Local Government Act 1989 ORDER APPOINTING THE COMMISSIONERS AND ACTING CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICERS OF THE CITIES OF BANYULE, BAYSIDE, BRIMBANK, CASEY, GLEN EIRA, GREATER DANDENONG, HUME, KINGSTON, MANNINGHAM, MARIBYRNONG, MAROONDAH, MONASH, MOONEE VALLEY, WHITEHORSE AND WYNDHAM, THE SHIRES OF CARDINIA, MORNINGTON PENINSULA, NILLUMBIK AND YARRA RANGES AND THE **RE-CONSTITUTED CITIES OF** FRANKSTON, KNOX AND WHITTLESEA AND SHIRE OF MELTON.

Whereas 23 new Councils have been constituted by Order in Council under Part 10C of the Local Government Act 1989 (the Act) the Minister has recommended to the Governor in Council that an Order be made, pursuant to section 220Q(o) of the Act, in the following terms

Now therefore, the Governor in Council acting under Part 10C of the Act orders that:

#### 1. Definitions

In this Order-

"former Council" means the Shire of Bacchus Marsh, City of Berwick, Council of the City of Box Hill, City of Brighton, City of Broadmeadows, the Mayor, Councillors and Citizens of the Shire of Bulla, City of Caulfield, City of Chelsea, City of Cranbourne, City of Croydon, City of Dandenong, Shire of Diamond Valley, City of Doncaster and Templestowe, Shire of Eltham, City of Essendon, the President, Councillors and Citizens of the Shire of Flinders, City of Footscray, City of Frankston, the President, Councillors and Citizens of the Shire of Hastings, Shire of Healesville, City of Heidelberg, City of Keilor, City of Knox, Shire

of Lillydale, Shire of Melton, City of Moorabbin, City of Mordialloc, Shire of Mornington, City of Nunawading, City of Oakleigh, Shire of Pakenham, City of Ringwood, City of Sandringham, Shire of Sherbrooke, City of Springvale, the Mayor, Councillors and Citizens of the City of Sunshine, Shire of Upper Yarra, City of Waverley, City of Werribee and City of Whittlesea.

#### 2. Commencement

This Order comes into operation on the day it is published in the Government Gazette.

#### 3. Commissioners

- (1) The persons specified in column 1 of the Schedule are appointed to administer the Council specified in column 2 of the Schedule from the day this Order comes into operation until 9:00 a.m. on the day on which the first meeting of the Council specified in column 2 is held following the first election of councillors for the Council.
- (2) The person specified in column 3 of the Schedule is appointed the Chairperson of the Commissioners.

#### 4. Chief Executive Officers

- (1) The person specified in column 4 of the Schedule is the person authorised to exercise the powers and perform the duties and functions conferred or imposed on Chief Executive Officers by any other Order, the Act and any other Act until revoked by the Council specified in column 2 of the Schedule.
- (2) Any authorisation given by a former Council under section 5 of the *Local Government (Miscellaneous Amendments)* Act 1993 has no effect.

ORDER CONSTITUTING THE CITIES OF
BANYULE, BAYSIDE, BRIMBANK,
CASEY, GLEN EIRA, GREATER
DANDENONG, HUME, KINGSTON,
MANNINGHAM, MARIBYRNONG,
MAROONDAH, MONASH, MOONEE
VALLEY, WHITEHORSE AND
WYNDHAM, THE SHIRES OF CARDINIA,
MORNINGTON PENINSULA, NILLUMBIK
AND YARRA RANGES,

RE-CONSTITUTING THE CITIES OF FRANKSTON, KNOX AND WHITTLESEA AND THE SHIRE OF MELTON AND ALTERING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICTS OF THE CITIES OF DAREBIN AND MORELAND, THE SHIRES OF MOORABOOL AND SOUTH GIPPSLAND AND THE BASS COAST SHIRE.

