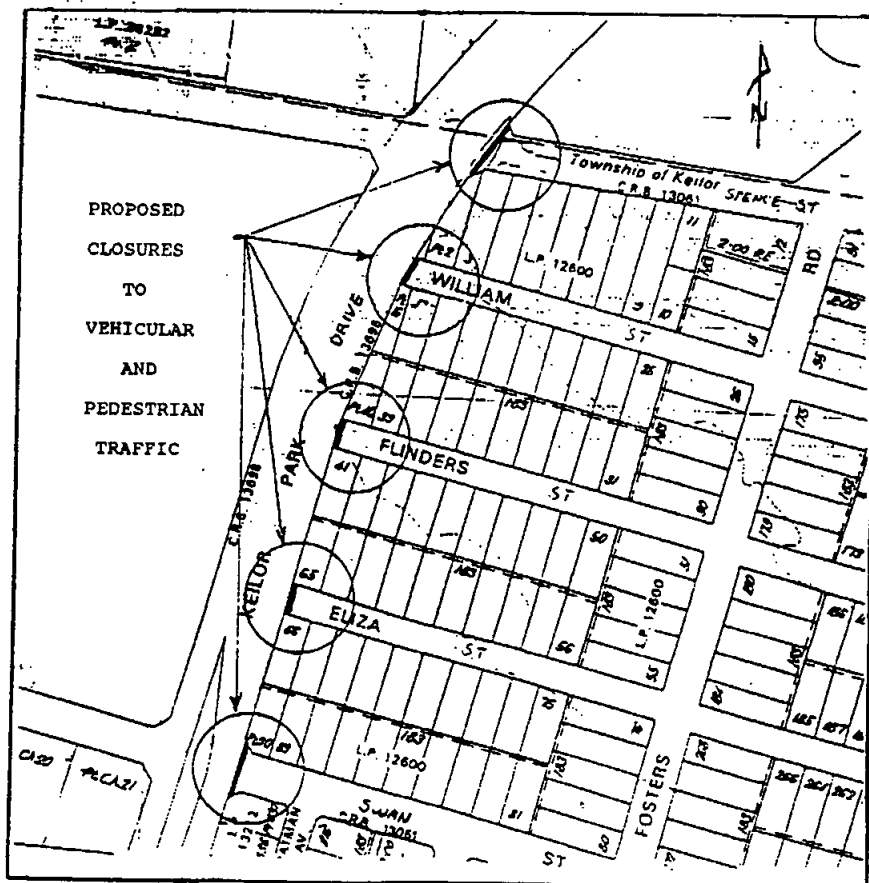

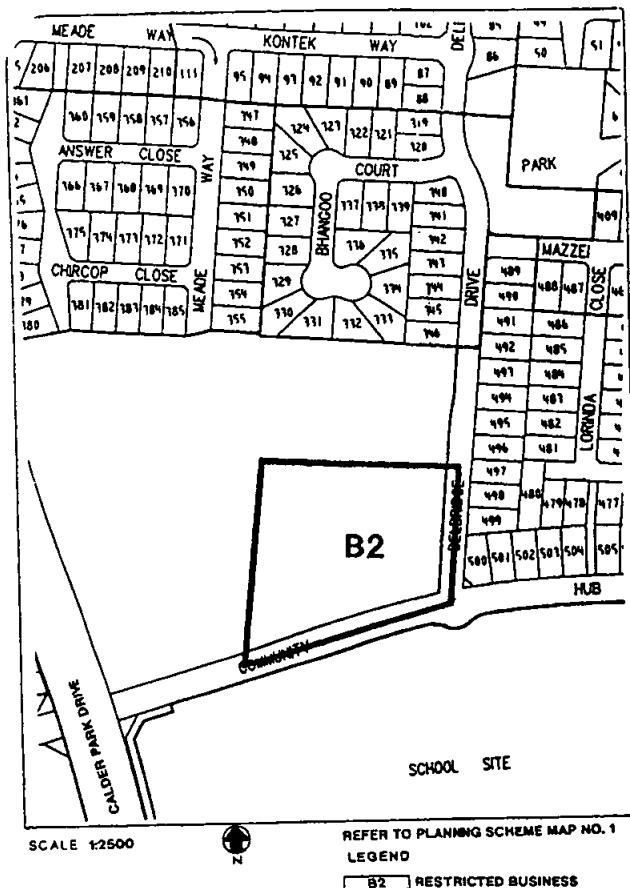

CITY OF MALVERN

Notice of Making of Local Law 5/93

Sale of Goods on Street

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Malvern at its meeting on 31 May 1993, made Local Law 5/93 to regulate or prohibit the sale of goods on streets and certain other lands and to regulate house to house solicitation for monetary donation. The purpose of the Local Law is to:

1. Regulate or prohibit the sale of goods other than from premises or land from which the sale of goods is authorised under any other legislation.
2. Regulate house to house solicitation for monetary donation.
3. Provide for the prevention and abatement of nuisances.
4. Provide for the administration of Council powers and functions.
5. Provide for the peace order and good government of the municipal district of the City of Malvern.
6. Prohibit any person without a permit or exemption from the need to apply for a permit as resolved by Council from time to time, from erecting or using on any land or road within the municipal district any stall, tent, motor vehicle, cart, truck, barrow or any other vehicle, or box, trolley, crate, bag or other receptacle or temporary structure or building of any kind for the purpose of the sale of any goods or services.
7. Prohibit any person without a permit from Council (or as exempted by Council from time to time for the need to obtain a permit) from selling any goods or services from any receptacle, basket or container carried about on any person or from any stall, tent, motor vehicle, cart, truck, barrow, trolley or any other vehicle or from any box, crate, bag or other receptacle or temporary structure or buildings of any kind on any land or road within the municipal district.
8. No person shall without a permit from the Council, unless exempted from the need to obtain a permit from Council by resolution of Council from time to time, conduct house to house solicitation or collect or seek upon any land or road within the municipal

district any gifts of money or any subscriptions for any purpose or cause or authorise another person to do so.

