Notice of Amendment to a Planning Scheme
Amendment L35

CITY OF CAMBERWELL
Protection of Roads, Council Land and
Council Assets
Local Law No. 5

Notice is hereby given that, at its meeting on 27 September 1993, the Council of the City of Camberwell pursuant to section 119 of the *Local Government Act 1989* made a Local Law entitled City of Camberwell (Protection of Roads, Council Land and Council Assets) Local Law No. 5.

The purposes of the Local Law are to—

1. provide for the peace, order and good government of the municipal district of the City of Camberwell; and
2. prohibit, regulate and control activities, events, practices or behaviour which may cause damage to or interference with roads, Council land and Council assets; and
3. protect roads, Council land and Council assets.

The general purport of the Local Law is summarised as follows:

1. To prevent damage to or interference with Council land or assets.
2. To recover the cost of reinstatement or repair of any damage done to Council land or assets.
3. To provide for the construction or removal of permanent vehicle crossings, and the recovery of costs.
4. To provide for the provision of temporary vehicle crossings to protect Council assets.
5. To prevent damage to or interference with barriers, lights or other equipment placed on roads or other Council land.
6. To provide for the removal or alteration of structures, plants or other items in easements, when required, to enable works or maintenance to be carried out on drains within the easement by a public authority.
7. To provide for the issue of permits and collection of permit fees, and for the lodging and use of security deposits, in respect to works likely to affect Council land or assets.
8. To provide for penalties upon conviction for an offence against the Local Law.
9. To provide for infringement notices and fixed penalties for offences against the Local Law.

COBURG CITY COUNCIL
Environmental Health (Animals and Birds)
Local Law No. 18

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Coburg proposes to make a Local Law for the following purposes:

To regulate the keeping of—

- (a) dogs;
- (b) cats;

- (c) animals (other than cats and dogs);
- (d) domestic birds;
- (e) poultry;
- (f) other birds;
- (g) bees;
- (h) rodents; and
- (i) reptiles.

The general purport of Local Law No. 18 is as follows:

1. To regulate the keeping of—
 - (a) dogs;
 - (b) cats;
 - (c) animals (other than cats and dogs);
 - (d) domestic birds;
 - (e) poultry;
 - (f) other birds;
 - (g) bees;
 - (h) rodents; and
 - (i) reptiles—

by requiring a permit to be obtained.

2. To restrict the number of dogs kept by occupiers of land in a prescribed size area.
3. To restrict the number of cats kept by occupiers of land in a prescribed size area.
4. To restrict the number of animals (other than dogs or cats) kept by occupiers of land in a prescribed size area.
5. To restrict the number of domestic birds and poultry kept by occupiers of land in a prescribed area.
6. To restrict the number of other birds kept by occupiers of land in a prescribed size area.
7. To restrict the keeping of bees by occupiers of land in a prescribed size area.
8. To restrict the number of rodents and reptiles kept by occupiers of land in a prescribed size area.
9. To require the keeping of dogs, cats, animals, domestic birds, poultry, birds, bees, rodents and reptiles in a clean environment.
10. To prohibit noise or smell to emanate from land where any dog, cat, animal, domestic bird, poultry, bird, bee, rodent or reptile is kept.
11. To regulate the application, currency, correction and registration of permits.
12. To provide for offences if a person contravenes or fails to comply with the Local Law.

Any person affected by the proposed Local Law may make a submission relating to the proposed Local Law under section 223 of the *Local Government Act 1989*, and all submissions must be lodged within fourteen (14) days of the publication of this notice.

GREATER GEELONG PLANNING SCHEME
Notice of Amendment to a Planning Scheme
Amendment RL42

The City of Greater Geelong has prepared Amendment RL42 to the Greater Geelong Planning Scheme.

The amendment proposes to change the Regional Section of the Planning Scheme by—

- (i) Rezoning (approximately 3000 m² of) land on the north west corner of Beach Road and Surf Coast Highway, Torquay from Reserved Residential to Local Business.
- (ii) Inserting an Ordinance Amendment to the Local Section to restrict the use and development of 67 Surf Coast Highway to that illustrated by the ROJO—Torquay Concept Plan. This includes the use of the site for a warehouse and retail outlet for sports and surf apparel, an office and associated business activities of ROJO Australia Pty Ltd.

