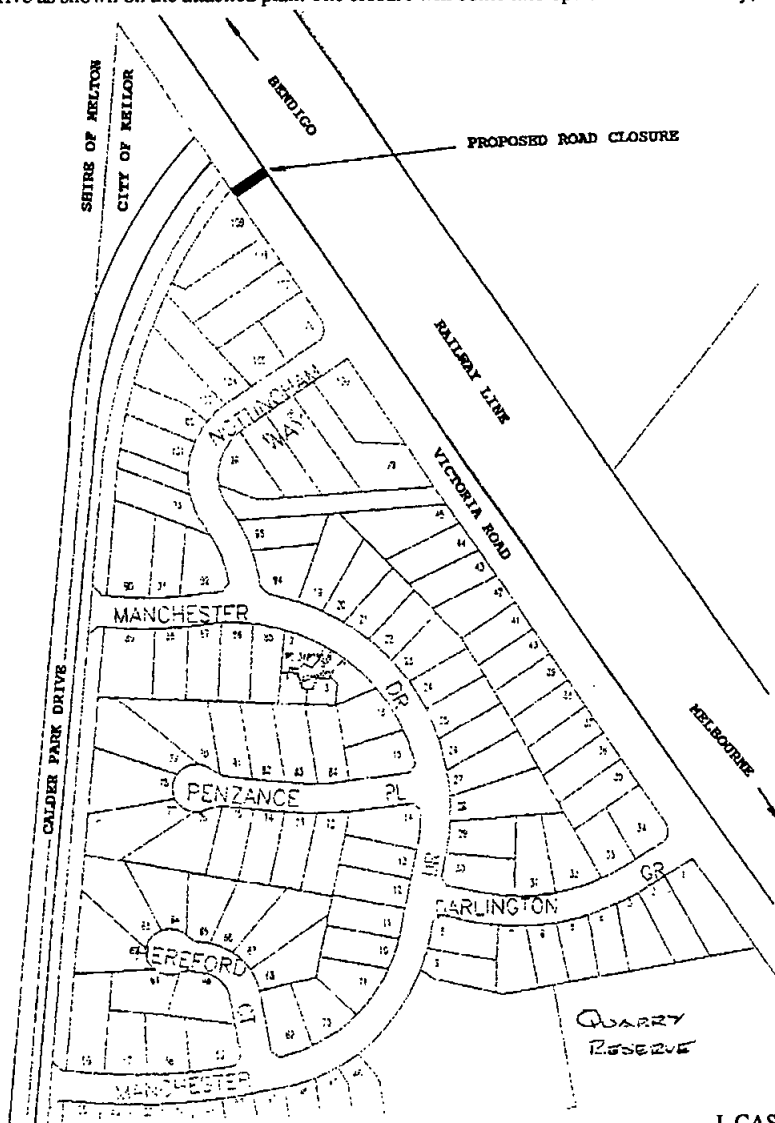

DIVISION 2—MERCHANDISE ON
PAVEMENTS

Local Law No. 7

Need for Permit

Streets and Roads (General Regulation)
Local Law

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Footscray at its meeting on 12 July 1993 made a Streets and Roads (General Regulation) Local Law to—

An owner or occupier of retail premises must not, without first obtaining a permit nor otherwise than in accordance with the conditions of such permit—

- (a) regulate the exhibition of merchandise on pavements;
- (b) regulate the exhibition of advertising signs on pavements;
- (c) regulate the placement of seats, tables, chairs and other furniture on pavements;
- (d) regulate the exhibition of merchandise and advertising signs on vehicles left standing near retail premises;
- (e) regulate the protrusion of verandahs and awnings into the airspace about pavements;
- (f) regulate the deposit of shopping trolleys in streets, car parks and other public places;
- (g) regulate the use of skateboards on pavements;
- (h) prohibit the dismantling and painting of vehicles on roads and in public places;
- (i) regulate the repair of vehicles on roads;
- (j) prevent the deposit of dog litter on roads and in other public places;
- (k) prohibit the destruction or removal of, or damage to, street furniture;
- (l) regulate the distribution of advertising and promotional material;
- (m) regulate the identification of premises;
- (n) regulate the growth of trees and plants so as to prevent accidents;
- (o) prohibit obstructions; and regulate behaviour on pavements;
- (p) provide for the construction and maintenance of permanent and temporary vehicle crossings.

