CORRIGENDUM

The City of Collingwood has prepared this amendment to the Local Section of the Collingwood Planning Scheme.

Previously published Notice of Amendment to the Collingwood Planning Scheme No. L19 was incorrectly printed in *Government Gazette* No. G41—Printed on 21 October 1993 and is herewith withdrawn.

The amendment proposes to rezone land bounded by Ramsden, Field, Roseneath Streets and the right-of-way at the rear of Yambra Street properties (east side), Clifton Hill, from Public Purposes—State Electricity Commission Proposed Public Purposes—State Electricity Commission and Light Industrial to Residential C.

The amendment also introduces a new clause into the provisions of the Residential C zone to enable redevelopment of the land for residential purposes in accordance with a development plan prepared to the satisfaction of the Responsible Authority.

The residential development proposed and regulated by this amendment incorporates:

- 158 units comprising a range of one, two, three and four bedroom accommodation;
- communal recreation areas including swimming pools, a tennis court and garden areas for residents of the development;
- provision of not less than 167 car parking spaces on the land;
- construction and landscaping of Field Street adjoining the land, improvement to components of Ramsden and Roseneath Streets adjoining the land and reconstruction of a right-of-way along the western boundary of the land; and
- landscape treatment on the land.

Notice of Adoption of Local Laws Nos 2 and 3

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Bairnsdale at its meeting on Monday, 11 October 1993, made Local Laws Nos 2 and 3 to be operative from 11 October 1993, pursuant to the provisions of the *Local Government Act* 1989.

Local Law No. 2—Environmental Health Local Law

The Local Law is made for the purposes of—

- (a) prohibit the presence of vermin and noxious weeds on land;
- (b) prevent land from becoming unsightly, dangerous or detrimental to the area in which it is located;
- (c) regulate the storage, assembly and dismantling of old or used motor vehicles, machinery or second hand goods;
- (d) regulate the lighting of fires in incinerators and in the open air;
- (e) prevent accidents and illnesses by restricting access to private swimming pools, and requiring these swimming pools to be maintained in a clean and sanitary state;
- (f) regulate camping on private land, Council land and roads;
- (g) regulate the erection, establishment and occupation of temporary dwellings;
- (h) regulate the holding of circuses, carnivals, festivals and like events;
- (i) prevent drains on private land from becoming unsightly or dangerous to health;
- (j) prevent trade premises from becoming offensive, unsanitary or dangerous to health;
- (k) prohibit the deposit of nightsoil on land or in watercourses;

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- (l) prohibit the presence of European wasps and European wasp nests on land;
- (m) regulate the keeping of animals (including dogs, cats and horses), poultry and bees;
- (n) regulate activities at the municipal tip;
- (o) regulate the storage and keeping of trade waste;
- (p) regulate the transportation of waste;
- (q) regulate the disposal and collection of household refuse and garbage; and
- (r) regulate the disposal and collection of recyclable material.

Local Law No. 3—Street Management and Protection of Physical Assets Local Law

The purpose of this Local Law is to—

- (a) prevent accidents and damage by regulating the growing of vegetation on land;
- (b) provide for the display of property numbers;
- (c) prohibit the leaving of shopping trolleys in various locations, and provide for the impounding of shopping trolleys found in those locations;
- (d) regulate the placing of signs and goods on roads;
- (e) regulate street trading;
- (f) regulate street collecting;
- (g) regulate the establishment of outdoor eating facilities;
- (h) regulate the distribution of handbills and other materials in various locations;
- (i) provide for the amenity and safety of roads by regulating the repair of vehicles and prohibiting the deposit of spoil on the same;
- (j) prohibit the abandoning of vehicles and provide for the impounding of abandoned and derelict vehicles;
- (k) regulate the operation and use of motorised vehicles;
- (l) secure the physical assets of Council;
- (m) regulate the driving of livestock within the municipal district;
- (n) regulate the grazing of animals on roads;
- (o) regulate the storage and keeping of trade waste;

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- (p) provide for and regulate the construction of vehicle crossings; and
- (q) regulate other activities on roads.

