



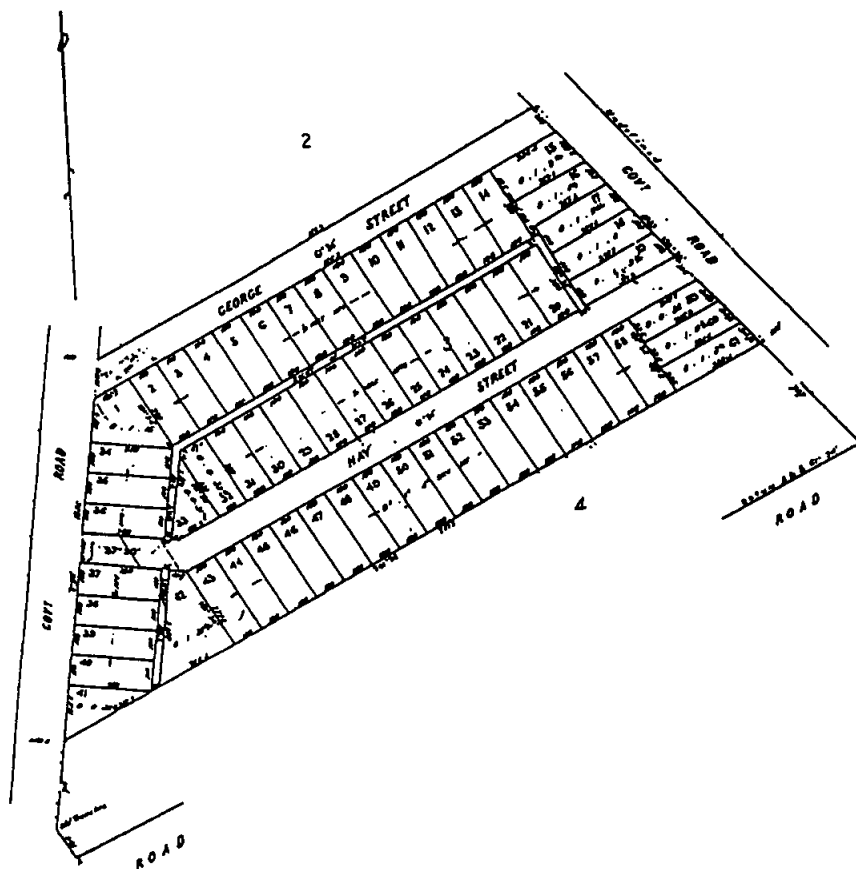

Comprehensive Local Law**

The Borough of Queenscliffe has drafted a local law to be known as the Comprehensive Local Law regulating all matters which the Council proposes to regulate by local law and repealing all prior local laws in force in the Borough of Queenscliffe. The Comprehensive Local Law is made for the purposes of:

- (1) providing for the peace, order and good government of the municipal district of the Borough of Queenscliffe;
- (2) providing for those matters which require a local law under the **Local Government Act 1989** and any other Act;
- (3) providing for the administration and exercise of Council powers and functions;

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- (4) prohibiting, regulating and controlling activities, events, practices and behaviour in places so that no nuisance is caused and there is no detriment to the amenity of the neighbourhood, to a person or to a person's property;
- (5) repealing prior by laws and local laws;
- (6) regulating permits and their administration and other matters relating to permits under the Local Law;
- (7) specifying when an offence has been committed, to prescribe penalties and procedures for Notices to Comply and Infringement Notices and to enable urgent action in certain circumstances;
- (8) regulating the use of the common seal and to prohibit unauthorised use of the common seal or any device resembling the common seal;
- (9) regulating the proceedings for the election of the Mayor and, if required, of a Deputy Mayor;
- (10) regulating the conduct of meetings of the Council and its committees;
- (11) protecting the amenity of the municipal district;
- (12) providing a safe and health environment in which residents may enjoy a quality of life that meets the expectations of the community;
- (13) controlling activities which may be dangerous or detrimental to persons and property;
- (14) regulating and controlling the keeping of animals, birds, bees and the like and the control of unwanted or stray animals;
- (15) providing a Pound for the impounding, keeping and disposal of animals not covered by the **Pounds Act 1958**;
- (16) providing for the containment and disposal of rubbish in order to maintain the municipal district in a clean and sanitary condition;
- (17) controlling the lighting of fires and the use of incinerators with a view to providing a safe and healthy environment;
- (18) protecting the health of the community and dealing with septic tanks;