#### Whereas

A. On 1 July 1994 the Acting Minister for Local Government, the Hon. Robert Maclellan, MLA, required the Local Government Board to conduct a review under Part 10B of the Local Government Act 1989 (the Act), on the most appropriate local government structure for the area comprising the municipal districts of the Shire of Bacchus Marsh, City of Berwick, City of Box Hill, City of Brighton, City of Broadmeadows, Shire of Bulla, City of Caulfield, City of Chelsea, City of Cranbourne, City of Croydon, City of Dandenong, Shire of Diamond Valley, City of Doncaster and Templestowe, Shire of Eltham, City of Essendon, Shire of Flinders, City of Footscray, City of Frankston, Shire of Hastings, Shire of Healesville, City of Heidelberg, City of Keilor, City of Knox, Shire of Lillydale, Shire of Melton, City of Moorabbin, City of Mordialloc, Shire of Mornington, City of Nunawading, City of Oakleigh, Shire of Pakenham, City of Ringwood, City of Sandringham, Shire of Sherbrooke, City of Springvale, City of Sunshine, Shire of Upper Yarra, City of Waverley, City of Werribee and City of Whittlesea (the review).

B. As required by section 220M of the Act, the Local Government Board has submitted a final report on the review to the Minister for Local Government, the Hon. Roger Murray Hallam, MLC (the Minister).

C. As required by sections 220M and 220P of the Act, the Minister has considered the

report and has recommended to the Governor in Council that an Order in Council be made in the following terms.

NOW THEREFORE, the Governor in Council acting under Part 10C of the Act ORDERS THAT:

#### PART 1- PRELIMINARY

1. Definitions

In this Order-

"Act" means the Local Government Act 1989.

"adjacent area" means, in relation to a Council, an area which does not form part of the municipal district of the Council but which immediately before the commencement of this Order formed part of the municipal district of the former Council.

"appointed day" means the day on which this Order comes into operation.

"Commissioner" means a person appointed by the Governor in Council to administer a newly constituted Council.

"former Council" means in relation to-

- (a) the Banyule City Council, each of the former City of Heidelberg and the former Shire of Diamond Valley;
- (b) the Bayside City Council, each of the former Cities of Brighton and Sandringham;
- (c) the Brimbank City Council, each of the former City of Keilor and the former City with the name of the Mayor, Councillors and Citizens of the City of Sunshine;
- (d) the Cardinia Shire Council, the former Shire of Pakenham;
- (e) the Casey City Council, each of the former Cities of Berwick and Cranbourne;
- (f) the Frankston City Council, the former City of Frankston;
- (g) the Glen Eira City Council, the former City of Caulfield;
- (h) the Greater Dandenong City Council, each of the former Cities of Dandenong and Springvale;
- (i) the Hume City Council, each of the former City of Broadmeadows and the former Shire with the name of the Mayor, Councillors and Citizens of the Shire of Bulla;

- (j) the Kingston City Council, each of the former Cities of Chelsea, Moorabbin and Mordialloc;
- (k) the Knox City Council, the former City of Knox:
- (1) the Manningham City Council, each of the former City of Doncaster and Templestowe;
- (m) the Maribyrnong City Council, the former City of Footscray;
- (n) the Maroondah City Council, each of the former Cities of Croydon and Ringwood;
- (o) the Melton Shire Council, the former Shire of Melton;
- (p) the Monash City Council, each of the former Cities of Oakleigh and Waverley;
- (q) the Moonee Valley City Council, the former City of Essendon;
- (r) the Moorabool Shire Council, the former Shire of Bacchus Marsh;
- (s) the Mornington Peninsula Shire Council, each of the former Shire of Mornington, the former Shire with the name of the President, Councillors, Citizens of the Shire of Hastings and the former Shire with the name of the President, Councillors and Citizens of the Shire of Flinders;
- (t) the Nillumbik Shire Council, the former Shire of Eltham;
- (u) the Whitehorse City Council, each of the former City of Nunawading and the former City with the name of the Council of the City of Box Hill;
- (v) the Whittlesea City Council, the former City of Whittlesea;
- (w) the Wyndham City Council, the former City of Werribee; and
- (x) the Yarra Ranges Shire Council, each of the former Shires of Healesville, Lillydale, Sherbrooke and Upper Yarra.

