SPECIAL

ORDER CONSTITUTING THE RURAL CITIES OF HORSHAM, MILDURA AND SWAN HILL, AND THE SHIRES OF BULOKE, GANNAWARRA, HINDMARSH, NORTHERN GRAMPIANS, WEST WIMMERA AND YARRIAMBIACK, AND ALTERING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICTS OF THE ARARAT RURAL CITY COUNCIL AND THE CAMPASPE, GLENELG, PYRENEES AND SOUTHERN GRAMPIANS SHIRE COUNCILS.

WHEREAS:

A. On 29 August 1994 the Minister for Local Government the Hon. Roger Hallam (the Minister) gave the Local Government Board (the Board) a reference to review and report on the area comprising the municipal districts of twenty-seven councils-Shire of Arapiles, Shire of Birchip, Shire of Charlton, Shire of Cohuna, Shire of Dimboola, Shire of Donald, Shire of Dunmunkle, Shire of Gordon, City of Horsham, Shire of Kaniva, Shire of Kara Kara, Shire of Karkarooc, Borough of Kerang, Shire of Kerang, Shire of Kowree, Shire of Lowan Shire of Mildura, City of Mildura, Town of St. Arnaud, Shire of Stawell, City of Stawell, City of Swan Hill, Shire of Swan Hill, Shire of Walpeup, Shire of Warracknabeal, Shire of Wimmera, and Shire of Wycheproof (the review).

B. As required by section 220M of the Act, the Local Government Board has submitted a final report on the review to the Minister.

C. As required by sections 220M and 220P of the Act, the Minister has considered the report and has recommended to the Governor in Council that an Order in Council be made in the following terms.

NOW THEREFORE, the Governor in Council acting under Part 10C of the Act ORDERS THAT:

PART 1—PRELIMINARY

Definitions
 In this Order—

"Act" means the Local Government Act

"adjacent area" means, in relation to a Council, an area which does not form part of the municipal district of the Council but which immediately before the commencement of this Order formed part of the municipal district of the former Council.

"appointed day" means the day on which this Order comes into operation.

"Commissioner" means a person appointed by the Governor in Council to administer a newly constituted Council.

"former Council" means in relation to-

- (a) the Buloke Shire Council, each of the former Shires of Birchip, Charlton, Donald and Wycheproof;
- (b) the Gannawarra Shire Council, each of the former Shires of Cohuna and Kerang and the former Borough of Kerang;
- (c) the Hindmarsh Shire Council, each of the former Shires of Dimboola and Lowan;
- (d) the Horsham Rural City Council, each of the former Shires of Arapiles and Wimmera and the former City of Horsham:
- (e) the Mildura Rural City Council, each of the former Shires of Mildura and Walpeup and the former City of Mildura:
- (f) the Northern Grampians Shire Council, each of the former Shires of Kara Kara and Stawell, the former City of Stawell and the former Town of St. Arnaud;
- (g) the Swan Hill Rural City Council, each of the former City of Swan Hill and the former Shire of Swan Hill;
- (h) the West Wimmera Shire Council, each of the former Shires of Kaniva and Kowree; and

 the Yarriambiack Shire Council, each of the former Shires of Dunmunkle, Karkarooc and Warracknabeal.

"neighbouring Council" means, in relation to another Council, a Council the municipal district of which an adjacent area in relation to that other Council forms part.

"newly constituted Council" means the Buloke Shire Council, the Gannawarra Shire Council, the Hindmarsh Shire Council, the Horsham Rural City Council, the Mildura Rural City Council, the Northern Grampians Shire Council, the Swan Hill Rural City Council, the West Wimmera Shire Council and the Yarriambiack Shire Council constituted under clause 3 (1) of this Order.

2. Commencement

This Order comes into operation on the day it is published in the Government Gazette.