- (19) enhancing the quality of air within Council buildings and to minimise pollution;
  - (20) controlling and preventing behaviour which is a nuisance or unpleasant for some persons;
  - (21) protecting and preventing damage to public land;
  - (22) allowing proper access by the public to public land and to facilitate enjoyment by the public without interference and to prevent unruly or boisterous behaviour on public land;
  - (23) regulating the consumption of and possession of liquor in open containers in public places;
  - (24) controlling activities and behaviour in shopping areas;
  - (25) controlling the use of roads and to provide for restriction on use in certain circumstances;
  - (26) providing for vehicular crossings;
  - (27) allowing for the removal of vehicles and boats;
  - (28) providing parking for the disabled and other matters in relation to roads and traffic;
  - (29) setting minimum siting and density requirements in relation to allotments of land and buildings; and
  - (30) providing requirements in excess of those specified in Table 11.6 of the Victoria Building Regulations 1983.
- In a way which is consistent with and in furtherance of the objectives specified in items (1) to (30) above the purport of the Local Law is:
- (a) In Part 1 to:
    - (i) regulate permits under the local law;
    - (ii) regulate matters relating to enforcement including notices to comply, infringement notices and penalties for offences;
    - (iii) repeal other local laws of the Borough;
  - (b) in Part 2 to regulate and provide for:
    - (i) the use and keeping of the common seal;
    - (ii) the election of Mayor of the Council;
    - (iii) meeting procedures including quorum, agenda and related matters;
  - (c) in Part 3 to prohibit, regulate and control the:
    - (i) storing of hazardous materials, rubbish and vermin and effecting works, lopping of trees near roads and plants on nature strips;
    - (ii) keeping of animals, birds and bees including providing for the impounding of unwanted cats and the destruction of feral cats;
    - (iii) providing for the impounding, sustenance, claiming and destruction of animals not subject to the provisions of the Pounds Act 1958;
    - (iv) regulating the manner of keeping and collecting domestic rubbish, recyclable materials, hard rubbish, trade waste and the use of the Council's transfer station and brush depot;
    - (v) regulating and prohibiting the use of fires and incinerators in certain circumstances;
    - (vi) prohibiting smoking in Council buildings;
  - (d) in Part 4 to provide for and regulate:
    - (i) the conduct of persons on public land and protecting Council facilities on public land including requiring dog excrement to be removed by the dog owner and regulating and prohibiting activity on Council's beaches and camping and caravan grounds;
    - (ii) the consumption of alcohol in public places;
  - (e) in Part 5 to:
    - (i) regulate conduct in shopping areas and provide for vehicular crossings, processions, ceremonies, and procedures for temporary road closures;
    - (ii) provide for the removal and sale of derelict and abandoned vehicles and boats;
    - (iii) regulate the activities of hawkers and pedlars in the municipal district;

- (iv) provide for and regulate parking on public land in the municipal district;
- (f) in Part 6 to provide to:
  - (i) adopt certain standards by way of siting requirements for dwellings under the provisions of the Victoria Building Regulations 1993.

