- 1. The Governor in Council under section 8 of the State Owned Enterprises Act 1992 hereby reappoints Tom Barlow and Judith King to be Directors of Melbourne Water Corporation, commencing 1 January 1995, for a term of three years.
- 2. The Directors' remuneration shall be at the rate of \$30,000 per annum in addition reimbursement for all expenses reasonably incurred in the discharge of the office.

Electricity Industry Act 1993 EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 160

The Governor in Council acting under section 160 of the Electricity Industry Act 1993 (the "Act") exempts the persons falling within the class of persons described below from the requirement to obtain a licence under section 159 of the Act in respect of each of the activities specified below:

Class of Persons

All persons who, immediately before the commencement of section 25 of the Act were engaged in the generation of electricity for supply or sale or the transmission, distribution, supply or sale of electricity, other than the following persons:

- (a) Power Net Victoria;
- (b) Victorian Power Exchange;
- (c) Electricity Services Victoria;
- (d) Generation Victoria;
- (e) Eastern Energy Limited (A.C.N. 064 651 118);
- (f) Citipower Ltd (A.C.N. 064 651 056);
- (g) United Energy Ltd (A.C.N. 064 651 029);
- (h) Solaris Power Ltd (A.C.N. 064 651 083);
- (i) Powercor Australia Ltd (A.C.N. 064 651 109);
- (j) State Electricity Commission of Victoria; and
- (k) Energy Brix Australia Corporation.

Exempt Activity

The generation of electricity for supply or sale, the transmission, the distribution, the supply or the sale of electricity where the relevant activity:

- (a) was occurring immediately prior to the commencement of section 25 of the Act; and
- (b) was not at that time prohibited by section 6 of the Electric Light and Power Act 1958.

This Order is subject to the following terms, conditions and limitations:

- (a) the exemption given under this Order commences on the date of this Order and ends on 31 December 1995;
- (b) persons exempted by this Order must, on or before 30 June 1995, furnish to the Office of the Regulator-General such information relating to the person and the person's activities as is sufficient to enable the Office to determine whether the person should remain exempt or apply for a licence under section 159 of the Act in relation to those activities.

This Order replaces the Order made on 27 September 1994 granting an exemption under section 160 of the Act to the class of persons to whom this Order applies.

Electricity Industry Act 1993 EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 160

The Governor in Council acting under section 160 of the Electricity Industry Act 1993 (the "Act") exempts Energy Brix Australia Corporation ("Energy Brix") from the requirement to obtain a licence under section 159 of the Act in respect of the generation of electricity for supply or sale, subject to the following terms, conditions and limitations:

- (a) the exemption contained in this Order commences on the date of this Order and ends on 31 December 1995;
- (b) Energy Brix must, at least 3 months before the exemption contained in this Order ends, make application to the Office of the Regulator-General for the issue of a licence to generate electricity for supply or sale; and
- (c) Energy Brix must comply with the terms and conditions of the initial licences issued to Generation Victoria under Part 12 of the Act as if those terms and conditions were expressed to apply to it (and notwithstanding any subsequent variation or revocation of those licences), except to the extent such terms and conditions relate to the supply of auxiliary services or the independent operation of licensed power stations.

This Order replaces the Order made on 27 September 1994 granting Energy Brix Australia Corporation an exemption under section 160 of the Act from the requirement to obtain a licence under section 159 of the Act.

- (2) Subject to sub-section (3), the remaining provisions of this Act come into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.
- (3) If a provision referred to in sub-section (2) does not come into operation within the period of 12 months beginning on, and including, the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent, it comes into operation on the first day after the end of that period.

No. 112/1994 (1) Part 1 and section 111 come into operation on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

- (2) Subject to sub-section (3), the remaining provisions of this Act, except Part 13, come into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.
- (3) If a provision referred to in sub-section (2) does not come into operation within the period of 12 months beginning on, and including, the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent, it comes into operation on the first day after the end of that period.
- (4) Part 13 comes into operation on a day to be proclaimed.
