### **ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS ACT 1983**

The Governor in Council makes the following Order:

### ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS ORDER (No. 143) 1995

- 1. This Order is called the Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 143) 1995.
- 2. This Order is made under the powers conferred by sections 3 and 4 of the Administrative Arrangements Act 1983 and under every other available power.
  - 3. This Order takes effect on and from 1 February 1995.
- 4. In respect of each item in Schedule 1 a reference to the Old Body in any provision of an Act specified in Column 2 or in any statutory or other instrument made under any provision of an Act specified in Column 2 shall be construed as a reference to the New Body.
  - 5. Where-
  - (a) before this Order takes effect a transaction happened in relation to an Old Body, then-
  - (b) this Order does not affect the validity or continuity of the transaction, and the transaction shall continue and may be completed in relation to the New Body in the same way as it would have been continued and may have been completed in relation to the Old Body if this Order has not been made.
- 6. (1) The amount of \$91 826 000 which was appropriated by the Appropriation (1994-95, No. 1) Act 1994 for recurrent services of the Department of Agriculture may, to the extent to which it has not been issued and applied, be issued and applied for recurrent services of the Department of Agriculture, Energy and Minerals carried out in the performance of the functions of the superseded Department of Agriculture.
- (2) The amount of \$27 337 600 which was appropriate by the Appropriation (1994-95, No. 1) Act 1994 for works and services of the Department of Agriculture may, to the extent to which it has not been issued and applied, be issued and applied for works and services of the Department of Agriculture, Energy and Minerals carried out in the performance of the functions of the superseded Department of Agriculture.
- 7. (1) The amount of \$26 998 900 which was appropriated by the Appropriation (1994-95, No. 1) Act 1994 for recurrent services of the Department of Energy and Minerals may, to the extent to which it has not been issued and applied, be issued and applied for recurrent services of the Department of Agriculture, Energy and Minerals carried out in the performance of the functions of the superseded Department of Energy and Minerals.
- (2) The amount of \$6 211 000 which was appropriated by the Appropriation (1994–95, No. 1) Act 1994 for works and services of the Department of Energy and Minerals may, to the extent to which it has not been issued and applied, be issued and applied for works and services of the Department of Agriculture, Energy and Minerals carried out in the performance of the functions of the superseded Department of Energy and Minerals.
  - 8. In this Order-
  - "The Act" means the Administrative Arrangements Act 1983.
  - "Body" means Minister, Department or Officer.
  - "Instrument" includes contract and agreement.
- "Old Body" and "New Body" means respectively the Bodies specified in Column 1 and Column 3 of each item in Schedule 1.
  - "Schedule" means Schedule to this Order.

# "Transaction" includes-

- (a) Agreement, bond, contract, deed or other consensual arrangement whatsoever;
- (b) Action, appeal, arbitration, prosecution and other legal proceeding whatsoever;
- (c) Assignment, charge, lease, mortgage, transfer or other dealing with property whatsoever;
- (d) Loan, guarantee, indemnity or other dealing with money whatsoever;
- (e) Approval, consent, delegation, direction, licence, Order, permit, requirement or other authority whatsoever;
- (f) Notice; and
- (g) Any other act, entitlement or liability in the law whatsoever.