"neighbouring Council" means, in relation to another Council, a Council the municipal district of which an adjacent area in relation to that other Council forms part.

"newly constituted Council" means the Banyule City Council, the Bayside City Council, the Brimbank City Council, the Cardinia Shire Council, the Casey City Council, the Frankston City Council, the Glen Eira City Council, the Greater Dandenong City Council, the Hume City Council, the Kingston City Council, the Knox City Council, the Manningham City Council, the Maribyrnong City Council, the Maroondah City Council, the Melton Shire Council, the Monash City Council, the Monash City Council, the Mornington Peninsula Shire Council, the Nillumbik Shire Council, the Whitehorse City Council, the Whitlesea City Council, the Wyndham City Council and the Yarra Ranges Shire Council constituted under clause 3(1) of this Order.

#### 2. Commencement

This Order comes into operation on the day it is published in the Government Gazette.

  - (g) a body corporate constituted as a City Council by the name of the Glen Eira City Council;
  - (h) a body corporate constituted as a City Council by the name of the Greater Dandenong City Council;
  - a body corporate constituted as a City Council by the name of the Hume City Council;
  - a body corporate constituted as a City Council by the name of the Kingston City Council;

- (k) a body corporate constituted as a City Council by the name of the Knox City Council:
- (l) a body corporate constituted as a City Council by the name of the Manningham City Council;
- (m) a body corporate constituted as a City Council by the name of the Maribymong City Council;
- (n) a body corporate constituted as a City Council by the name of the Maroondah City Council:
- (o) a body corporate constituted as a Shire Council by the name of the Melton Shire Council;
- (p) a body corporate constituted as a City Council by the name of the Monash City Council;
- (q) a body corporate constituted as a City Council by the name of the Moonee Valley City Council;
- (r) a body corporate constituted as a Shire Council by the name of the Mornington Peninsula Shire Council;
- (s) a body corporate constituted as a Shire Council by the name of the Nillumbik Shire Council:
- (t) a body corporate constituted as a City Council by the name of the Whitehorse City Council;
- (u) a body corporate constituted as a City Council by the name of the Whittlesea City Council;
- (v) a body corporate constituted as a City Council by the name of the Wyndham City Council; and
- (w) a body corporate constituted as a Shire Council by the name of the Yarra Ranges Shire Council.
- (2) On the appointed day the following councils cease to exist-

  - (b) City of Berwick;
  - (c) Council of the City of Box Hill;
  - (d) City of Brighton;

- 4. Commissioners
- (1) The Chief Executive Officer of a newly constituted Council must call the first meeting of the Council to be held by the Commissioners which must be held within 3 days of the appointed day.
- (2) Section 89 (4) of the Act does not apply to the first meeting of a newly constituted Council.
- (3) The provisions of Schedule 1 apply to the Commissioners and meetings of the Commissioners.

- 8. Transitional Provisions
- (1) Clause 84 of this Order applies to the Bass Coast Shire Council as if the Bass Coast Shire Council is a newly constituted Council.
- (2) Unless amended or revoked by an Order in Council or by the Bass Coast Shire Council the local laws in force in the municipal district of the former City of Cranbourne or the South Gippsland Shire Council immediately before the appointed day continue to apply in the relevant part of its municipal district for the period commencing on the appointed day and ending on 2 December 1995 as if the local laws had been made by the Bass Coast Shire Council.
- (3) The Bass Coast Shire Council shall be responsible for the enforcement of local laws within its municipal district and for continuing any proceedings for the enforcement of those local laws.
- 9. Savings Provision

Notwithstanding any reconstitution of the Bass Coast Shire Council effected by this Part, the Bass Coast Shire Council is deemed to be the same body on and after as before the appointed day and no act, matter or thing is in any way abated or affected by reason of any such reconstitution and any such act, matter or thing may be continued and concluded in all respects as if this Order had not been made.