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CITY OF HAWTHORN

Local Law No. 2

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Hawthorn pursuant to section 119 of the *Local Government Act* 1989 intends at its ordinary meeting to be held on 23 November 1993 to make Local Law No. 2.

The purpose of the Local Law is to—

- (a) provide for the peace, order and good government of the municipal district of the City of Hawthorn; and
- (b) provide for those matters which require a Local Law under the *Local Government Act* 1989 and any other Act; and
- (c) provide for the administration of Council powers and functions; and
- (d) prohibit, regulate and control activities, events, practices or behaviour in places so that no detriment is caused to the amenity of the neighbourhood, nor nuisance to a person nor detrimental effect to a person's property.

The general purpose of the Local Law is summarised as follows:

- (i) *Use of Common Seal*
To provide for use of the Common Seal, and prohibit use of the Common Seal (or a device resembling the Common Seal) without the authority of Council.
- (ii) *Election of Mayor*
To regulate the proceedings for the election of Mayor.
- (iii) *Meeting Procedures*
To regulate the meeting procedures of Council, special and advisory committees regarding—
 - quorums, commencement of meetings, adjournments;
 - order of business to be conducted at meetings and circulation of agendas;
 - minutes;
 - general meeting procedures;
 - correspondence, petitions and joint letters.
- (iv) *Protection of Council land*
To protect Council land in relation to the following actions:
 - interfering with or destroying sewers, drains and water courses;

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construction of permanent or temporary vehicle crossings;
destroying, damaging or lighting fires on Council land;
trees or plants causing damage to Council land;
use of mobile crane without permit.

(v) *Use of Council land*

To enable the use and enjoyment of Council land without nuisance or disturbance.

This includes requirements regarding:

Municipal Buildings—

hours;
availability and hire;
prohibitions on entry;
behaviour of persons;
prohibited articles.

Hawthorn Aquatic and Leisure Centre—

prohibitions on entry;
behaviour of persons;
prohibited articles;
lost property;
dress requirements.

Hawthorn City Library—

membership of Library;
conditions of borrowing;
conduct in the Library;
use of the Library;
confidentiality.

Public Reserves and Recreation Lands—

management committees;
access to reserves;
use of reserves;
behaviour in reserves;
liability in reserves;
wetlands and fountains.

Roads and Council land—

behaviour on roads, public places and Council land;
dog litter;
shopping trolleys;
spitting;
advertising signs, chairs and table, obstructions;
repairing vehicles;
consumption of liquor;
animals;

collection bins.

(vi) *Parking Schemes*

To control the issue of Resident and Disabled Persons parking permits, Parking Meters and Ticket Machines.

(vii) *Sale of Goods, Street Selling, Collections and Distributions*

To control the sale of goods other than from premises or land from which sale of goods are authorised under any other legislation and to regulate house to house collections and distributions of materials.

Without a permit it is an offence to—

- engage in itinerant trade;
- sell goods from any temporary structure, building or receptacle;
- appeal for money or gifts on any street or road.

(viii) *Protection of the Amenity of the Municipal District*

General: The Local Law specifies that a person must—

- not keep land in an unsightly or dangerous manner;
- without a permit not use land for storage, dismantling or breaking up of old vehicles or machinery or for camping;
- exterminate vermin and noxious weeds;
- not obscure intersections with trees and plants;
- take fire preventative measures;
- display property numbers on properties;
- not cause noise which is an annoyance or nuisance;
- not place advertisements or graffiti on any road, public place or Council land;
- nor remove or demolish a building without a certificate from a Council Health Surveyor or Environmental Health Officer.

Open Air Burning and Incinerators: The Local Law specifies that without a permit—

- no person will construct, erect, install or use an incinerator;
- no person shall light or permit to remain alight any fire in the open air on specified days;

no person shall cause or allow any dangerous or annoying substances to be burnt.

Building Siting Requirements—

provides minimum siting requirements for buildings.

Dilapidated Buildings—

requires owners or occupiers to carry out work on dilapidated buildings.