9. The Local Law provides that any charity registered with the Fund Raising Appeals Board may lodge a written application to the Environmental Services Manager for permission to conduct door knocks or street collections, upon any land or road within the municipal district.

The Local Law provides for offences to be prosecuted either by court procedure or the issue of infringement notices and sets penalties for breaches of the Local Law.

Local Law 5/93 comes into force and effect on 11 June 1993.

Notice of Proposed Local Law 1/93 Environmental Health (Refuse Collection and Disposal)

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Malvern proposes to make Local Law 1/93, Environmental Health (Refuse Collection and Disposal) which will be applicable throughout the municipal district and will have the following purposes:

1. Regulate the deposit of refuse and rubbish upon roads and other lands.
2. Provide for the use and control of mobile refuse receptacles for the deposit and collection of household refuse and approved trade wastes.
3. Provide for the collection of other refuse, rubbish and waste by Councils.
4. Regulate the placement of waste containers on roads and naturestrips.
5. Regulate the storage of trade waste.

The Local Law is generally designed to control and regulate the collection of household refuse and trade waste (excluding building materials) and provides for the placement and use of mobile refuse containers, as directed by Council.

Amongst other things the Local Law provides that a person must not without first obtaining a permit (for which a fee is payable) and then in accordance with the conditions of the permit, place or allow to be placed any waste container on a road or naturestrip. (Refuse receptacles of the type issued or approved by Council, being either 120 litres or 240 litres, in capacity are excluded.

The Local Law provides for offences to be prosecuted either by court procedure or the issue of infringement notices and sets penalties for breaches of the Local Law.

A copy of the Local Law can be obtained from the Council offices, corner Glenferrie Road and High Street, Malvern, during normal office hours.

Any person affected by the proposed Local Law may make a written submission to the Council addressed to the undersigned, PO Box 100, Malvern 3144.