10. Boundaries of the municipal district of the Bayside City Council

On the appointed day the boundaries of the municipal district of the Bayside City Council shall be fixed as described in Schedule 4.

- 11. Bayside City Council is Successor in Law
  On the appointed day—
  - (a) all property, rights and assets of the former Council are vested in the Bayside City Council;
  - (b) all liabilities of the former Council are liabilities of the Bayside City Council;
  - (c) the Bayside City Council is the successor in law of the former Council.

#### PART 6-CITY OF BRIMBANK

12. Boundaries of the municipal district of the Brimbank City Council

On the appointed day the boundaries of the municipal district of the Brimbank City Council shall be fixed as described in Schedule 5.

13. Brimbank City Council is Successor in Law

On the appointed day-

- (a) all property, rights and assets of the former Council are vested in the Brimbank City Council;
- (b) all liabilities of the former Council are liabilities of the Brimbank City Council;
- (c) the Brimbank City Council is the successor in law of the former Council.

#### PART 7-SHIRE OF CARDINIA

14. Boundaries of the municipal district of the Cardinia Shire Council

On the appointed day the boundaries of the municipal district of the Cardinia Shire Council shall be fixed as described in Schedule 6.

- Cardinia Shire Council is Successor in Law
   On the appointed day—
  - (a) all property, rights and assets of the former Council are vested in the Cardinia Shire Council;
  - (b) all liabilities of the former Council are liabilities of the Cardinia Shire Council;
  - (c) the Cardinia Shire Council is the successor in law of the former Council.

16. Boundaries of the municipal district of the Casey City Council

On the appointed day the boundaries of the municipal district of the Casey City Council shall be fixed as described in Schedule 7.

- Casey City Council is Successor in Law On the appointed day—
  - (a) all property, rights and assets of the former Council are vested in the Casey City Council;
  - (b) all liabilities of the former Council are liabilities of the Casey City Council;
  - (c) the Casey City Council is the successor in law of the former Council.

#### PART 9-CITY OF DAREBIN

18. Boundaries of the municipal district of the Darebin City Council

On the appointed day the boundaries of the municipal district of the Darebin City Council shall be fixed as described in Schedule 8.

- 19. Transitional Provisions
- (1) Clause 84 of this Order applies to the Darebin City Council as if the Darebin City Council is a newly constituted Council.
- (2) Unless amended or revoked by an Order in Council or by the Darebin City Council the local laws in force in the municipal district of the former Shire of Diamond Valley and the former City of Heidelberg immediately before the appointed day continue to apply in the relevant part of its municipal district for the period commencing on the appointed day and ending on 22 June 1995 as if the local laws had been made by the Darebin City Council.
- (3) The Darebin City Council shall be responsible for the enforcement of local laws within its municipal district and for continuing any proceedings for the enforcement of those local laws.

#### 20. Savings Provision

Notwithstanding any reconstitution of the Darebin City Council effected by this Part, the Darebin City Council is deemed to be the same body on and after as before the appointed day and no act, matter or thing is in any way abated or affected by reason of any such reconstitution and any such act, matter or thing may be continued and concluded in all respects as if this Order had not been made.

21. Boundaries of the municipal district of the Frankston City Council

On the appointed day the boundaries of the municipal district of the Frankston City Council shall be fixed as described in Schedule 9.

22. Frankston City Council is Successor in Law

- (b) all liabilities of the former Council are liabilities of the Frankston City Council:
- (c) the Frankston City Council is the successor in law of the former Council.

64. Wyndham City Council is Successor in Law

#### On the appointed day-

(a) all property, rights and assets of the former Council are vested in the Wyndham City Council;

#### Victoria Government Gazette

- (b) all liabilities of the former Council are liabilities of the Wyndham City Council;
- (c) the Wyndham City Council is the successor in law of the former Council.