PART 2—CONSTITUTION OF NEW COUNCILS

- 3. Constitution of New Councils
- (1) On the appointed day there is constituted—
 - (a) a body corporate constituted as a Shire Council by the name of the Buloke Shire Council;
 - (b) a body corporate constituted as a Shire Council by the name of the Gannawarra Shire Council;
 - (c) a body corporate constituted as a Shire Council by the name of the Hindmarsh Shire Council;
 - (d) a body corporate constituted as a Rural City Council by the name of the Horsham Rural City Council;
 - (e) a body corporate constituted as a Rural City Council by the name of the Mildura Rural City Council;
 - (f) a body corporate constituted as a Shire Council by the name of the Northern Grampians Shire Council;
 - (g) a body corporate constituted as a Rural City Council by the name of the Swan Hill Rural City Council;
 - (h) a body corporate constituted as a Shire Council by the name of the West Wimmera Shire Council; and
 - a body corporate constituted as a Shire Council by the name of the Yarriambiack Shire Council.

- (2) On the appointed day the following councils cease to exist—
 - (a) Shire of Arapiles;
 - (b) Shire of Birchip;
 - (c) Shire of Charlton;
 - (d) Shire of Cohuna:
 - (e) Shire of Dimboola;
 - (f) Shire of Donald;
 - (g) Shire of Dunmunkle;
 - (h) City of Horsham;
 - (i) Shire of Kaniva;
 - (j) Shire of Kara Kara;
 - (k) Shire of Karkarooc;
 - (l) Borough of Kerang;
 - (m) Shire of Kerang;
 - (n) Shire of Kowree;
 - (o) Shire of Lowan;
 - (p) City of Mildura;
 - (q) Shire of Mildura;
 - (r) Town of St. Arnaud;
 - (s) City of Stawell;
 - (t) Shire of Stawell;
 - (u) City of Swan Hill;
 - (v) Shire of Swan Hill;
 - (w) Shire of Walpeup;
 - (x) Shire of Warracknabeal;
 - (y) Shire of Wimmera; and(z) Shire of Wycheproof.
- (3) On the appointed day the persons holding office as Councillors of a Council specified in clause 3 (2) cease to hold such office.

4. Commissioners

- (1) The Chief Executive Officer of a newly constituted Council must call the first meeting of the Council to be held by the Commissioners which must be held within 3 days of the appointed day.
- (2) Section 89 (4) of the Act does not apply to the first meeting of a newly constituted Council.
- (3) The provisions of Schedule 1 apply to the Commissioners and meetings of the Commissioners.

PART 3 —RURAL CITY OF ARARAT

5. Changes to the Boundaries of the municipal district of the Ararat Rural City Council

On the appointed day the boundaries of the municipal district of the Ararat Rural City Council shall be fixed as described in Schedule

6. Transitional Provisions

- (1) Clause 46 of this Order applies to the Rural City of Ararat as if the Rural City of Ararat is a newly constituted Council and the adjacent area is the area severed from its municipal district and included in the municipal district of the Northern Grampians Shire Council by virtue of this Order.
- (2) Clause 49 of this Order applies to the Ararat Rural City Council as if the Ararat Rural City Council is a newly constituted Council.
- (3) Unless amended or revoked by an Order in Council or by the Ararat Rural City Council the local laws in force in the municipal district of the former Shire of Stawell immediately before the appointed day continue to apply in the relevant part of its municipal district for the period commencing on the appointed day and ending on 23 September 1995 as if the local laws had been made by the Ararat Rural City Council.
- (4) The Ararat Rural City Council shall be responsible for the enforcement of local laws within its municipal district and for continuing any proceedings for the enforcement of those local laws.

7. Savings Provision

Notwithstanding any reconstitution of the Ararat Rural City Council effected by this Part, the Ararat Rural City Council is deemed to be the same body on and after as before the appointed day and no act, matter or thing is in any way abated or affected by reason of any such reconstitution and any such act, matter or thing may be continued and concluded in all respects as if this Order had not been made.

PART 4 — SHIRE OF BULOKE

8. Boundaries of the municipal district of the Buloke Shire Council

On the appointed day the boundaries of the municipal district of the Buloke Shire Council shall be fixed as described in Schedule 3.

