**VGG Periodical** is published on Monday when required and includes specialised information eg. Medical, Dental, Pharmacist's Registers, etc.

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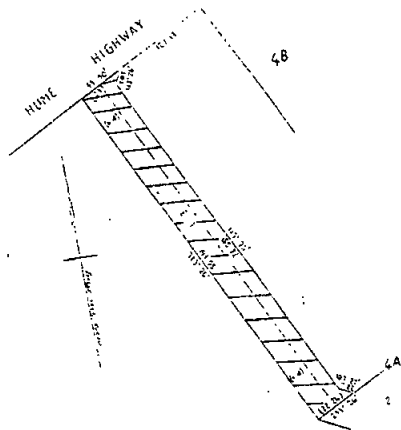

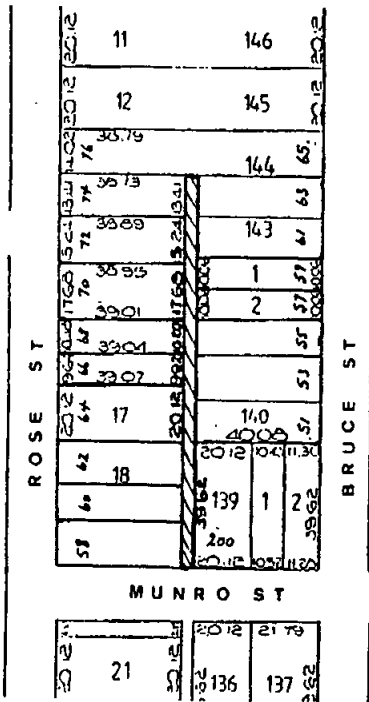

COBURG CITY COUNCIL  
Road Discontinuance

Pursuant to section 528 (2) of the *Local Government (Miscellaneous) Act* 1958, the Council of the Coburg City Council, at its Ordinary Meeting of Council, held on 18 October 1993, formed the opinion that the Road (Right-of-Way) situated at the rear of Nos 58-74 Rose Street and 51-63 Bruce Street and adjacent to No. 200 Munro Street, Coburg, which is shown by hatching on the plan herewith, is not reasonably required as a road for public use, be discontinued subject to:

- (a) Melbourne Water Corporation and the Mayor, Councillors and Citizens of the Coburg City Council continuing to have and possess the same right, title, power, authority or interest in or in relation to the whole of the land shown by hatching on the said plan as it had or possessed prior to such discontinuance with respect to or in connection with any drains or pipes laid or erected in on or over such land for the purpose of drainage or sewerage.
- (b) The land in the said road subject to any such right, title, power, authority or interest vesting in the municipality, and shall be retained by the Council until sold by Private Treaty.

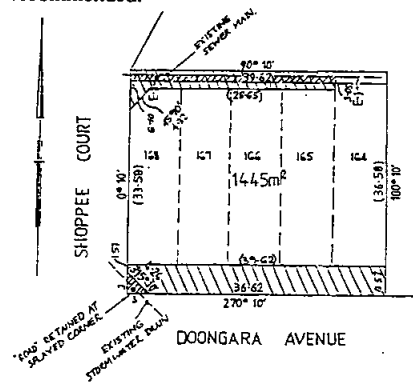

CITY OF MELBOURNE  
Consumption of Liquor on Roads and Public  
Places Local Law  
(No. 10 of 1993)

Notice is given that at a meeting of the Council of the City of Melbourne held on 15 November 1993, the Council made a Local Law titled "Consumption of Liquor on Roads and Public Places Local Law 1993" (No. 10 of 1993) pursuant to the provisions of the *Local Government Act 1989*.

The objective of the Local Law is to—

- (a) regulate and control the consumption of liquor and possession of liquor other than in a sealed container—
  - (i) on a road; or
  - (ii) in or at a public place; or
  - (iii) in or on a stationary vehicle; within the area and times specified in the Local Law; and
- (b) prevent behaviour which—
  - (i) constitutes a nuisance; or
  - (ii) may be detrimental to health or safety; or
  - (iii) affects the enjoyment of public places.

Area and times specified in the Local Law

The Local Law applies to the area bounded by and including Flinders Street, Spring Street, La Trobe Street and Spencer Street, including the area known as Banana Alley, during the hours 7.00 p.m. each day and 8.00 a.m. the next day.