#### PART 30-SHIRE OF YARRA RANGES

65. Boundaries of the municipal district of the Yarra Ranges Shire Council

On the appointed day the boundaries of the municipal district of the Yarra Ranges Shire Council shall be fixed as described in Schedule

66. Yarra Ranges Shire Council is Successor in Law

On the appointed day-

- (a) all property, rights and assets of the former Council are vested in the Yarra Ranges Shire Council;
- (b) all liabilities of the former Council are liabilities of the Yarra Ranges Shire Council;
- (c) the Yarra Ranges Shire Council is the successor in law of the former Council.

### PART 31—REGIONAL ORGANISATIONS 67. Definitions

In this Part

"Authority" means the Upper Yarra Valley and Dandenong Ranges Authority established under the Upper Yarra Valley and Dandenong Ranges Authority Act 1976.

"regional group" means a regional refuse disposal group established under section 812B of the Local Government (Miscellaneous) Act 1958 and, as from the commencement of section 30 of the Local Government (Amendment) Act 1994, a regional waste management group deemed to have been established under section 50F of the Environment Protection Act 1970.

"Waste Management Council" means the Waste Management Council established under Division 2 of Part 9 of the Environment Protection Act 1970.

68. Boundaries of the Upper Yarra Valley and Dandenong Ranges Authority

For the purposes of the Upper Yarra Valley and Dandenong Ranges Authority Act 1976, the boundaries of the Region of the Authority shall be the boundaries which existed immediately before the appointed day.

69. Membership of the Upper Yarra Valley and Dandenong Ranges Authority

A person appointed to be a member of the Authority under paragraph (a) of section 7(1) of the Upper Yarra Valley and Dandenong Ranges Authority Act 1976 shall not cease to hold office by virtue of that person ceasing to be a Councillor under this Order.

70. Membership of a Regional Refuse Disposal Group

During the period commencing on the appointed day and ending on 28 February 1995, a person appointed by the former Council to be a member of the committee of a regional group shall continue to hold such office, unless such appointment is sooner revoked by the newly constituted Council.

71. Membership of Waste Management Council

During the period commencing on the appointed day and ending on 28 February

- (a) a person appointed as a Director of the Waste Management Council; or
- (b) the President of the Waste Management Council,

shall continue to hold such office, unless that person ceases to be a member of a regional group by virtue of clause 70 of this Order.

#### PART 32—GENERAL

#### 72. Holding of the First Elections

The date for the first election of Councillors for a newly constituted Council is to be fixed by the Minister by a notice published in the Government Gazette.

- First Meeting of the Councillors of a Newly Constituted Council
- (1) After the first election of Councillors for a newly constituted Council has been held, the Chief Executive Officer of the Council must call the first meeting of the Council which must be held within 10 days of the day on which the returning officer declares the result of the first election.
- (2) At 9 a.m. on the day on which the first meeting of the Council is held under sub-clause (1)—
  - (a) the Commissioners go out of office; and
  - (b) the Councillors elected at the first election of the Council assume office as Councillors of the Council.

74. Staff

On the appointed day all the members of staff of the former Council become members of staff of the newly constituted Council with the same terms and conditions as those with the former Council and with the benefit of all accrued rights.

75. Delegations—Transitional Provisions

- (1) With effect from the appointed day until revoked by the newly constituted Council all delegations made by the former Council or by the Chief Executive Officer of the former Council under the Act or any other Act remain in force.
- (2) A newly constituted Council may, with the agreement of a neighbouring Council, delegate under section 98 of the Act a power, duty or function to a member of staff of that Council in respect of the period commencing on the appointed day and ending on 28 February 1995.