- Buloke Shire Council is Successor in Law On the appointed day—
 - (a) all property, rights and assets of the former Council are vested in the Buloke Shire Council;
 - (b) all liabilities of the former Council are liabilities of the Buloke Shire Council;
 - (c) the Buloke Shire Council is the successor in law of the former Council.

PART 5 —SHIRE OF CAMPASPE

10. Changes to the Boundaries of the municipal district of the Campaspe Shire Council

On the appointed day the boundaries of the municipal district of the Campaspe Shire Council shall be fixed as described in Schedule 4

11. Transitional Provisions

- (1) Clause 49 of this Order applies to the Campaspe Shire Council as if the Campaspe Shire Council is a newly constituted Council.
- (2) Unless amended or revoked by an Order in Council or by the Campaspe Shire Council the local laws in force in the municipal district of the former Shire of Cohuna immediately before the appointed day continue to apply in the relevant part of its municipal district for the period commencing on the appointed day and ending on 18 November 1995 as if the local laws had been made by the Campaspe Shire Council.
- (3) The Campaspe Shire Council shall be responsible for the enforcement of local laws within its municipal district and for continuing any proceedings for the enforcement of those local laws.

12. Savings Provision

Notwithstanding any reconstitution of the Campaspe Shire Council effected by this Part, the Campaspe Shire Council is deemed to be the same body on and after as before the appointed day and no act, matter or thing is in any way abated or affected by reason of any such reconstitution and any such act, matter or thing may be continued and concluded in all respects as if this Order had not been made.

PART 6—SHIRE OF GANNAWARRA

13. Boundaries of the municipal district of the Gannawarra Shire Council

On the appointed day the boundaries of the municipal district of the Gannawarra Shire Council shall be fixed as described in Schedule 5

14. Gannawarra Shire Council is Successor in Law

On the appointed day-

 (a) all property, rights and assets of the former Council are vested in the Gannawarra Shire Council; (c) the Gannawarra Shire Council is the successor in law of the former Council.

PART 7-SHIRE OF GLENELG

15. Changes to the Boundaries of the municipal district of the Glenelg Shire Council

On the appointed day the boundaries of the municipal district of the Glenelg Shire Council shall be fixed as described in Schedule 6.

16. Transitional Provision

Clause 46 of this Order applies to the Glenelg Shire Council as if the Glenelg Shire Council is a newly constituted Council and the adjacent area is the area severed from its municipal district and included in the municipal district of the West Wimmera Shire Council by virtue of this Order.

17. Savings Provision

Notwithstanding any reconstitution of the Glenelg Shire Council effected by this Part, the Glenelg Shire Council is deemed to be the same body on and after as before the appointed day and no act, matter or thing is in any way abated or affected by reason of any such reconstitution and any such act, matter or thing may be continued and concluded in all respects as if this Order had not been made.

PART 8—SHIRE OF HINDMARSH V

18. Boundaries of the municipal district of the Hindmarsh Shire Council

On the appointed day the boundaries of the municipal district of the Hindmarsh Shire Council shall be fixed as described in Schedule

19. Hindmarsh Shire Council is Successor in Law

On the appointed day-

- (a) all property, rights and assets of the former Council are vested in the Hindmarsh Shire Council;
- (b) all liabilities of the former Council are liabilities of the Hindmarsh Shire Council;
- (c) the Hindmarsh Shire Council is the successor in law of the former Council.

PART 9—RURAL CITY OF HORSHAM

20. Boundaries of the municipal district of the
Horsham Rural City Council

On the appointed day the boundaries of the municipal district of the Horsham Rural City Council shall be fixed as described in Schedule 8

21. Horsham Rural City Council is Successor in Law

On the appointed day-

- (a) all property, rights and assets of the former Council are vested in the Horsham Rural City Council;
- (b) all liabilities of the former Council are liabilities of the Horsham Rural City Council;
- (c) the Horsham Rural City Council is the successor in law of the former Council.

