A Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS) was prepared and advertised, inviting public comment and submissions. The decision to make this regulation follows consideration of comment and submissions received in response to the RIS.

NOTICE OF DECISION
Proposed Water Industry Regulations 1995**

I, Charles Geoffrey Coleman, Minister for Natural Resources and Minister responsible for administering the **Water Industry Act 1994**, give notice under section 12 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994** that I have decided that the proposed Water Industry Regulations 1995, be made, with some minor amendments, as detailed below.

A regulatory impact statement (RIS) was prepared in relation to the proposed Regulations and was advertised inviting public comment and submissions. Eighteen submissions were received commenting on various issues. After considering these submissions, the following amendments have been made to the proposed Regulations—

- (a) Part 2 now more accurately identifies people who are entitled to apply for remissions of usage charges, simplifies the application procedure, and omits previous restrictions on refunds of a remission where payment of the full charge has been made;
- (b) Part 3 now omits certain responsibilities previously placed on owners and plumbers in relation to work of water supply, more clearly expresses the responsibilities of licensees and owners for maintenance of works relating to water supply, and removes the provision for licensees to authorise plumbing products;
- (c) Part 4 now recognises termination provisions in agreements made before the commencement of the Regulations; and
- (d) several other minor amendments have been made to clarify certain matters.