  76. Rates—General Transitional Provisions 1994–1995
- (1) Any rate or charge levied by the former Council under section 158(3) of the Act for the 1994-1995 financial year is deemed to have been levied by the newly constituted Council.
- (2) Any state deficit levy imposed by the former Council under the State Deficit Levy Act 1992 for the 1994-1995 financial year is deemed to have been imposed by the newly constituted Council.
- 77. Rates—Transitional Provisions for the Declaration and Levying of Rates 1994–1995
- (1) If immediately before the appointed day the former Council had not declared a general rate in respect of the 1994–1995 financial year, the newly constituted Council may, in accordance with the budget prepared by the former Council and having regard to any submissions made by a person in accordance with the Act, declare and levy any general rates, service rates and charges or municipal charge in respect of rateable land in the municipal district of the former Council.
- (2) If immediately before the appointed day the former Council had declared but not levied any general rate in respect of the 1994–1995 financial year, the newly constituted Council may levy such rates and charges as have been declared by the former Council in respect of rateable land within the municipal district of the former Council.
- (3) Notwithstanding sub-clauses (1) and (2), a newly constituted Council can authorise a

neighbouring Council to levy in respect of rateable land in an adjacent area such rates and charges as have been declared by the former Council or by the newly constituted Council, as the case may be.

78. Minimum Rates—Transitional Provisions 1995–1996

In the 1995-996 financial year a newly constituted Council may levy a minimum rate in accordance with sub-section 3(2) of the Local Government (Consequential Provisions) Act

79. Differential Rates—Transitional Provisions 1995-1996 & 1996-1997

In the 1995-1996 and 1996-1997 financial years a newly constituted Council may—

- (a) raise any general rate by the application of a differential rate pursuant to section 161 of the Act regardless of the system of valuation it is using;
- (b) apply a differential rate for a type or class of land according to its geographic location;
- (c) declare a different service rate or different annual service charge pursuant to section 162 of the Act in different areas.

#### 80. Valuations-Transitional Provision

- (1) Where different systems of valuation apply within the municipal district of a newly constituted Council, the newly constituted Council must determine to use a system of valuation which applies to the whole of its municipal district for the purpose of declaring a rate in respect of the 1995–1996 financial year.
- (2) If a newly constituted Council determines to change the system of valuation for the purpose of declaring a rate in respect of the 1995-1996 financial year, section 157 of the Act does not apply to that determination.

#### 81. Adjacent Areas-Transitional Provisions

(1) For the period commencing on the appointed day and ending on 28 February 1995, except as otherwise agreed between the relevant Councils or provided for in this Order, a newly constituted Council must provide the same services and perform the same functions in an adjacent area and in the same manner as if the area was in its municipal district and for that purpose any powers, duties and functions imposed or conferred by any Act on a

neighbouring Council are deemed to be imposed by that Act on the newly constituted Council.

- (2) A newly constituted Council must be reimbursed by a neighbouring Council the cost of providing services and performing functions in the adjacent area.
- (3) A newly constituted Council must come to an agreement with a neighbouring Council on the apportionment, settlement, transfer, adjustment or determination of any property, income, assets, liabilities, expenses, staff or other matters in relation to an adjacent area by 28 February 1995.

#### 82. Local Laws-Transitional Provisions

- (1) On the appointed day any local law, or part of any local law, which deals with the meeting procedures or the common seal of a council which ceases to exist by virtue of clause 3 (2), is revoked.
- (2) Sections 5 (3) and 91 (1) of the Act do not apply in respect of the common seal and meetings of a newly constituted Council while the newly constituted Council is under the administration of Commissioners.
- (3) Unless amended or revoked by an Order in Council or by a newly constituted Council the local laws in force in the municipal district of the newly constituted Council immediately before the appointed day continue to apply in the relevant part of its municipal district for a period of 12 months from the appointed day as if the local laws were made by the newly constituted Council.
- (4) A newly constituted Council shall be responsible for the enforcement of local laws within its municipal district and for continuing any proceedings for the enforcement of those local laws.
- 83. Enforcement and Proceedings—Transitional Provisions
- (1) With effect from the appointed day until revoked by a newly constituted Council all authorisations made by the former Council under section 224 of the Act or any other Act remain in force.
- (2) Where, immediately before the appointed day, proceedings to which the former Council was a party were pending or existing in any court or tribunal, then, except as otherwise provided in this Order, a newly constituted Council, as the case may be, is substituted for the former Council as a party to the proceedings

and has the same rights in the proceedings as the former Council had.