PART 10-RURAL CITY OF MILDURA

22. Boundaries of the municipal district of the Mildura Rural City Council

On the appointed day the boundaries of the municipal district of the Mildura Rural City Council shall be fixed as described in Schedule

23. Mildura Rural City Council is Successor in

On the appointed day-

- (a) all property, rights and assets of the former Council are vested in the Mildura Rural City Council;
- (b) all liabilities of the former Council are liabilities of the Mildura Rural City Council;
- (c) the Mildura Rural City Council is the successor in law of the former Council.

PART 11—SHIRE OF NORTHERN GRAMPIANS

24. Boundaries of the municipal district of the Northern Grampians Shire Council

On the appointed day the boundaries of the municipal district of the Northern Grampians Shire Council shall be fixed as described in Schedule 10.

25. Northern Grampians Shire Council is Successor in Law

On the appointed day-

 (a) all property, rights and assets of the former Council are vested in the Northern Grampians Shire Council;

- (b) all liabilities of the former Council are liabilities of the Northern Grampians Shire Council;
- (c) the Northern Grampians Shire Council is the successor in law of the former Council.

PART 12—SHIRE OF PYRENEES

26. Changes to the Boundaries of the municipal district of the Pyrenees Shire Council

On the appointed day the boundaries of the municipal district of the Pyrenees Shire Council shall be fixed as described in Schedule 11.

27. Transitional Provision

Clause 46 of this Order applies to the Pyrenees Shire Council as if the Pyrenees Shire Council is a newly constituted Council and the adjacent area is the area severed from its municipal district and included in the municipal district of the Northern Grampians Shire Council by virtue of this Order.

28. Savings Provision

Notwithstanding any reconstitution of the Pyrenees Shire Council effected by this Part, the Pyrenees Shire Council is deemed to be the same body on and after as before the appointed day and no act, matter or thing is in any way abated or affected by reason of any such reconstitution and any such act, matter or thing may be continued and concluded in all respects as if this Order had not been made.

PART 13—SHIRE OF SOUTHERN GRAMPIANS

29. Changes to the Boundaries of the municipal district of the Southern Grampians Shire Council

On the appointed day the boundaries of the municipal district of the Southern Grampians Shire Council shall be fixed as described in Schedule 12.

30. Transitional Provisions

- (1) Clause 49 of this Order applies to the Southern Grampians Shire Council as if the Southern Grampians Shire Council is a newly constituted Council.
- (2) Unless amended or revoked by an Order in Council or by the Southern Grampians Shire Council the local laws in force in the municipal district of the former Shire of Kowree immediately before the appointed day continue to apply in the relevant part of its municipal

district for the period commencing on the appointed day and ending on 23 September 1995 as if the local laws had been made by the Southern Grampians Shire Council.

(3) The Southern Grampians Shire Council shall be responsible for the enforcement of local laws within its municipal district and for continuing any proceedings for the enforcement of those local laws.

31. Savings Provision

Notwithstanding any reconstitution of the Southern Grampians Shire Council effected by this Part, the Southern Grampians Shire Council is deemed to be the same body on and after as before the appointed day and no act, matter or thing is in any way abated or affected by reason of any such reconstitution and any such act, matter or thing may be continued and concluded in all respects as if this Order had not been made.

PART 14—RURAL CITY OF SWAN HILL

32. Boundaries of the municipal district of the Swan Hill Rural City Council

On the appointed day the boundaries of the municipal district of the Swan Hill Rural City Council shall be fixed as described in Schedule 13

33. Swan Hill Rural City Council is Successor in Law

On the appointed day-

- (a) all property, rights and assets of the former Council are vested in the Swan Hill Rural City Council;
- (b) all liabilities of the former Council are liabilities of the Swan Hill Rural City Council:
- (c) the Swan Hill Rural City Council is the successor in law of the former Council.

PART 15-SHIRE OF WEST WIMMERA

34. Boundaries of the municipal district of the West Wimmera Shire Council

On the appointed day the boundaries of the municipal district of the West Wimmera Shire Council shall be fixed as described in Schedule 14.

35. West Wimmera Shire Council is Successor in Law

On the appointed day—

 (a) all property, rights and assets of the former Council are vested in the West Wimmera Shire Council;

- (b) all liabilities of the former Council are liabilities of the West Wimmera Shire Council:
- (c) the West Wimmera Shire Council is the successor in law of the former Council.

