Vocational Education and Training Act 1990 CHANGE OF NAME OF THE DANDENONG COLLEGE OF TECHNICAL AND FURTHER EDUCATION TO THE

CASEY COLLEGE OF TECHNICAL AND FURTHER EDUCATION

The Governor in Council, acting under section 23 of the Vocational Education and Training Act 1990 and on recommendation of the State Training Board of Victoria made in accordance with that section—

- (a) changes the name of the Dandenong College of Technical and Further Education to "Casey College of Technical and Further Education"; and
- (b) amends Schedule 1 to that Act to change the name of the College by---
 - (i) removing the name "Dandenong College of Technical and Further Education"; and
 - (ii) inserting immediately after the name "Broadmeadows College of Technical and Further Education" the name "Casey College of Technical and Further Education".

This Order takes effect on and from 19 April 1994.