- 84. Planning Matters—Transitional Provisions
- (1) Except where a planning scheme specifies the Minister administering the Planning and Environment Act 1987 or any other person to be the responsible authority, a newly constituted Council is the responsible authority for the purposes of the Planning and Environment Act 1987 in relation to the planning schemes in force in its municipal district.
- (2) Any reference in a planning scheme in force in the municipal district of a newly constituted Council to another council as a responsible authority for a particular purpose, is to be taken as a reference to the newly constituted Council in relation to the relevant part of its municipal district.
- (3) For the purposes of the Planning and Environment Act 1987 and the administration, amendment or enforcement of each of the planning schemes referred to in sub-clause (1)—
  - (a) anything of a continuing nature (including a contract, agreement or proceeding) done, commenced or made by or in relation to a council which ceases to exist by virtue of this Order may be done, enforced or completed by the newly constituted Council of the municipal district to which the matter relates;
  - (b) anything done by or in relation to a council which ceases to exist by virtue of this Order that concerns a matter of a continuing nature has effect as if done by the newly constituted Council of the municipal district to which the matter relates.

#### 85. References—Transitional Provisions

From the appointed day, any reference in any instrument or any other document of any kind to the former Council is, except as otherwise provided in this Order, to be construed as a reference to a newly constituted Council, as the case may be, unless the contrary intention appears.

#### 86. Corporate Plan-Transitional Provisions

For the purpose of section 153A of the Act a newly constituted Council must prepare a three year corporate plan by a date set by the Minister.

- 87. Modified Reporting Requirements for the 1993-1994 Financial Year
- (1) If immediately before the appointed day the former Council had not prepared an annual report in respect of the 1993-1994 financial year, the newly constituted Council must prepare an annual report containing—
  - (a) a report of the operations of the former Council during the financial year; and
  - (b) audited financial statements for the former Council for the financial year.
- (2) For the purposes of section 128 (1) of the Act, the financial statements for the former Council may be signed by two Commissioners of the newly constituted Council and a person designated by the Council as having relevant financial management responsibilities for that purpose and regulation 85 of the Local Government Regulations 1990 is modified accordingly.
- (3) Section 128 (2) of the Act does not apply in respect of the financial statements for the former Council.
- 88. Modified Reporting Requirements for the 1994–1995 Financial Year
- (1) A newly constituted Council must prepare an annual report in respect of the 1994– 1995 financial year containing—
  - (a) for the period commencing 1 October 1994 and ending on the day before the appointed day—
    - (i) a report of the operations of the former Council during that period;
       and
    - (ii) audited financial statements for the former Council for that period;
       and
  - (b) for the period commencing on the appointed day and ending on 30 June 1995—
    - (i) a report of its operations during that period; and
    - (ii) audited financial statements for that period.
- (2) The provisions of the Act and the Local Government Regulations 1990 relating to the preparation and submission of annual reports, the preparation of reports of operations and the preparation, signing and audit of financial statements apply to a report prepared under sub-clause (1) with such modifications as are

necessary, unless otherwise provided in this clause.

- (3) Clause 87 (2) applies to the financial statements prepared under sub-clause (1) (a).
- (4) The financial statements prepared under sub-clause (1) (b) must be prepared, to the extent it is reasonably practicable, in such manner and form as prescribed.
- (5) The auditor's report required to be attached to the financial statements prepared under sub-clause (1) (b) by clause 9 of Schedule 8A of the Act may be signed by more than one
- (6) Except as provided in this clause, the requirements of section 126 of the Act do not apply to the newly constituted Council in respect of the 1994-1995 financial year.