PART 16—SHIRE OF YARRIAMBIACK 36. Boundaries of the municipal district of the Yarriambiack Shire Council

On the appointed day the boundaries of the municipal district of the Yarriambiack Shire Council shall be fixed as described in Schedule 15.

37. Yarriambiack Shire Council is Successor in Law

On the appointed day-

- (a) all property, rights and assets of the former Council are vested in the Yarriambiack Shire Council;
- (b) all liabilities of the former Council are liabilities of the Yarriambiack Shire Council:
- (c) the Yarriambiack Shire Council is the successor in law of the former Council.

PART 17—GENERAL

38. Holding of the First Elections

- (1) The date for the first election of Councillors for a newly constituted Council is to be fixed by the Minister by a notice published in the Government Gazette.
- (2) For the purposes of holding the first election of Councillors, a newly constituted Council is deemed to have decided under section 35 of the Act to hold triennial elections and sub-sections (2) and (3) of that section do not apply in respect of that decision.
- (3) Except as provided by this clause, the provisions of Part 3 of the Act apply to and in respect of the first and subsequent elections.
- 39. First Meeting of the Councillors of a Newly Constituted Council
- (1) After the first election of Councillors for a newly constituted Council has been held, the Chief Executive Officer of the Council must call the first meeting of the Council which must be held within 10 days of the day on which the returning officer declares the result of the first election.
- (2) At 9 a.m. on the day on which the first meeting of the Council is held under sub-clause (1)—

- (a) the Commissioners go out of office; and
- (b) the Councillors elected at the first election of the Council assume office as Councillors of the Council.

40. Staff

On the appointed day all the members of staff of the former Council become members of staff of the newly constituted Council with the same terms and conditions as those with the former Council and with the benefit of all accrued rights.

41. Delegations—Transitional Provisions

- (1) With effect from the appointed day until revoked by the newly constituted Council all delegations made by the former Council or by the Chief Executive Officer of the former Council under the Act or any other Act remain in force
- (2) A newly constituted Council may, with the agreement of a neighbouring Council, delegate under section 98 of the Act a power, duty or function to a member of staff of that Council in respect of the period commencing on the appointed day and ending on 31 March 1995.
- 42. Valuations in Force—Transitional Provisions 1995–1996 & 1996–1997
- (1) A newly constituted Council may use valuations in force in relation to any rateable land in its municipal district immediately before the appointed day until 30 June 1996.
- (2) Despite anything to the contrary in the Valuation of Land Act 1960, a newly constituted Council must apply the same level of value date throughout its municipal district after 30 June 1996.

43. Systems of Valuation—Transitional Provisions 1995–1996 & 1996–1997

- (1) In respect of the 1995-1996 financial year a newly constituted Council may continue to use the system of valuation used by another council immediately before the appointed day in relation to that part of the municipal district of the newly constituted Council that was in the municipal district of that other council.
- (2) If different systems of valuation apply within the municipal district of a newly constituted Council, the newly constituted Council must determine to use a system of valuation which applies to the whole of its municipal district in respect of the 1996-1997 financial year.

- (3) If a newly constituted Council determines to change the system of valuation in respect of the 1995–1996 or the 1996–1997 financial year, section 157 of the Act does not apply to that determination.
- 44. Minimum Rates—Transitional Provisions 1995-1996

In respect of the 1995-1996 financial year a newly constituted Council may levy a minimum rate in accordance with sub-section 3 (2) of the Local Government (Consequential Provisions) Act 1989.