Submissions will be considered by the Council or a Committee appointed by the Council, in accordance with section 223 of the *Local Government Act 1989*. All submissions must be lodged within 14 days of the publication of this notice. Persons making a submission may request to be heard in support thereof, either in person or by a person acting on their behalf, by the Council or by a Committee of the Council, and will be notified of the time and date of the hearing.

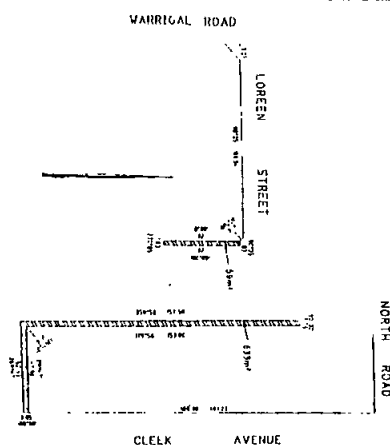

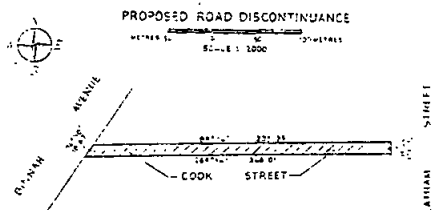

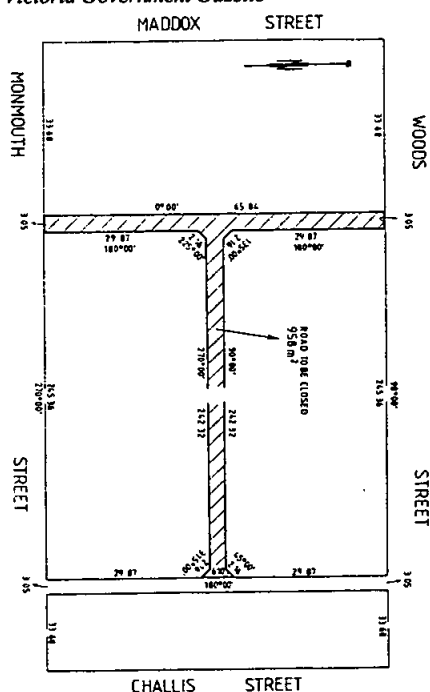

The Local Law provides for persons not being able to consume and possess liquor in any public reserve or in any motor vehicle on any public reserve between the hours of 10.00 p.m. and 6.00 a.m. It also provides provisions for exemption in certain circumstances and outlines of procedure for offences and enforcement.

Local Law No. 9—INCINERATOR

The purpose of the Local Law is to regulate and control incinerators and the use of such. The Local Law sets out the times a person may light an incinerator, namely only on Saturdays or Tuesdays between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. It also identifies the materials which cannot be burnt.

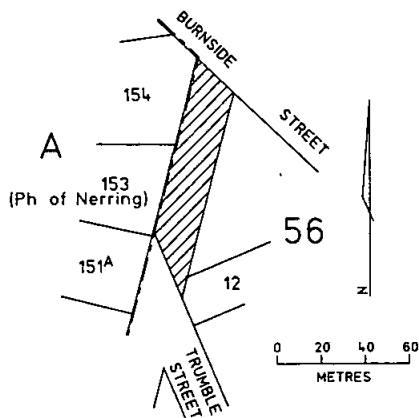

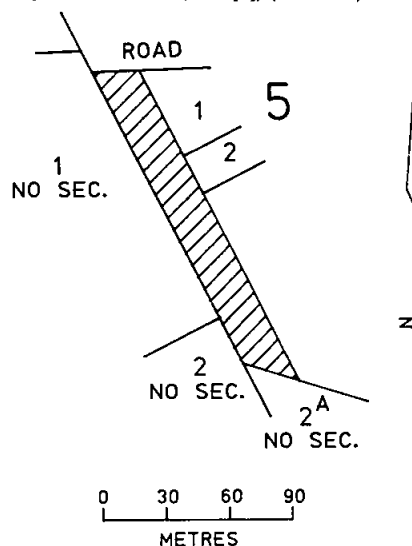