- (i) exhibit;
- (ii) place out for exhibition; or
- (iii) allow to be exhibited or placed out for exhibition—

any merchandise on the pavement adjacent to, or near the retail premises.

Applications for Permit

Any person applying for a permit must lodge with the Municipal Clerk an Application in a form approved by Council, and any Application Fee fixed by Resolution of Council.

Council may in its discretion, grant the Application, grant the Application with conditions, or refuse to grant the Application.

Form of Permit

Any permit granted by Council shall be in a form approved by Council, and not be operative until the Applicant pays any Permit Fee fixed by Resolution of Council.

DIVISION 3—EXHIBITION OF
ADVERTISING SIGNS

Need for Permit

An owner or occupier of retail premises must not, without first obtaining a permit nor otherwise than in accordance with the conditions of such permit—

- (i) exhibit;
- (ii) place out for exhibition; or
- (iii) allow to be exhibited or placed out for exhibition—

any advertising sign on the pavement adjacent to, or near the retail premises.

Applications for Permit

Any person applying for a permit must lodge with the Municipal Clerk an Application in a form approved by Council, and any Application Fee fixed by Resolution of Council.

Council may in its discretion, grant the Application, grant the Application with conditions, or refuse to grant the Application.

DIVISION 1—PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

Detail the title, purpose, authorising provision, commencement and revocation dates of the Local Law, area of operation, and definition of words and phrases used in the Local Law.

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Form of Permit

Any permit granted by Council shall be in a form approved by Council, and not be operative until the Applicant pays any Permit Fee fixed by Resolution of Council.

DIVISION 4—FURNITURE ON PAVEMENTS

Need for Permit

An owner or occupier of retail premises must not, without first obtaining a permit nor otherwise than in accordance with the conditions of such permit—

- (i) provide for public or other use; or
- (ii) allow to be provided for public or other use any—
 - (v) seats;
 - (w) umbrellas;
 - (x) tables;
 - (y) chairs; or
 - (z) other furniture—
on the pavement—
 - (aa) adjacent to; or
 - (bb) near—
the retail premises.

Applications for Permits

Any person applying for a permit must lodge with the Municipal Clerk an Application in a form approved by Council, and any Application Fee fixed by Resolution of Council.

Council may in its discretion, grant the Application, grant the Application with conditions, or refuse to grant the Application.

Form of Permit

Any permit granted by Council shall be in a form approved by Council, and not be operative until the Applicant pays any Permit Fee fixed by Resolution of Council.

DIVISION 5—VEHICULAR ADVERTISING

Need for Permit

An owner or occupier of retail premises must not, without first obtaining a permit nor otherwise than in accordance with the conditions of such permit, leave standing on any road or in any public place a motor vehicle—

- (i) on which there is placed any merchandise referable to retail premises; or

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- (ii) to which there is fitted or otherwise attached an advertising sign which advertises any retail premises or merchandise.

Applications for Permit

Any person applying for a permit must lodge with the Municipal Clerk an Application in a form approved by Council, and any Application Fee fixed by Resolution of Council.

Council may in its discretion, grant the Application, grant the Application with conditions, or refuse to grant the Application.

Form of Permit

Any permit granted by Council shall be in a form approved by Council, and not be operative until the Applicant pays any Permit Fee fixed by Resolution of Council.

DIVISION 6—PROTRUDING MATERIALS

Need for Permit

An owner or occupier of retail premises must not, without first obtaining a permit nor otherwise than in accordance with the conditions of such permit—

- (i) attach; or
- (ii) allow to be attached—
to any verandah or awning which forms part of the retail premises—
 - (y) an advertising sign; or
 - (z) any banner, flag, bunting or like decoration.