Building Operation Hours—

no person shall erect, construct, repair or demolish any building outside specific building operation hours without a permit.

(ix) *Keeping of Animals*

To control animals in the City of Hawthorn—

- provide numbers of animals which may be kept without a permit;
- specifications for poultry houses, kennels and pigeon lofts;
- requirements on cleanliness and noise.

(x) *Health*

To promote a physical and social environment free of hazards to health, to maintain the Municipal District at all times in a clean and sanitary condition, and prevent and remedy all nuisances or conditions liable to be dangerous to health or offensive to people.

Specifies conditions on the disposal of domestic waste and trade waste, use of rubbish hoppers, night soil, animal premises and drains.

(xi) *Permits*

To provide the method for obtaining permits under other provisions of the Local Law.

A person must apply to the Council in writing, including any fee. The Council may require more information, and reject or accept the permit.

(xii) *Infringement Notices*

To provide for infringement notices to be issued where a person is believed to be guilty of an offence listed in Schedule 2 of the Local Law.

(xiii) *Enforcement*

To provide for enforcement of the Local Law, by any authorised officer.

Any person affected by the proposed Local Law may make a submission to Council relating to the proposed Local Law in accordance with section 223 of the *Local Government Act 1989*.

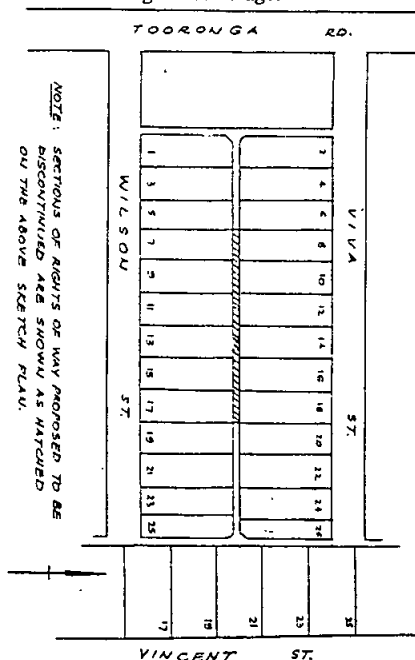

Pursuant to section 207 (2) (a) of the *Local Government Act 1989*, the Council of the City of Malvern after consultation with Public Authorities and the advertising of its intention and notification to the registered proprietors of the land and owners and occupiers of any land abutting the right of way, resolved at its ordinary meeting held on 17 May 1993, as follows:

- (a) That the right-of-way abutting properties 7-17 Wilson Street and 8-18 Viva Street as shown hatched on the plan hereunder shall be discontinued upon publication of this resolution in the *Government Gazette* subject to Melbourne Water and the City of Malvern continuing to have and possess the same right, title, power, authority or interest in or in relation to the whole of the land shown by hatching on the said plan as it had or possessed prior to such discontinuance with respect to or in connection with any drains or pipes laid or erected in on or over such land for the purposes of drainage or sewerage.



- (b) The land contained in the said right-of-way shall vest in the City of Malvern and may be sold by private treaty.

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS

1. Rescission Motions

To amend the existing paragraph L9.40 with the following wording:

For a decision of the Council to be amended or rescinded the motion for the amendment or rescission must be carried by a majority of votes cast.

Explanation

This will correct the present situation where the Local Law was inconsistent with the provisions of section 90 (1) (d) of the Local Government Act.

2. Council Seal

The existing paragraph provides that the person who must sign the affixing of the seal are the Chairperson, one Councillor and the Shire Secretary . . . etc.

The proposed new provision is:

That the seal be used on the authority of Council and every document to which the seal is

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affixed must be signed by the Municipal Clerk or some other Senior Officer authorised by him or her, and two other Councillors.

Explanation

This is restoring the same provision as Council used in its previous meeting procedure by law.

Local Law No. 8

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Shire of Cranbourne has resolved to adopt a Local Law to be known as the Streets Local Law, pursuant to section 119 of the *Local Government Act* 1989 (as amended).

