Extension to Waterway Management District**

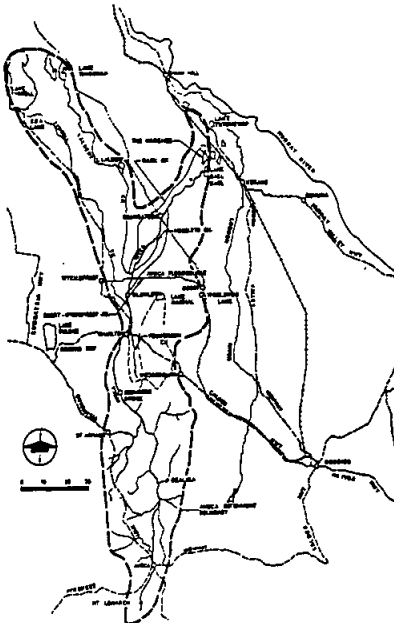