#### 89. Borrowings-Transitional Provisions

For the purpose of Part 7 of the Act until a new budget is made by a newly constituted Council any proposed borrowings included in a budget or revised budget of the former Council are deemed to have been included in a budget or revised budget made by the newly constituted Council.

#### 90. Registrar of Titles

The Registrar of Titles, on being requested to do so and on delivery of any relevant certificates of title or instrument, must make any amendments in the Register that are necessary because of the operation of this Order.

#### SCHEDULE 1 COMMISSIONERS

- 1. A Commissioner is entitled to receive-
- (a) an annual remuneration;
- (b) any travelling subsistence allowances; and
- (c) any other allowances in relation to expenses incurred in the discharge of his or her duties-

that the Minister may from time to time determine in respect of the Commissioner.

- 2. Such remuneration, allowances and expenses are to be paid by the newly constituted Council.
  - 3. A Commissioner must—
    - (a) ensure that the operations of a newly constituted Council are carried out in the most efficient and economic manner possible;

- (b) report to the Minister on such matters and at such intervals as the Minister may specify.
- 4. A Commissioner must exercise his or her powers and perform his or her functions subject to any written directions given by the Minister.
  - 5. A Commissioner-
  - (a) must not, without the consent of the Minister, while in office directly or indirectly engage in any paid employment outside the duties of his or her office;
  - may resign the office in writing signed by him or her and delivered to the Governor in Council;
  - (c) may at any time be removed from office by the Governor in Council.
  - 6. If a Commissioner-
    - (a) becomes bankrupt or his or her property becomes in any manner subject to control under the law relating to bankruptcy;
    - (b) is convicted of an indictable offence or of an offence which, if committed in Victoria, would be an indictable offence;
    - (c) becomes incapable of performing the duties of office;
    - (d) is removed from office or resigns the office; or
    - (e) dies-

the office of a Commissioner becomes vacant.

- 7. During the absence from office or illness of a Commissioner, a person nominated by the Minister shall act in the place of the Commissioner and while so acting shall have, exercise and discharge all the responsibilities, liabilities, rights, powers, authorities, duties and functions conferred or imposed on the Commissioner by or under this Order.
- 8. An act or decision of a Commissioner is not invalid by reason only of a defect or irregularity in or in connection with the appointment of a Commissioner or that Commissioner, as the case may be.
- 9. No person shall be concerned to inquire whether any occasion had arisen requiring or authorising a person to act in the place of a Commissioner and all acts or things done or omitted to be done by the person, while so acting, shall be as valid and effectual and shall have the same consequence as if the acts or

things had been done or omitted to be done by the Commissioner.

- 10. Except as provided for in this Order, where provision is made in any Act, regulation, rule, by-law, local law, instrument or document
  - (a) for the Mayor, a councillor or the Chairperson or a member of a committee of the newly constituted Council or the former Council, to be a member of or to be represented on a board, council, committee, commission or other body, or to be a trustee, or to be a member or director of a company, that provision has effect during the period of administration as if it provided for a Commissioner or some other person appointed by the Commissioners to be that member, representative, trustee or director;
  - (b) for a Council to appoint a councillor to be the representative of the Council that provision has effect during the period of administration as if it provided for a Commissioner or some other person nominated by the Commissioners to be the representative; or
  - (c) for a member of a board, council, committee, commission or other body to be appointed from a panel of councillors of municipal councils, that provision has effect during the period of administration as if it provided for a Commissioner or some other person nominated by the Commissioners to be included in the panel.
- 11. Sections 71, 74 and 75 of the Act do not apply to a Commissioner.
- 12. A quorum for a meeting of Commissioners is two Commissioners.
- 13. Except as provided in this Order, the procedure for meetings of newly constituted Councils may be determined by the Commissioners.