The purpose and general purport of the proposed Local Law is to regulate traffic and the use of roads by persons, vehicles and animals and to provide for the safe and fair use of roads by people in the municipal district; to provide for the peace, order and well being of people in the municipal district; to provide for the physical features of roads and adjacent properties to be managed in a way which improves the safety and convenience of people travelling on or using roads (whether by foot or by vehicle); to preserve and protect as far as possible roads and road facilities from damage; to control and regulate activities on roads including the placing of goods and equipment, repairs to vehicles, parties, festivals and processions, in a fair, equitable and safe manner which does not compromise the primary need for the passage of vehicles, people and goods on roads; to protect against behaviour which causes detriment to the amenity and environment of the municipal district; and to protect the community interest.

Local Law No. 5—Environment

The Council of the Shire of Euroa gives notice that on 20 September 1993, it made Local Law No. 5—Environment, with the following purposes:

- (a) to provide a safe and healthy environment in which the residents of the municipal district enjoy a quality of life that meets the general expectations of the community; and
- (b) to prohibit, regulate and control activities which may be dangerous or unsafe or detrimental to the quality of life that meets the general expectations of the community; and
- (c) to facilitate the provision of general public services, health and other community services, property services, recreational and cultural services, and other services in a way which enhances the environment and quality of life in the municipal district; and
- (d) to control nuisances and noise, odour and smoke emissions, and other discharges to the environment which may adversely affect the enjoyment of life within the municipal district of health, safety and welfare of persons within the municipal district; and
- (e) in a way which is consistent with, and in furtherance of, the objectives specified in paragraphs (a) to (d) of this clause to prohibit, regulate and control activities and circumstances associated with—
 - (i) smoke emission, particularly emission from burning material and from chimneys; and
 - (ii) the use of recreational vehicles, particularly recreational vehicles which are not used on appropriate land or reserves or which emit excessive noise or air pollution; and
 - (iii) dangerous and unsightly land; and
 - (iv) swimming pools; and

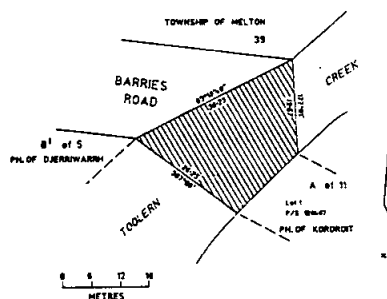

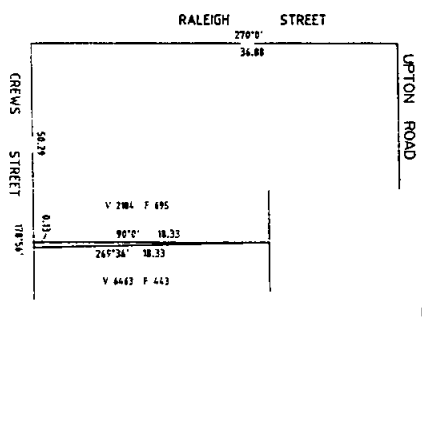

3. All of the following cranes must comply with the notification requirements specified in section 13 (1) of the *Lifts and Cranes Act 1967*:

- (a) tower cranes;
- (b) personnel and material hoists, stage hoists, guided hoists between floors, and vehicle hoists;
- (c) aerial ropeways;
- (d) bridge and gantry cranes, and portal cranes with a maximum safe working load greater than 10 tonnes; and

(e) building maintenance units, when being set up, or set or placed in position, or when a new model is being built.

When the first crane of a new model is built, any further cranes of that model to be built are exempt from the building notification requirement.

4. Swing stages must comply with the notification requirements specified in section 13 (1) of the *Lifts and Cranes Act 1967* when a new model is being built, or set up, or set or placed in position on a building for the first time, but they are exempted from further notification when set up, or set or placed in position on the same building.

When the first swing stage of a new model is built, any further swing stages of that model to be built are exempt from the building notification requirement.

5. All other cranes are exempted from the notification requirements specified in section 13 (1) of the *Lifts and Cranes Act 1967*.

Note: This exemption does not remove the requirement to obtain approval for workboxes as defined in the *Cranes (Suspended Personnel) Regulations 1992*.