Consumption and possession of liquor

A person must not—

- (a) on a road; or
- (b) in or at a public place; or
- (c) in or on a stationary vehicle on a road or in or at a public place—

consume any liquor or have in his or her possession or control any liquor other than liquor in a sealed container.

The above provision does not apply to a person—

- (a) taking part in a function or activity—
  - (i) on a road; or
  - (ii) in or at a public place; or
  - (iii) in or on a stationary vehicle on a road or in or at a public place—in respect of which the Council has given its written consent for persons to consume liquor or have in their possession or control any liquor other than liquor in a sealed container; or
- (b) within authorised premises or licensed premises under the *Liquor Control Act 1987*.

Enforcement

Where a member of the police force believes on reasonable grounds that a person is in contravention of this Local Law or has contravened this Local Law, the member may direct the person to seal any container or dispose of the contents of any unsealed container.

If a person fails or refuses to comply with a direction of a member of the police force the member may report the failure or refusal to the delegate.

Notices

If the delegate receives a report from a member of the police force the delegate must—

- (a) forward a notice to the person who is the subject of the report—
  - (i) detailing the date, time, location and nature of the failure or refusal;
  - (ii) detailing the name and rank of the member of the police force who reported the failure or refusal and

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- the police station to which the member was stationed at the time of the failure or refusal;
- (iii) enclosing with the notice a copy of this Local Law; and
  - (iv) stating that any future breaches of this Local Law may result in proceedings being taken against him or her; and
- (b) keep a register of all reports received and notices forwarded.

If the delegate receives a further report in respect of a person who has been forwarded a notice within 12 months of the date of the receipt by the delegate of the prior report or reports, the delegate may issue an infringement notice or institute prosecution proceedings against that person.

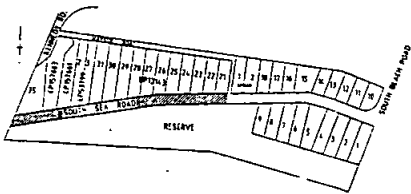

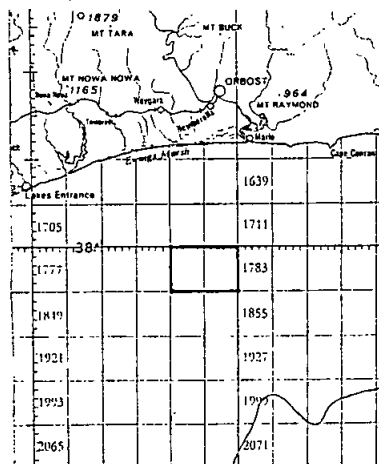

**SOLICITORS' (PROFESSIONAL  
CONDUCT AND PRACTICE)  
(AMENDMENT No. 2) RULES 1993**

In pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Legal Profession Practice Act 1958* and all other powers thereunto enabling the Council of the Law Institute of Victoria hereby makes the following Rules:

1. These Rules may be cited as the Solicitors' (Professional Conduct and Practice) (Amendment No. 2) Rules 1993 and shall come into operation on the date of their publication in the *Victoria Government Gazette*.

2. The Solicitors' (Professional Conduct and Practice) Rules 1984 are in these Rules referred to as the Principal Rules.

3. Rule 10 of the Principal Rules is repealed and the following is substituted:

“10 (1) Nothing in this Rule shall be deemed to limit or restrict any duty or obligation of a solicitor which otherwise exists.

(2) A solicitor shall not act—

(a) for both vendor and purchaser in connection with a contract for the sale of land, or a conveyance or transfer of land, for value at arm's length; or

(b) for both vendor and purchaser in connection with a contract for the sale of a business at arm's length; or

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- (c) for both lessor and lessee in connection with a lease of land, or an agreement for the lease of land, for value at arm's length; or
- (d) for both lender and borrower in connection with a loan of money or an agreement to lend money; or
- (e) for both purchaser of land and the lender of money intended to be secured by a mortgage of that land—

unless and until the solicitor obtains the written acknowledgment of the parties in or to the effect of Form 1 in the Schedule.

This sub-rule does not authorise the solicitor to act in the circumstances set out in sub-rules 10 (5) or 10 (6) or 10 (6A) or 10 (6B).