Applications for Permit

Any person applying for a permit must lodge with the Municipal Clerk an Application in a form approved by Council, and any Application Fee fixed by Resolution of Council.

Council may in its discretion, grant the Application, grant the Application with conditions, or refuse to grant the Application.

Form of Permit

Any permit granted by Council shall be in a form approved by Council, and not be operative until the Applicant pays any Permit Fee fixed by Resolution of Council.

DIVISION 7—SHOPPING TROLLEYS

General Obligation

A person must not leave a shopping trolley on a road, in a car park, or in any other public place.

Power to Impound

Repairing Vehicles

If an Authorised Officer finds a shopping trolley on a road, in a car park, or in any other public place, he or she may arrange for the shopping trolley to be removed to a place appointed or approved by Council, and be retained there subject to this Local Law.

A person must not repair a vehicle on a road or in a public place. This does not apply to a person who is repairing a vehicle because of any emergency or a breakdown.

Impound Shopping Trolleys

Where a shopping trolley has been impounded, Council may serve a notice on each of the persons who appear to be the owner of the shopping trolley.

DIVISION 9—SKATEBOARDS

A person must not ride or otherwise use any skateboard on a pavement so as to injure, inconvenience, or endanger the safety of any person using the pavement, or damage any premises which abut the pavement.

Each notice must be served personally or by certified mail, and be in a form approved by Council.

DIVISION 10—DOG LITTER

A person who is the effective control of a dog must not permit that dog to excrete faeces on a road, or in any other public place.

Surrender of Shopping Trolleys

A shopping trolley which has been impounded must be surrendered to the owner or any person acting on the owner's behalf if—

If a dog which is under the effective control of a person excretes faeces on a road, or in any public place, that person must immediately remove the faeces, or cause the faeces to be removed.

- (a) in the event of a claim being made by a person acting on the owner's behalf, satisfactory evidence is provided of that person's authority from the owner; and
- (b) in the event, there is paid to Council a fee fixed by Resolution of Council.

DIVISION 11—STREET FURNITURE

A person must not, without the authority of Council, destroy, remove, deface, interfere or tamper with, damage, or attack or affix an advertising sign to any street furniture, or any tree or plant under the care and management of Council.

Power to Sell, Destroy or Give Away

(a) If 14 days elapse from the removal of a shopping trolley to a place appointed or approved by Council, and the shopping trolley is not surrendered to—

DIVISION 12—JUNK MAIL

(a) A person must not deliver, or cause to be delivered, to any part of premises, advertising or promotional material if the words "No Junk Mail" or words to the like effect are displayed on those premises or any part of those premises.

- (a) its owner; or
- (b) a person acting on its owner's behalf—
Council may—
 - (i) destroy the shopping trolley;
 - (ii) deliver the shopping trolley to a municipal tip;
 - (iii) give the shopping trolley away; or
 - (iv) sell the shopping trolley by auction, public tender or private sale.

(b) A person on whose behalf advertising or promotional material is printed must give an Authorised Officer the name and address of the person who was responsible for distributing and advertising or promotional material to the premises described in sub-clause (a).

(b) Where a shopping trolley is sold in accordance with sub-clause (a) (iv) above, the net proceeds from sale shall belong to Council and be paid into the Municipal Fund.

(c) A person must comply with the obligation imposed by sub-clause (b) within seven (7) days of receiving a written request for such information from the Authorised Officer.

DIVISION 8—STATIONARY VEHICLES ON ROADS

Dismantling and Painting Vehicles

A person must not assemble, dismantle or paint a vehicle on a road or in a public place.

(d) A person who engaged another person (whether as an employee or agent) to deliver advertising or promotional material to premises described in sub-clause (a) must give an Authorised Officer the name and address of that other person.

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(e) A person must comply with the obligation imposed by sub-clause (d) within seven (7) days of receiving a written request for such information from the Authorised Officer.

