Stock Diseases Act 1968
DECLARATION OF A TUBERCULOSIS
IMPENDING FREE AREA

The Governor in Council, acting under section 4 of the **Stock Diseases Act 1968**, hereby—

1. Revokes the Order made on 15 December 1987 and published in the Government Gazette of 16 December 1987 declaring the State of Victoria to be an impending free area in respect of tuberculosis.

2. Declares the whole State of Victoria to be an impending free area in respect of tuberculosis in stock.

3. Specifies that the following shall apply within the said impending free area:

(a) the owner of any stock must—

(i) submit in accordance with any directions that may be issued by the Chief Inspector of Stock, any stock to a registered veterinary surgeon, Inspector of Stock or authorised officer of the Department of Agriculture for tuberculosis testing; and

(ii) provide adequate facilities and sufficient assistance to allow the safe and efficient handling of stock during testing procedures;

(b) the owner of any cattle or pigs;

(i) must make application to the Chief Inspector of Stock for, in the case of cattle, the allocation of a tag number or, in the case of pigs, a tattoo number which identifies the property on which the cattle or pigs are kept;

(ii) must not sell, or must not dispatch for sale at saleyards or for slaughter at an abattoir, any cattle or pigs unless—

the cattle carry a tail tag or ear tag of a type approved and manufactured by a manufacturer approved by the Chief Inspector of Stock which identifies the property on which the cattle are kept except that—

(A) all cattle with docked tails and calves less than 6 weeks of age not accompanying their dam must carry an ear tag of a type approved by the Chief Inspector of Stock which identifies the property on which the cattle are kept; and

(B) where the cattle are sold privately between an owner of an identified property to another owner of an identified property and the cattle are held on the new property for at least 30 days,

- the cattle need not carry an approved tail tag or ear tag;
- the pigs carry a tattoo of a type approved by the Chief Inspector of Stock which identifies the property on which the pigs are kept;
- (iii) must ensure that all tail and ear tags must carry a distinct numeric serial number between 0000 and 99999;
- (c) a person who purchases cattle or pigs and within a period of 7 days from the date of purchase sells the cattle or pigs or dispatches the cattle or pigs for sale at a saleyard or for slaughter at an abattoir must not remove the approved tags or tattoos carried by the cattle or pigs at the time of purchase;
- (d) a person who purchases—
- cattle and more than 7 days from the date of purchase sells the cattle or dispatches the cattle for sale at a saleyard or for slaughter at an abattoir must remove the approved tags carried by the cattle at the time of purchase and apply another approved tag identifying the cattle as being from the new property; and
 - pigs and more than 7 days from the date of purchase sells the pigs or dispatches the pigs for sale at a saleyard or for slaughter at an abattoir must apply another approved tattoo identifying the pigs as being from the new property;
- (e) a person must not transport cattle or pigs for sale at saleyards or for slaughter at an abattoir, unless the cattle or pigs transported carry an approved tag or tattoo;
- (f) a person must not sell cattle or pigs by auction or otherwise unless the cattle or pigs sold carry an approved tag or a tattoo;
- (g) a person who slaughters cattle or pigs at a premises licensed under the **Meat Industry Act 1993** must not slaughter any cattle or pigs unless—
- (i) the cattle or pigs carry an approved tag or tattoo; or
 - (ii) the senior meat inspector at the works has authorised the slaughter of any cattle or pigs not carrying an approved tag or tattoo, in which case the cattle or pigs must be handled in accordance with any directions issued by the Secretary of the Department of Agriculture;
 - (iii) the carcasses of cattle can be accurately identified by the approved tag(s) borne and the tattoos on the carcasses of pigs can be accurately identified until the carcasses of the cattle or pigs have passed all examinations and tests required to be carried out; and
 - (iv) samples from carcasses suspect of being infected with tuberculosis must be collected and dispatched to a laboratory approved by the Chief Inspector of Stock;
- (h) a person must not apply an approved tag to cattle or an approved tattoo to pigs unless the approved tag or tattoo identifies the property on which the cattle or pigs were kept for the preceding 7 days;
- (i) the owner of any cattle or pigs who ceases to keep cattle or pigs on any property identified by an approved tag or tattoo number, must immediately notify the Chief Inspector of Stock of that fact and must return to the Chief Inspector of Stock any unused tags previously issued to the owner.

CREDIT (CREDIT SOCIETY GENERAL

The Governor in Council under section 19 of the **Credit Act 1984** makes the following order.

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as "Credit (Credit Society General Exemptions) Order No. 2 (Variation of Order)".

Commencement

2. This Order takes effect on and from 26 May 1994.

Variation

3. Clause 10 of the Credit (Credit Society General Exemptions) Order No. 2 is hereby revoked and replaced by the following—

"Variation of Loan Contracts—Repayments

10. Section 70 (1) (d) of the **Credit Act 1984** does not have effect:

(1) In relation to a variation of the regulated loan contract where:

(a) The variation relates only to the amount and number of instalments;

- (b) The variation is made at the request of the debtor; and
 - (c) The Credit Society does not make a deferral or default charge; or
- (2) In relation to a variation of the regulated loan contract where:
- (a) the variation relates only to the date for payment of the first instalment (and each subsequent instalment as a result of that variation);
 - (b) the variation is made unilaterally by the credit provider as a consequence of a discrepancy between the "anticipated funding date" (calculated by reference to paragraphs 4 or 5 of the order) and the actual funding date; and
 - (c) the Credit Society does not make a default or deferral charge".

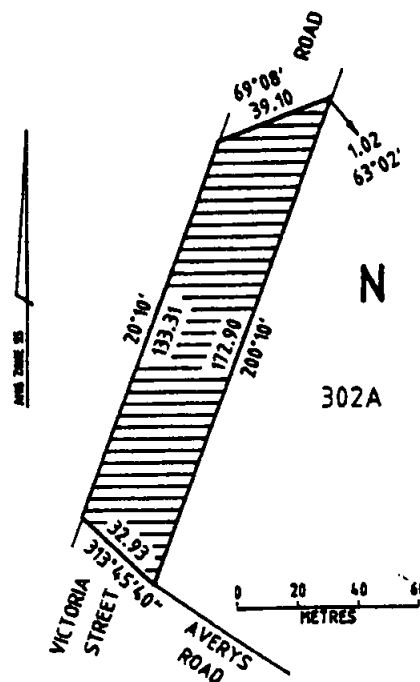