- (3) In the event of a conflict of interest arising, the solicitor will cease to act for all of the parties for whom the solicitor has agreed to act unless each of them agrees in writing for which of them the solicitor may continue to act.
- (4) A solicitor may obtain a general authority from a client authorising the solicitor to act for that client and for other parties to any matter or transaction, and such general authority in or to the effect of Form 2 in the Schedule will satisfy the requirements of sub-rule 10 (2) insofar as that client is concerned.
- (5) A solicitor shall not act for any purchaser under a contract of sale of land if the solicitor is a party to any agreement or understanding with the vendor or the lender under an associated loan agreement as to the amount of costs that will be payable to the purchaser as to the payment of those costs.
- (6) A solicitor shall not act for a borrower and a lender in connection with a loan of money or an agreement to lend money if the lender is held out to the public as being in the business of lending and the lender is not—
  - (a) a bank;
  - (b) a trustee company as defined in the *Trustee Companies Act 1984*;

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- (c) a solicitors' mortgage investment company;
- (d) a building society;
- (e) a credit union;
- (f) a credit co-operative;
- (g) a housing co-operative; or
- (h) the solicitor or the solicitor's nominee company when the solicitor complies with the Mortgage Register and Nominee Company Rules 1977 and the solicitor or the solicitor's nominee company is to hold or holds the mortgage as nominee from clients of the solicitor.

- (6A) A solicitor shall not act for a guarantor in connection with a loan of money or an agreement to lend money where the solicitor is also acting in the same transaction for the borrower or the lender. This rule does not prohibit the solicitor acting for both a borrower and a guarantor if in the same transaction the guarantor is—
  - (a) a borrower;
  - (b) a director of a borrower;

  - (d) a beneficiary in a trust of which a borrower is the trustee;
  - (e) a party holding a beneficial interest in a borrower;
  - (f) a body corporate related to a borrower within the meaning of the Corporations Law;
  - (g) a director of such related body corporate;
  - (h) a shareholder of such a related body corporate;
  - (i) a party holding a beneficial interest in such a related body corporate; orFor the purposes of this sub-rule (6A) "guarantor" means guarantor, indemnifier, surety or a person or company providing security for the loan.

- (6B) A solicitor shall not act in any matter or transaction for value at arms length relating to land for a person or entity carrying on business as a builder, developer or subdivider and any other

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party contracting with that person or entity in the course of that business.

(7) For the purpose of this rule—

Reference to a solicitor acting or not acting includes the partner, principal or employee of the solicitor acting or not acting.

“land” has the same meaning as in section 2 (1) of the *Sale of Land Act 1962*;

“solicitor” has the same meaning as in section 51 of the *Legal Profession Practice Act 1958*.

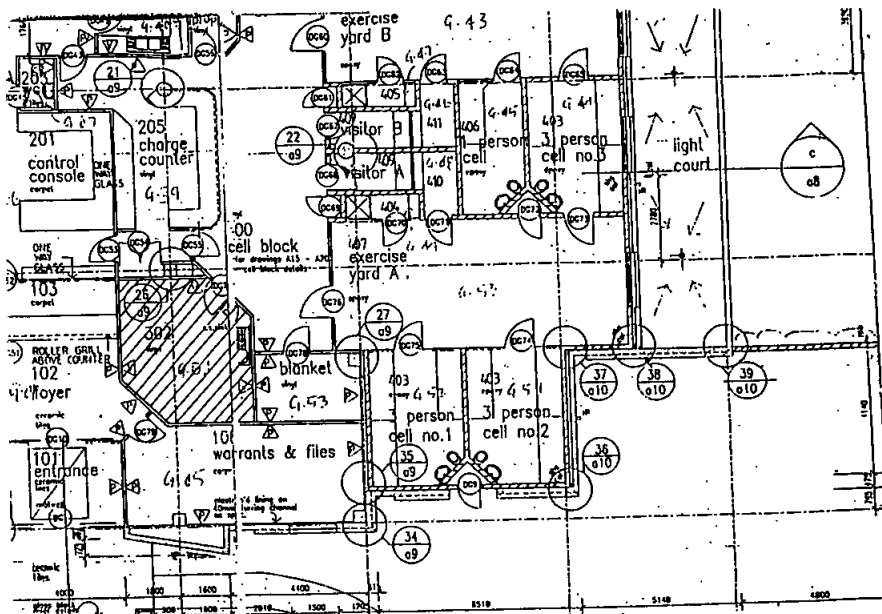

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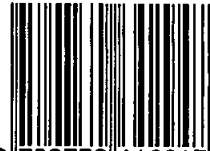
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
