





MURRAY VALLEY (VICTORIA) WINE GRAPE INDUSTRY MARKETING ORDER 1994

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Murray Valley (Victoria) Wine Grape Industry Marketing Order 1994.

Order made under the Agricultural Industry Development Act 1990

2. This Order is made under Part 2 of the Agricultural Industry Development Act 1990.

Purposes of Order

- 3. The purposes of this Order are-
- (a) to set up a Committee:
 - (i) to recommend prices to be paid by wineries to producers for wine grapes grown in the Victorian production area;
 - (ii) to analyse and report on the market outlook for the wine grape and wine industry; and
 - (iii) to fix the minimum terms of payment for wine grapes grown in the Victorian production area;
- (b) to provide for the Committee to be functionally set up as either—
 - (i) a single interstate Committee if New South Wales legislation provides for a similar organisation having similar functions in relation to the New South Wales production area of the Murray Valley, or

- (ii) an independent intra-state Committee having functions and powers that relate solely to the Victorian production area; and
- (c) to empower the Committee to liaise and meet with any other organisations that have similar purposes.

Definitions

4. In this Order:

"Act" means the Agricultural Industry Development Act 1990.

"Committee" means the Murray Valley Wine Grape Industry Negotiating Committee.

"Victorian production area" means the areas within the Cities of Mildura and Swan Hill and the Shires of Mildura, Swan Hill and Kerang in Victoria.

"New South Wales production area" means that area within the Local Government Areas of Wentworth, Balranald and Wakool.

"Producer" means a person, including a partnership, share farming agreement or company, who grows or produces wine grapes in the Victorian production area for delivery to wineries in either the current or preceding year, but excluding:

- (a) wineries;
- (b) non-profit institutions, charitable organisations and community groups;
 and
- (c) employees of producers.

"Recommended prices" are specific prices or price ranges which, in the Committee's collective judgment, are the best available forecast of prices that are likely to prevail for wine grapes in the Victorian and NSW production areas at an identified future time.

"Wine grapes" means any variety of grapes grown in the production area and used or intended to be used for processing into wine, must, juice or wine spirit.

"Wineries" means all wineries which accept wine grapes from producers in the production areas, for use in wine, must, juice or wine spirit production. For the purpose of this Order, the definition of wineries is inclusive of persons who purchase wine grapes from producers for resale to wineries.

Term of Order

5. This Order commences on the date of its publication in the Government Gazette and remains in force for four years from that date. It

is renewable for a further period not exceeding four years, subject to a poll in accordance with the Act.

Establishment of Committee

6. There shall be a "Murray Valley Wine Grape Industry Negotiating Committee."

Members

- 7. (a) (i) The Committee shall consist of either seven or fourteen members, depending on whether it is formed independently of, or jointly with, any Committee that may be established under New South Wales legislation and having similar functions to those of this Committee.
- (ii) The option to form a seven member intra-State Committee will be exercised only if there is no provision under New South Wales legislation for the formation of a jointly formed negotiating committee.
- (b) If the Committee is established as an independent intra-State Committee, it will comprise seven members appointed by the Minister, being—
 - three persons appointed from a panel of at least five persons nominated by the Victorian and Murray Valley Wine Grape Growers' Council or any other relevant body that in the opinion of the Minister has replaced that body;
 - (ii) three persons appointed from a panel of at least five persons nominated by wineries to whom wine grapes are supplied from the Victorian production area and whose nomination to the Minister is supported by the Winemakers Federation of Australia; and
 - (iii) an independent non-voting Chairperson who is an employee of the Department of Agriculture, Victoria.
- (c) If the Committee is established as a jointly formed Victorian/NSW Committee with responsibility for administering the relevant arrangement in both States, the Committee will consist of up to fourteen members appointed jointly by the Victorian Minister for Agriculture and the NSW Minister for Agriculture and Fisheries on the following basis—
 - six persons appointed from a panel of at least eight persons nominated by the Victorian and Murray Valley Wine

Grape Growers' Council or any other relevant body that in the opinion of the Ministers has replaced that body;

- (ii) six persons appointed from a panel of at least eight persons nominated by wineries to whom wine grapes are supplied from the production areas and whose nomination to the Ministers is supported by the Winemakers Federation of Australia;
- (iii) up to two independent non-voting persons, jointly appointed by the Victorian Minister for Agriculture and the NSW Minister for Agriculture and Fisheries, will share the responsibility for acting as Chairperson of the Committee.

Function to Analyse and Report on Market

- 8. (a) The Committee must prepare a report on the market outlook for the industry at least once in every year and must prepare such a report whenever a recommendation is made about prices or terms of payment.
- (b) The Committee must publish any report prepared on the market outlook and any recommended prices or terms of payment at the same time and in the same manner being in a newspaper or other publication which circulates throughout the production area.

Function to Recommend Prices

- 9. (a) The Committee may recommend prices for wine grapes delivered to a winery.
- (b) The Committee may recommend different prices for wine grapes according to the variety of wine grape.
- (c) The Committee may adjust a recommended price if it is of the opinion that it is appropriate to do so because of changed circumstances.

Function to Fix Terms of Payment

- 10. (a) The Committee may fix the minimum terms of payment by wineries for wine grapes.
- (b) The terms of payment fixed by the Committee may include—
 - (i) times of payment;
 - (ii) interest penalties for non-compliance with times of payment.
- (c) When fixing minimum terms of payment, the Committee may determine alternative arrangements with regard to the industry's needs on both a seasonal and longer term basis.

- 11. (a) If the Committee is unable to agree, the minimum terms of payment for the previous year will apply for the current year.
- (b) If the Committee is unable to agree in its first year, the minimum terms of payment last fixed by the Wine Grape Industry Negotiating Committee established under the Wine Grape Industry Development Order 1990 will apply.

Meetings

- 12. (a) The Committee must meet in a timely manner to enable it to determine recommended prices for wine grapes and to fix terms of payment prior to harvest and no later than 15 December.
- (b) A Special meeting of the Committee may be convened by notice in writing given to the Chairperson by all producer members or all processor members. Such notice must be given to all other members at least seven days before the proposed meeting.

Financial Year

13. The financial year of the Committee is the period from 1 July to 31 June.

Voting

14. (a) For the purposes of voting at a future poll on the renewal or remaking of this Marketing Order, a producer in the Victorian production area who delivered grapes to at least one winery in either the current or preceding year is eligible to vote.

Penalty for Contravening Order

15. A person who fails to comply with the terms of payment fixed by the Committee under the clause 10 and published under clause 8 contravenes this Order and is liable to a penalty not exceeding twenty penalty units. One penalty unit is currently \$100.


