Electricity Industry Act 1993 NOTICE

Relevant dates for the purposes of section 98 (2)

In the exercise of powers given under section 98 (2) of the Electricity Industry Act 1993 I hereby:

- (a) fix 30 June 1994 as the relevant date for the purposes of the following allocation statements to be prepared by National Electricity under section 99 of that Act:
 - (i) statement allocating to Energy Information Technology Company Pty Ltd all property, rights and liabilities relating to the Energy Information Technology Centre function of National Electricity including certain specified property, rights and liabilities;
 - (ii) statement allocating to Electricity Services Victoria all property, rights and liabilities relating to the subtransmission function of National Electricity including certain specified property, rights and liabilities but excluding certain retained property, rights and liabilities;
 - (iii) statement allocating to Generation Victoria all property, rights and liabilities relating to the Vic Hydro function of National Electricity including certain specified property, rights and liabilities but excluding certain

- retained property, rights and liabilities; and
- (iv) statement allocating to the State Electricity Commission of Victoria certain property, rights and liabilities of National Electricity;
- (b) fix 30 June 1994 as the relevant date for the purposes of the following documents to be prepared by National Electricity under section 113 (1) of that Act:
- (i) list providing for the transfer to Energy Information Technology Company Pty Ltd of officers and employees of National Electricity associated with the Energy Information Technology Centre function;
 - (ii) list providing for the transfer to Electricity Services Victoria of officers and employees of National Electricity associated with the subtransmission function; and
 - (iii) list providing for the transfer to Generation Victoria of officers and employees of National Electricity associated with the Vic Hydro function.