2. To prevent the placing or leaving of materials, bins, signs, goods, equipment or items of any nature on footpaths, roads or other public areas except in approved areas or with a permit.
3. To control the occupation of any part of a road for works, or the erection of hoardings or the use of mobile cranes or elevated work platforms on roads.
4. To prevent work on vehicles on a road or other public place except for the purpose of putting it into a serviceable condition so that it may continue a bona fide journey.
5. To control street parties, festivals and processions, street busking, and the collection of donations or subscriptions on footpaths, roads and other public areas.
6. To prevent the parking of vehicles on roads or other public places for the primary purpose of displaying an advertisement.
7. To provide for the impounding of goods, materials, equipment, unregistered or abandoned vehicles or items of any nature which have been placed or left on any road or other public place without the necessary approval or permit, or contrary to the conditions of any approval or permit, or contrary to any Act, regulation or other Local Law.
8. To provide for the issue of permits and collection of permit fees.
9. To provide for penalties upon conviction for an offence against the Local Law.
10. To provide for infringement notices and fixed penalties for offences against the Local Law.

Obstruction of Streets and Roads
Local Law No. 6

Notice is hereby given that at its meeting on 18 October 1993, the Council of the City of Camberwell, pursuant to section 119 of the *Local Government Act 1989*, made a Local Law entitled City of Camberwell (Obstruction of Streets and Roads) Local Law No. 6.

The purposes of the Local Law are to:

1. Provide for the peace, order and good government of the municipal district of Camberwell; and
2. Prohibit, regulate and control activities, events, practices, occurrences or behaviour which may cause an encroachment, obstruction, danger or nuisance in streets, roads and Council land within the municipality; and
3. Control and regulate secondary activities on streets, roads and Council land, including—
 - (a) trading;
 - (b) the placing of materials, goods, equipment or items;
 - (c) collection of monies;
 - (d) repairs to vehicles;
 - (e) parties, festivals and processions—in a fair, equitable and safe manner which does not compromise the primary need for the passage of people, goods and vehicles; and
4. Maintain and manage roads and public highways.

The general purport of the Local Law is summarised as follows:

1. To prevent obstruction of roads, footpaths, bicycle paths and other public places, and the obscuring of

Environmental Health (Open Air Burning and Incinerators) (Amendment No. 1)

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Coburg proposes to make a Local Law for the following purposes:

- (a) To amend the Environmental Health (Open Air Burning and Incinerators) Local Law No. 5; and

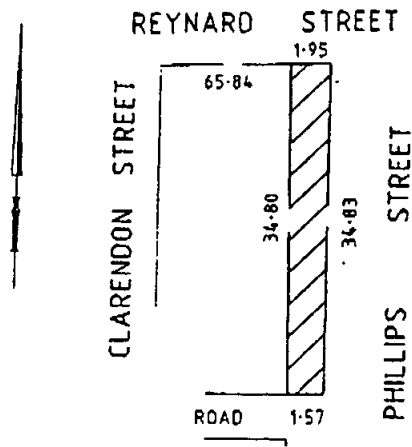

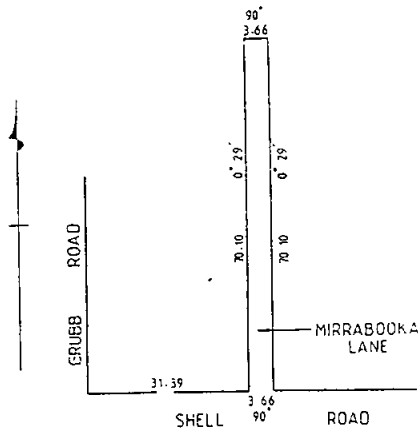
- (b) The land in the said road subject to any such right, title, power, authority or interest vesting in the municipality, and shall be retained by the Council until sold by Private Treaty.

