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

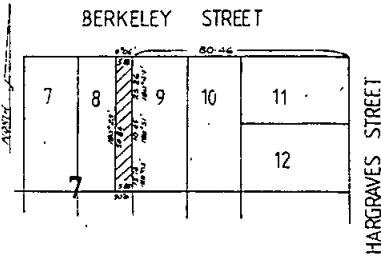

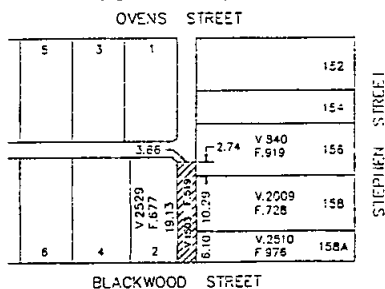

Horse-Drawn Vehicles and Pedicabs Local Law

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A permit if issued will detail the conditions which the permit-holder must comply and these conditions are detailed in clause 10 (2) of the Local Law.

Control over the issuing of permits and enforcement of the Local Law will lie the Council's Traffic Services Division. The RSPCA has agreed to provide professional expert assistance in respect of those matters concerning the welfare of the animals.

A copy of the Local Law can be obtained free of charge from the Office of the Town Clerk, 3rd Floor, Town Hall, Swanston Street, Melbourne, during office hours (i.e. 8.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. daily from Monday to Friday).

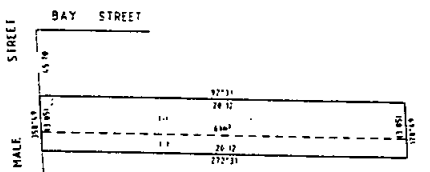

STATUTORY RULES 1993

No. 146

Legal Profession Practice Act 1958

Rules of the Council of Legal Education (Mutual Recognition Act Amendment) 1993

Pursuant to the authority conferred on the Council of Legal Education by the **Legal Profession Practice Act 1958**, the Council makes the following Rules:

1. Title

These Rules may be cited as the "Rules of the Council of Legal Education (Mutual Recognition Act Amendment) 1993".

2. Principal Rules

In these Rules the *Rules of the Council of Legal Education 1985 are called "the Principal Rules".

3. Amendment of Rule 3 (1) (b)

In Rule 3 (1) (b) of the Principal Rules, for "and Deakin University" substitute ", Deakin University and Northern Territory University".

4. New Rules 54 to 64—Mutual Recognition

After Rule 53 of the Principal Rules, the following is inserted—

**"PART VI—MUTUAL RECOGNITION ACT
ADMISSIONS**

54. (1) This Part shall apply to the admission of interstate practitioners to practise as barristers and solicitors of the Supreme Court in accordance with the mutual recognition

principle enacted in Part 3 of the Mutual Recognition Act 1992 (Cth).

- (2) Parts I to V of these Rules shall not apply to admissions to practise as barristers and solicitors of interstate practitioners of the Supreme Court in accordance with the mutual recognition principle enacted in Part 3 of the Mutual Recognition Act 1992 (Cth).
- (3) The Rules in this Part shall cease to operate upon the expiry of the **Mutual Recognition (Vic) Act 1993**.
- (4) In this Part, unless the contrary intention appears—

“**Act**” means the Mutual Recognition Act 1992 (Cth);

“**barrister**” and “**solicitor**” have the meaning attributed to them by the **Legal Profession Practice Act 1958**;

“**admission**” means admission to practise as a barrister and solicitor in Victoria in accordance with the mutual recognition principle enacted in Part 3 of the Act as applying to the occupation of barrister and solicitor;

“**notice**” means a written notice seeking admission pursuant to section 19 (1) of the Act and complying with the requirements of that section and of Part VI of these Rules;

“**the Board**” means the Board of Examiners appointed pursuant to Part II of these Rules;

“**interstate practitioner**” has the same meaning as in Part I of these Rules.

55. Every interstate practitioner applying for admission in accordance with these Rules must lodge a notice

in the form prescribed by these Rules with the Secretary of the Board.

56. An applicant for admission shall, prior to lodgment of a notice, pay all fees payable pursuant to section 9 of the **Legal Profession Practice Act 1958** and pursuant to the Supreme Court (Fees) Regulations 1991 as amended, and evidence of such payment shall be produced to the Secretary of the Board at the time of lodgment of the notice.
57. Upon receipt of a notice, the Secretary of the Board shall—
 - (a) post a notice at the office of the Prothonotary of the name of the applicant, the State or Territory in which the applicant is admitted as a legal practitioner, and the fact of the application; and
 - (b) carry out such investigations and make such inquiries as the Board deems appropriate to obtain any information relevant to admission or to grounds for a postponement or refusal of a grant of admission.
58. The Secretary of the Board shall consider a notice and any accompanying documents within one month after the notice was lodged and—
 - (a) if it appears that the applicant for admission has complied with the provisions of the Act and of these Rules, the Secretary of the Board may issue a Certificate to that effect in the form prescribed by these Rules;
 - (b) if it appears that the applicant is not entitled to a grant of admission or that one of the reasons for postponement or refusal of admission prescribed by the Act exists, the Secretary of the Board shall refer the notice and any accompanying documents to the Board for its consideration.
59. In respect of any notice and accompanying documents lodged with the Secretary or referred to it by the Secretary, the Board may consider the

- application for admission and may direct the issue of a Certificate that the applicant is entitled to admission or postpone or refuse the application for admission for a reason prescribed by the Act.
60. An interstate practitioner applying to be admitted may, on lodging a notice, elect not to appear in person on the hearing of the motion for admission.
 61. Every applicant for admission electing not to appear in person in Court shall take the oaths required by section 5 (2) of the **Legal Profession Practice Act 1958** and sign a proforma for insertion in a roll of barristers and solicitors kept by the Prothonotary before the principal registrar of the Supreme Court of another State or of a Territory or before such other officer of such Court as may be designated by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Victoria, and shall return forthwith the proforma and a certificate of the administration of the oaths in the form prescribed by these Rules to the Secretary of the Board.
 62. The Certificate of the Secretary of the Board on which the applicant for admission relies and the notice and all accompanying documents shall be produced to the Court by the Secretary of the Board, and the production thereof shall be treated as a motion for admission of the applicant.
 63. A motion for an admission may be made to a Judge of the Supreme Court of Victoria sitting in the Practice Court.
 64. Any person may show cause to the Board or to the Court why an applicant should not be admitted.”.

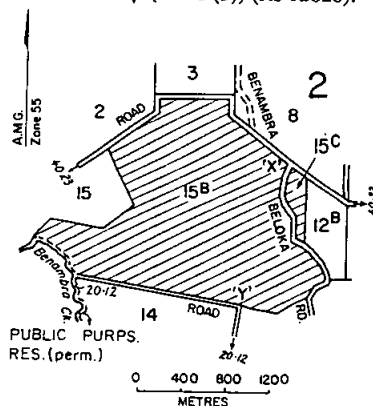

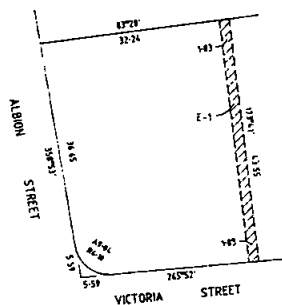

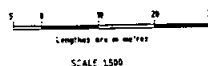