DIVISION 13—IDENTIFICATION OF PREMISES

(a) If Council has allotted a numbered premises abutting the road so that they may be identified, the owner and occupier of those premises must mark or cause to be marked, and maintain or cause to be maintained, that number on part of the premises.

(b) The number must be marked such that it can, at any reasonable time, be clearly seen by any person using the road which abuts such premises.

DIVISION 14—OVERHANGING VEGETATION

General Prohibition

The owner and occupier of land must not permit any tree or part of a tree, or plant or part of a plant, to grow in such a manner as to overhang the boundary of the land and obstruct or impair the vision of the driver of any vehicle travelling along a road abutting the land, or otherwise prejudice the safe and convenient use of any pavement or road abutting the land.

If an Authorised Officer reasonably suspects that an owner or occupier of land is contravening the above, he or she may serve a notice on the owner or occupier.

Upon receiving any such notice, the owner or occupier must cease his or her contravention in accordance with the notice.

DIVISION 15—OBSTRUCTIONS

General Prohibition

A person must not obstruct any road or pavement.

This shall not extend to any person who holds or operates under a permit issued with the authority of an Act or this or another Local Law, or to whom section 4 (e) of the *Summary Offences Act 1966* applies.

Enforcement

If an Authorised Officer finds a person contravening the above, Council or that Authorised Officer, may remove the obstruction or cause the obstruction to be removed.

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Any expenses incurred shall be a debt due and payable to the Council by the person found to be contravening.

DIVISION 16—VEHICLE CROSSINGS

Permanent Vehicle Crossings

The owner and occupier of premises must not, without first obtaining a permit nor otherwise in accordance with the conditions of such permit, construct or cause to be constructed, and maintain or cause to be maintained, a permanent vehicle crossing.

General Prohibition

An owner and occupier of land who proposes to carry out, or cause to be carried out, building works on the land must not, unless the vehicle crossing adequately protects any pavement, drain, culvert or kerb adjacent to or near the land, commence the building works, or allow the building works to be commenced, without constructing a temporary vehicle crossing.

Need for Permit

An owner or occupier of land must not, without first obtaining a permit nor otherwise than in accordance with the conditions of such permit, construct or cause to be constructed, a temporary vehicle crossing.

If Council is satisfied that a permanent or temporary vehicle crossing is no longer required, or is no longer of use, it may serve on the owner or occupier who constructed the permanent or temporary vehicle crossing, a notice requiring him or her to remove or reconstruct the permanent or temporary vehicle crossing, or cause it to be removed or constructed, within 30 days of service.

If a person does not comply in accordance with the notice, Council may remove or reconstruct it, or cause it to be removed or reconstructed, and recover the costs of doing so from that person.

Applications for Permits

Any person applying for a permit must lodge with the Municipal Clerk an Application in a form approved by Council, and any Application Fee fixed by Resolution of Council.

Council may in its discretion, grant the Application, grant the Application with conditions, or refuse to grant the Application.

Form and Operation of Permit

Any permit granted by Council shall be in a form approved by Council and may contain any guidelines or policy adopted by Council from time to time, and not be operative until the Applicant pays any Permit Fee fixed by Resolution of Council.

the date of the notice will be taken into account in the determination of the Application.

(c) Where Council has required the giving or publication of a notice it must not further consider the Application until—

- (i) it is satisfied that the Applicant has given and/or published the notice in the required manner; and
- (ii) at least 14 days have elapsed since the giving or publication of the notice.

(d) All written submissions received within the 14 day period must be considered by Council or a special committee of Council.

DIVISION 17—BEHAVIOUR ON PAVEMENT

A person must not, without the authority of Council—

- (a) use or play any musical or broadcasting equipment, or use any loud-hailer, on a pavement;
- (b) solicit custom or gifts of money on a pavement;
- (c) organise or sponsor any demonstration, exhibition, entertainment, meeting or other gathering on a pavement;
- (d) distribute any handbill, pamphlet, paper or like material on a pavement; or
- (e) preach, declaim, harangue or deliver an address on a pavement.