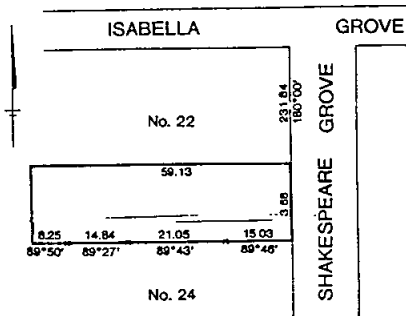

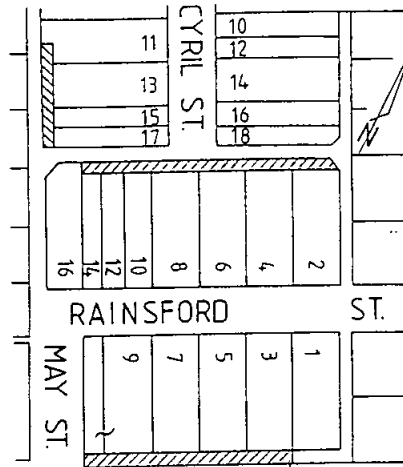

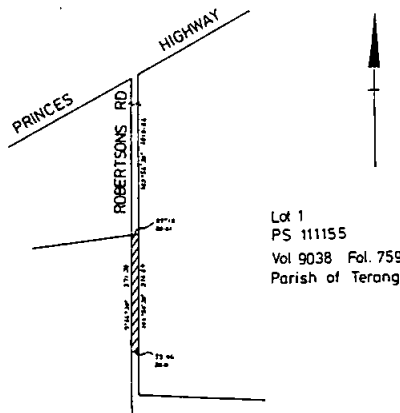

Victorian Dairy Industry Authority
DETERMINATION

This Determination is made by the Victorian Dairy Industry Authority under the powers conferred by section 61 of the *Dairy Industry Act 1992* and shall come into operation on 1 November 1993.

The Determination of milk prices made by the Victorian Dairy Industry Authority and published in the *Government Gazette* dated 21 April 1993, 3 June 1993 and 22 July 1993 is revoked.

DETERMINATION

Part 1

PRICES PAYABLE FOR SALES OF MILK

The prices payable for sales of daily pasteurised milk other than flavoured milk in Victoria shall be in accordance with Schedule 1.

The price for sales of packaged ultra heat treated milk other than flavoured milk in Victoria shall not be less than the prices shown in Schedule 2.

The prices payable for milk and milk products in the package types as shown in column 1 of the attached schedules shall be as indicated in the appropriate columns according to the category of sale.

The categories of sales are defined as:

- (1) Wholesale sales are those by a milk processor to a milk distributor (column 2).
- (2) Semi-wholesale sales are those by a milk distributor to a milk shop, or other approved person (column 3).
- (3) Retail sales are sales by a milk distributor or milk processor of not more than 16 litres to a person on any one day, or any sale made by any other person (column 4).
- (4) Export sales are sales for the purpose of human consumption as a liquid beyond the territorial limits of the Commonwealth of Australia.
- (5) An institutional sale is a sale by a milk distributor to:
 - (a) A registered funded agency or a health service establishment as described in section 3, Part 1 of the *Health Services Act 1988*; or
 - (b) An institution which is operated under the Community Welfare Services Act.
- (6) Sales to institutions by a milk distributor may be at 95% of the gazetted minimum semi-wholesale delivered prices.

"Ultra heat treated milk (or UHT milk)" is milk that is processed by subjecting the product to a temperature of not less than 132°C for not less than one second and aseptically packaging it in approved hermetically sealed packages.

"Flavoured Milk" is milk to which flavouring, as defined in the Food Standards Code, has been added so as to alter the odour or taste of the milk to an appreciable extent.

The following interpretations as stated in section 3 of the *Dairy Industry Act 1992* shall apply in Part 2 of this determination of prices:

"Factory" means any premises where—

- (a) milk is received direct from a dairy farm; or
- (b) dairy produce (other than market milk) is manufactured or packed.

"Milk processing premises" means any premises where market milk is pasteurised or packed.

Part 2

PRICES PAYABLE FOR MILK SUPPLIED TO PROCESSORS BY THE AUTHORITY

The Authority has determined that the following prices must be paid for milk sold by the Authority to milk processors.

