## TREASURY CORPORATION OF VICTORIA ACT 1992

The Governor in Council, under section 36d of the *Treasury Corporation of Victoria Act 1992* (the "Act"), on the recommendation of the Treasurer, hereby declares that the liabilities of the State Electricity Commission of Victoria ("SECV") under any financial obligation which is included in a class of financial obligations specified in the Schedule below (being financial obligations which are governed by the laws of Victoria) are to be taken to be liabilities of the Treasury Corporation of Victoria.

## TREASURY CORPORATION OF VICTORIA ACT 1992

The Governor in Council under section 36e (1) of the *Treasury Corporation of Victoria Act 1992* (the "Act"), on the recommendation of the Treasurer, hereby declares that all financial obligations of State Electricity Commission of Victoria ("SECV") which are included in the class of financial obligations specified in the Schedule below (being financial obligations that are governed by a law other than the laws of Victoria) are financial obligations to which section 36e of the Act relates.