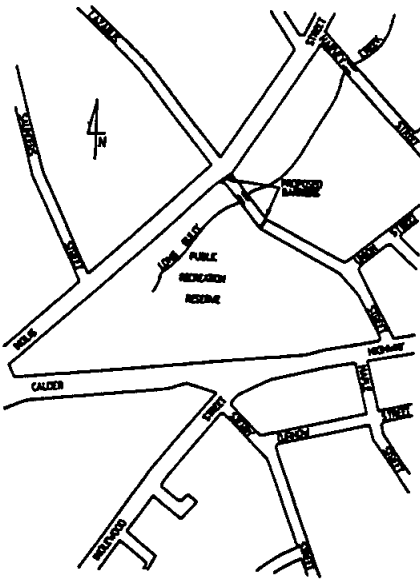

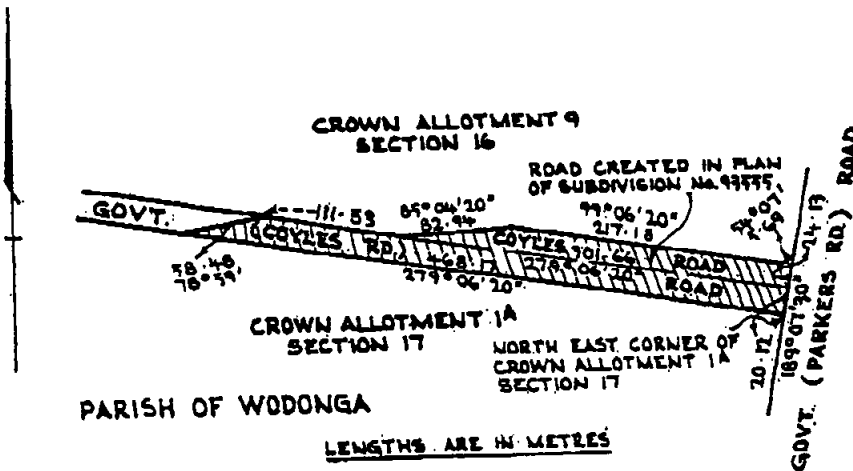

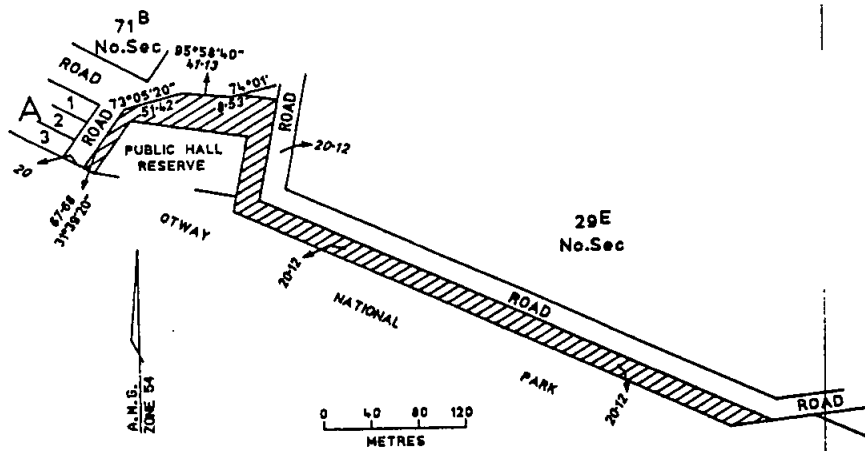

It is now proposed to alter the constitution of the Authority by increasing the number of members to 7 and to appoint Mr Nicholls as the additional member.

Section 8 (2) (a) of the Act allows the Governor in Council, by Order published in the



Government Gazette, to declare that the number of members of the board of a reorganising body is changed, and section 8 (3) provides for the Governor in Council to appoint members of the board of a reorganising body.

This Order therefore specifies that the number of members of the board of the Urban Land Authority be increased to 7 and provides for the appointment of Mr Nicholls as a member of the Authority.

- (d) is issued subject to the proviso that all stalls are to be cleared of stocks at the end of each days trading.

- (a) 19 December 1994—"entitlement date" for the purposes of Division 1 of Part 3 of the Act;
- (b) 27 January 1995—the date for the purposes of section 21 (2) of the Act which is the date on or before which the Electoral Commissioner must supply to the Chief Executive Officer a voters' list;
- (c) 10 February 1995—the date for the purposes of section 22 (2) which is the date on or before which the Chief Executive Officer must make a voters' list.

3. For the purposes of any poll which may be conducted as provided for under Part 10B of the Act, Chief Executive Officers and the Electoral Commissioner must prepare voters' lists in relation to the Councils set out in Schedule 1 on the basis of the dates fixed for municipal council elections in the Order made on 8 March 1994 entitled "Municipal Council Elections 1994 Fixing of Dates" and printed in the Government Gazette on 10 March 1994 and Chief Executive Officers must also certify the voters' rolls by 8 July 1994.

4. The Order in Council made on 16 March 1994 entitled "Altering the Boundaries of the North, East, West and Central Ridings of the Municipal District of Kowree" and printed in the Government Gazette on 17 March 1994 is altered as follows:

- (a) in clause 2 substitute "25 March 1995" for "6 August 1994";

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- (b) in clause 3 substitute "25 March 1995" for "6 August 1994".