Revocation of Permits

If, in the opinion of Council, a permit-holder fails to comply with any conditions of the permit, or obstructs or unduly interferes with pedestrian traffic, it may revoke the permit.

Correction of Permits

Council may correct a permit if it contains a clerical error, omission or mistake.

Currency of Permits

Unless revoked, a permit will continue in force for the period specified in the permit, or for 12 months if no period is specified, and the permit holder must not assign, transfer or encumber his or her permit.

Record of Permits

Council must keep a record of all permits issued under this Local Law.

Infringement Notices

Provides for the serving of Infringement Notices as an alternative to prosecution.

Offences and Penalties

A person who contravenes this Local Law is guilty of an offence, and liable to a penalty—

- (a) for an initial offence, not exceeding 10 penalty units (\$1000.00);
- (b) for a subsequent offence, not exceeding 20 penalty units (\$2000.00).

A copy of the Local Law is available for inspection free of charge during office hours at the Administration Department, 2nd Floor, Municipal Offices, corner Napier and Hyde Streets, Footscray.

DIVISION 18—GENERAL PROVISIONS

Advertisement of Applications

(a) Before considering any Application under this Local Law, Council may require the Applicant to—

- (i) give notice of the Application to any persons whom Council considers may be detrimentally affected by the grant of the Application; and
- (ii) publish notice of the Application in a newspaper generally circulating in the municipal district.

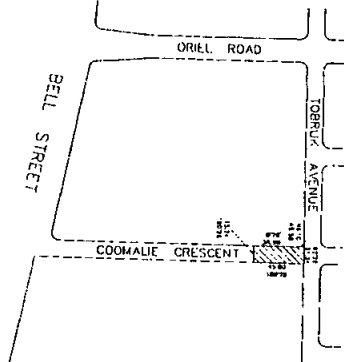
(b) Every notice given or published must consist of—

- (i) a true copy or summary of the Application;
- (ii) an indication that Council will consider the Application after the expiry of 14 days following the giving or publication of the notice;
- (iii) an indication that all persons affected by the grant of an Application may send to Council any written submissions they may have in relation to the Application; and
- (iv) an indication that all written submissions received within 14 days of

Notice of Approval of Amendment
Amendment L85

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment L85 to the Local Section of the Melbourne Planning Scheme.

Notice of Amendment to a Planning Scheme
Amendment L7

The City of Mordialloc has prepared an amendment to the Mordialloc Planning Scheme, Local Section.

The amendment affects land at 363-383 Nepean Highway, Mordialloc.

The amendment proposes to change the condition under which shops may establish within the zone. Up to seven (7) shops may have minimum floor areas of 500m², whilst at least three (3) premises must have floor areas greater than 1 000m². No changes to the types of retailing is proposed, but the condition has been expanded to include all retail uses set out in the definition of "Peripheral Sales" in the Mordialloc Planning Scheme.

SUNSHINE PLANNING SCHEME

Notice of Amendment to a Planning Scheme
Amendment L51, Parts 1, 2 and 3

The City of Sunshine has prepared Amendment L51, Parts 1, 2 and 3 to the Sunshine Planning Scheme.

Part 1

This amendment affects land in Hampstead Road, bounded by Creffden Street and is occupied by the Footscray West Mail Centre.

The amendment proposes to rezone the total site from Public Purpose (Office of Defence Production) Reservation to Manufacturing Zone 3.

Part 2

This amendment proposes to formally close a disused right-of-way between Barb Street and Chicago Street, Maribymong. The land is currently zoned Residential "C" as are all abutting properties. The effect of this amendment will be the introduction of a Road Closure reservation over the existing zoning of the land.

Part 3

This amendment proposes to modify the Sunshine District Centre No. 2 Zone so as to provide the following:

- delete requirement for a child minding centre, baby changing facilities and public toilets.