- (a) Standardised raw milk for processing as dairy pasteurised milk for sale in Victoria will be:
 - (i) for flavoured milk and low fat flavoured milk marketed under processor (non VDIA) brands—50.73 cents per litre.
 - (ii) for all other milk—51.49 cents per litre.
- (b) Standardised raw milk for processing as daily pasteurised milk for sale in Australia but outside Victoria will be:
 - (i) for flavoured milk and low fat flavoured milk marketed under processor (non VDIA) brands—49.45 cents per litre.
 - (ii) for all other milk—49.45 cents per litre.
- (c) Standardised raw milk for processing as daily pasteurised milk for sale by export will be 28.15 cents per litre where the milk is appropriated in accordance with section 51 (1) (b) of the *Dairy Industry Act 1992* and 34.59 cents per litre when delivered by the Authority to milk processing premises.
- (d) Standardised raw milk for processing as daily pasteurised ultra filtered milk for sale in Victoria will be 40.75 cents per litre.
- (e) Standardised raw milk for processing as daily pasteurised ultra filtered milk for sale in Australia but outside Victoria will be 39.96 cents per litre.
- (f) Standardised raw milk for processing as daily pasteurised reverse osmosis milk "Challenge" for sale in Victoria will be 42.39 cents per litre.
- (g) Standardised raw milk for processing as daily pasteurised reverse osmosis milk "Challenge" for sale in Australia but outside Victoria will be 41.52 cents per litre.
- (h) Standardised raw milk for processing as ultra heat treated milk for sale in Australia will be 31.92 cents per litre where the milk is appropriated in accordance with section 51 (1) (b) of the *Dairy Industry Act 1992* and 34.36 cents per litre when delivered by the Authority to milk processing premises.
- (i) Standardised raw milk for processing as ultra heat treated milk for sale by export will be 28.15 cents per litre where the milk is appropriated in accordance with section 51 (1) (b) of the *Dairy Industry Act 1992* and 30.59 cents per litre when delivered by the Authority to milk processing premises.
- (j) Standardised raw milk for processing as reverse osmosis ultra heat treated milk "Challenge" for sale in Australia will be 31.92 cents per litre where the milk is appropriated in accordance with section 51 (1) (b) of the *Dairy Industry Act 1992*.
- (k) Standardised raw milk for processing as sterilised milk for sale by export will be 28.15 cents per litre where the milk is appropriated in accordance with section 51 (1) (b) of the *Dairy Industry Act 1992* and 30.59 cents per litre when delivered by the Authority to milk processing premises.
- (l) Standardised raw milk for processing as daily pasteurised organic and bio-dynamic milk for sale in Victoria will be 55.51 cents per litre.
- (m) Standardised raw milk for processing as daily pasteurised organic and bio-dynamic milk for sale in Australia but outside Victoria will be 53.35 cents per litre.

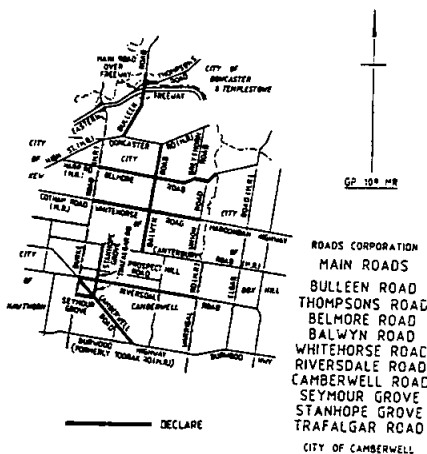

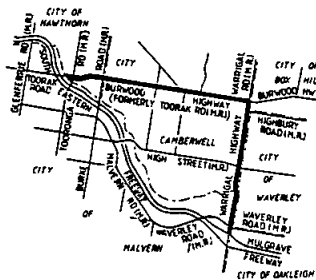

Retirement Villages Act 1986

SECTION 6

Declaration of Exemption

Under the powers found in section 6 of the *Retirement Villages Act 1986*, the Governor in Council on the recommendation of the Attorney-General, declares:

The Brickendon Lodge managed by R. C. and L. D. Nominees Pty Ltd ("the Manager") and situated at Lot 52 Brickendon Drive, Rosebud to be an exempt village for the purposes of the following provisions of the *Retirement Villages Act 1986* ("the Act");

1. Section 13;
2. Section 14 sub-sections (1), (2), (3) and (4) upon condition that:

- (1) A contract which is entered into between a resident and the Manager and which creates or gives rise to a residence right binds the owners and successors in title of the owners while the contract remains in force as if the owners

and successors had also entered into the contract.

- (2) In paragraph 2 (1) "successor in title" includes a person who acquires any interest in or right affecting land or has a mortgage, charge or other encumbrance over land.
3. Section 16 upon the following conditions:
 - (1) If a resident is in breach of a provision of a residence contract the Manager may serve on the resident a notice specifying the breach and—
 - (a) requiring the breach to be remedied;
 - (b) if the breach is not capable of being remedied, requiring the resident to cease committing the breach—

within 28 days after the date of service of the notice.

