Notice of Amendment Amendment L94

The Shire of Cranbourne has prepared Amendment L94 to the Cranbourne Planning Scheme.

The amendment affects land on the north side of Cranbourne-Frankston Road, Langwarrin described as Lot 2 on LP 143872 and contained in Certificate of Title Volume 9619 Folio 239.

The amendment proposes to change the Planning Scheme by rezoning the land from Reserved Living to Restricted Business. The amendment will allow the land to be developed for shop purposes (including a convenience shop) as well as a petrol station, mechanical car

wash and a child care centre without the need for a planning permit provided plans that accord with a concept plan are approved to the satisfaction of the Responsible Authority.

Local Law No. 12 Environmental Local Law

Notice is hereby given that the Council at its meeting on 28 March 1994, made Local Law No. 12 for the purpose of amending Local Law No. 7 in the following manner:

- (a) Include the following Clause 2.4;
 - "No person shall undertake any building, engineering or other work which necessitates the employment of workers unless there are provided suitable sanitary conveniences for the use of the workers, to the satisfaction of the Council."
- (b) The existing Clause 2.4 becomes 2.5, re-numbered through to 2.15.
- (c) Modify Clause 2.6 (e) (v) by adding "at least 2 metres from", in place of "within 2 metres of", so that the Clause will read accordingly:
 - "2.6 (e) An incinerator shall be located:
 - (v) at least 2 metres from any material considered combustible."

- (d) Modify Clause 4.1 accordingly:
 - (a) delete "fowl" in the second line, to read:

"No person may keep any animal, bird or poultry other than a domestic animal, or songbird on any property unless such person has a permit."

(c) add "Part" in place of "clause" in the first line, to read:

"For the purpose of this Part, noises emanating from such animal, bird or poultry shall not be deemed to cause a nuisance to any person unless an objection in writing has been lodged with Council."

(d) add "portion" in place of "part" in the first line, to read:

"Any structure or any portion thereof for housing any animal, bird or poultry, shall not be erected or placed on any property unless a plan and specification is first submitted to and approved by the Council in writing."

- (e) Renumber Clause 4.3 to 4.3 (a).
- (f) Include the following Clause 4.3 (b):

"No person shall keep a cat which causes a nuisance or damage to any person, property or the environment."





which are shown by hatching on the plans herewith, are not reasonably required as roads for public use, be discontinued, subject to:



CITY OF WILLIAMSTOWN Road Closure


Whereas the Council of the City of Williamstown has done all those things required by section 528 (2) of the Local Government Act 1958 (as amended) to be done prior to the making of this resolution and has formed the opinion that the road hereinafter mentioned is not reasonably required as a road for public use.

Now the said Council of the City of Williamstown pursuant to the power given to it by section 528 (2) of the said Act hereby resolves and directs:

- (a) That the unnamed road running northsouth adjacent to 66 River Street, Newport and more particularly shown cross hatched on the attached plan whether or not a public highway (but not being a road set out on Crown Land) shall be discontinued.
- (b) That notwithstanding such discontinuance, Melbourne Water shall continue to have and possess the same right, title, power, authority or interest in or in relation to the whole of