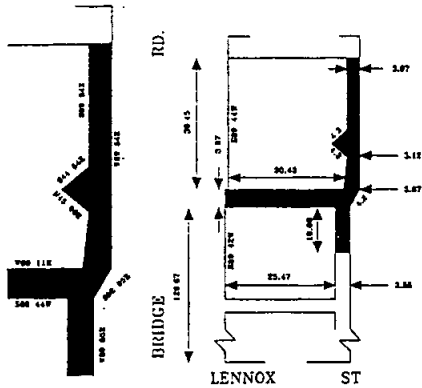

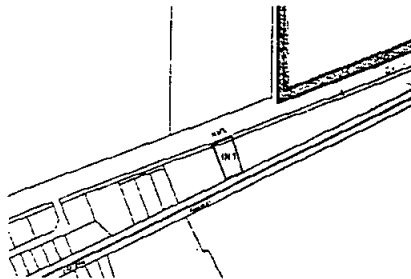
The City of Traralgon has prepared Amendment L46 to the Traralgon (City) Planning Scheme.

WESTERN REGIONAL REFUSE DISPOSAL GROUP

By Law (Local Law) No. 1 of 1993—Meeting Procedure

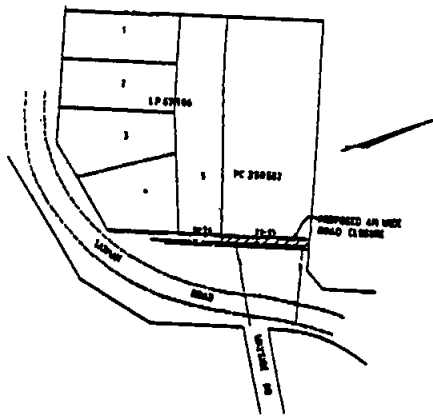

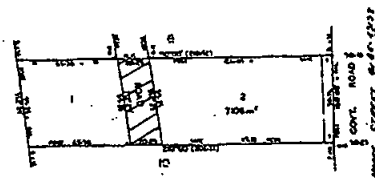

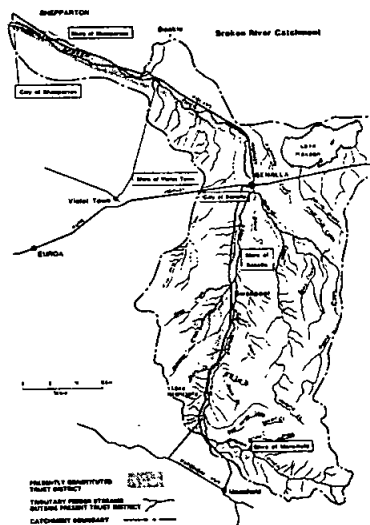

- (b) whether he did in or about July 1992, as Officer in the State of Victoria supply to Mr Claude Senior Vitamin E-Selen injection solution for administration to an animal other than for the treatment of an animal under his care;
- (c) whether at Stockwell Stud, Diggers Rest, contrary to Regulation 1001 (4) of the Drugs, Poisons and Controlled Substances Regulations 1985 and/or good veterinary practice he did supply restricted substances to Mr Michael Becker for use by Stockwell Stud other than in accordance with that Regulation.

The Board found Dr Cleeland guilty on all three counts and inflicted the following penalty:

Charges (a) and (b): Fine of \$100 plus costs of \$1055 being costs of and incidental to the inquiry.

Charge (c): Severe reprimand.

Fine of \$500 plus costs of \$3224 being costs of and incidental to the inquiry.

Additional costs of \$1890 being costs of and incidental to an adjourned inquiry hearing.

A stay of three months for payment of fine and costs was granted.

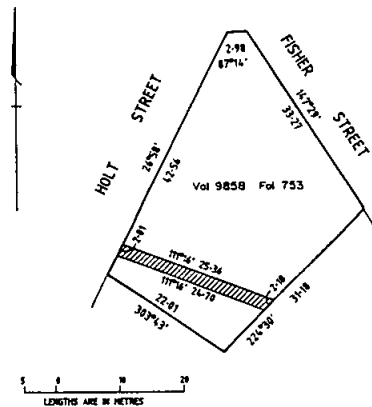
