This publication seeks to ensure that tertiary institutions work toward the enhancement of access to, and prospects of success in, University studies for members of each of the designated categories of disadvantage, including women. Accordingly, tertiary institutions have been asked to develop and implement strategies, which would aim to increase the number of women studying at the postgraduate level, including researchbased higher degrees.

Deakin University has reflected this in its 1994 Equity Plan submitted to DEET as part of the Educational Profile. A stated objective of the University is to increase the number of women engaged in research-based higher degree studies from 45% in 1994 to 49% of all postgraduate research students 1996. Female students currently comprise 62% of the total student population at the higher degree level. The Re-entry Scholarships and Fellowships were consequently developed as part of the University.

A similar program is available at the University whereby both males and females may apply for scholarships.