- (2) If—
- (a) the Manager has served on a resident a notice under paragraph 3 (1); and
 - (b) the resident has not complied with the notice at the end of 28 days after the date of service of the notice; and
 - (c) the breach specified in the notice is substantial—
- the Manager may serve on the resident a notice specifying the breach and requiring the resident to leave the retirement village on or before a date stated in the notice, which is not earlier than 60 days after the date of service of the notice.
- (3) If a resident has a residence right by virtue of a contract which creates a periodic tenancy the Manager may serve on the resident notice requiring the resident to leave the retirement village on a date which is not earlier than—
- (a) six months after the date of service of the notice; or
 - (b) the end of the period of the tenancy—
- whichever last happens.
- (4) The Manager may serve on a resident a notice requiring the resident to leave the retirement village within 14 days after the service of the notice if—
- (a) the residence contract authorises the giving of the notice and, if the contract includes conditions which must be complied with before the notice can be given, those conditions have been complied with; and
 - (b) the notice includes a copy of a certificate signed by 2 legally qualified medical practitioners, one of whom is nominated or agreed to by the resident and stating to the effect that the resident needs care of a kind which is not available at the retirement village.
- (5) A notice under these paragraphs may be served on a resident personally or by post addressed to the resident at the resident's address in the retirement village or at the resident's last known address.
4. Section 19 upon condition that, before a resident enters into any residence contract, the Manager or the Manager's agent gives to the resident all residence documents as defined in the Act relating to the village;
5. Section 24 sub-sections (2), (3), (4), (5), (6) and (7) upon condition that:
- (1) A resident who signs a residence contract may at any time before the end of the period of 21 business days after signing the contract give notice to the Manager that the resident wishes to rescind the contract and, where the resident has signed the notice and given it in accordance with this paragraph, the contract is rescinded.
 - (2) A notice under paragraph 5 (1) must be given to the Manager or the Manager's agent or left at the address for service of the Manager specified in the residence contract or the address of the Manager's agent within 21 clear business days after the resident signs the contract.
 - (3) If a resident rescinds a contract under these paragraphs the resident is entitled to the return of all moneys paid by the resident under the contract, except for the sum of \$100 or 0.2 per centum of the in-going contribution paid by the resident (whichever is the greater), which may be retained by the Manager.
 - (4) A contract to which these paragraphs apply must contain a conspicuous notice advising the resident that the resident may before the end of 21 clear business days after the resident signs the contract give notice that the resident wishes to terminate the contract.

- (5) If a contract to which these paragraphs apply does not contain the notice required by paragraph 5 (4) a resident may rescind the contract.
- (6) In these paragraphs "business day" means a day which is not a holiday within the meaning of section 44 (3) of the *Interpretation of Legislation Act 1984*;
6. Section 25 and Part 5 upon condition that any monies paid by a resident as an ingoing contribution are held in trust for the benefit of the resident by a Trustee Company authorised under the *Trustee Companies Act 1984*, less any deductions allowed under the contract between the resident and the Manager;
7. Section 33 upon condition that the information which would have been required to be presented at an Annual Meeting, is delivered to residents of the village (or their representatives) once a year, and an Annual Meeting is held if a written request is received from more than 20% of residents in the village (or their representatives);
8. Section 38 upon condition that no resident in the village is required to pay a maintenance charge which exceeds an amount calculated pursuant to any current agreement between the Manager and the Commonwealth in accordance with the *Aged or Disabled Persons Care Act 1954* as amended from time to time;
9. And upon condition that:
 - (a) The owner of the retirement village land does not sell or permit the land to be sold, or part with possession of the land, without the prior approval of the Commissioner for Corporate Affairs which shall not be unreasonably withheld;
 - (b) "R. C. and L. D. Nominees Pty Ltd" complies with the terms and conditions imposed by the Commonwealth on it in respect of any funding provided under the *Aged or Disabled Persons Care Act 1954*;

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- (c) "R. C. and L. D. Nominees Pty Ltd" maintains an enforceable lease from the owners of the retirement village land;
- (d) A copy of this exemption is given to the owner of the property;
- (e) Notification of the name of the Trustee Company holding residents ingoing contributions is given to each prospective resident at the same time such resident is given the residence documents relating to the village and;
- (f) A copy of this exemption is given to each prospective resident at the same time such resident is given the residence documents relating to the village.