- 45. Differential Rates—Transitional Provisions 1995-1996 & 1996-1997
- (1) In respect of the 1996-1997 financial year a newly constituted Council may—
 - (a) raise any general rate by the application of a differential rate pursuant to section 161 of the Act regardless of the system of valuation it is using;
 - (b) apply a differential rate for a type or class of land according to its geographic location;
 - (c) declare a different service rate or different annual service charge pursuant to section 162 of the Act in different areas.
- (2) If a common system of valuation applies throughout the municipal district of a newly constituted Council, sub-clause (1) also applies in respect of the 1995–1996 financial year.
- 46. Adjacent Areas—Transitional Provisions
- (1) For the period commencing on the appointed day and ending on 31 March 1995, except as otherwise agreed between the relevant Councils or provided for in this Order, a newly constituted Council must provide the same services and perform the same functions in an adjacent area and in the same manner as if the area was in its municipal district and for that purpose any powers, duties and functions imposed or conferred by any Act on a neighbouring Council are deemed to be imposed by that Act on the newly constituted Council.
- (2) A newly constituted Council must be reimbursed by a neighbouring Council the cost of providing services and performing functions in the adjacent area.
- (3) A newly constituted Council must come to an agreement with a neighbouring Council on the apportionment, settlement, transfer,

adjustment or determination of any property, income, assets, liabilities, expenses, staff or other matters in relation to an adjacent area by 31 March 1995.

- 47. Local Laws-Transitional Provisions
- (1) On the appointed day any local law, or part of any local law, which deals with the meeting procedures or the common seal of a council which ceases to exist by virtue of clause 3 (2), is revoked.
- (2) Sections 5 (3) and 91 (1) of the Act do not apply in respect of the common seal and meetings of a newly constituted Council while the newly constituted Council is under the administration of Commissioners.
- (3) Unless amended or revoked by an Order in Council or by a newly constituted Council the local laws in force in the municipal district of the newly constituted Council immediately before the appointed day continue to apply in the relevant part of its municipal district for a period of 12 months from the appointed day as if the local laws were made by the newly constituted Council.
- (4) A newly constituted Council shall be responsible for the enforcement of local laws within its municipal district and for continuing any proceedings for the enforcement of those local laws.
- 48. Enforcement and Proceedings— Transitional Provisions
- (1) With effect from the appointed day until revoked by a newly constituted Council all authorisations made by the former Council under section 224 of the Act or any other Act remain in force.
- (2) Where, immediately before the appointed day, proceedings to which the former Council was a party were pending or existing in any court or tribunal, then, except as otherwise provided in this Order, a newly constituted Council, as the case may be, is substituted for the former Council as a party to the proceedings and has the same rights in the proceedings as the former Council had.
- 49. Planning Matters—Transitional Provisions
- (1) Except where a planning scheme specifies the Minister administering the Planning and Environment Act 1987 or any other person to be the responsible authority, a newly constituted Council is the responsible authority for the purposes of the Planning and

Environment Act 1987 in relation to the planning schemes in force in its municipal district.

- (2) Any reference in a planning scheme in force in the municipal district of a newly constituted Council to another council as a responsible authority for a particular purpose, is to be taken as a reference to the newly constituted Council in relation to the relevant part of its municipal district.
- (3) For the purposes of the Planning and Environment Act 1987 and the administration, amendment or enforcement of each of the planning schemes referred to in sub-clause (1)—
 - (a) anything of a continuing nature (including a contract, agreement or proceeding) done, commenced or made by or in relation to a council which ceases to exist by virtue of this Order may be done, enforced or completed by the newly constituted Council of the municipal district to which the matter relates;
 - (b) anything done by or in relation to a council which ceases to exist by virtue of this Order that concerns a matter of a continuing nature has effect as if done by the newly constituted Council of the municipal district to which the matter relates.

50. References-Transitional Provisions

From the appointed day, any reference in any instrument or any other document of any kind to the former Council is, except as otherwise provided in this Order, to be construed as a reference to a newly constituted Council unless the contrary intention appears.

51. Corporate Plan-Transitional Provisions

For the purpose of section 153A of the Act a newly constituted Council must prepare a three year corporate plan by a date set by the Minister.

- 52. Modified Reporting Requirements for the 1993-1994 Financial Year
- (1) If immediately before the appointed day the former Council had not prepared an annual report in respect of the 1993–1994 financial year, the newly constituted Council must prepare an annual report containing—
 - (a) a report of the operations of the former Council during the financial year; and

- (b) audited financial statements for the former Council for the financial year.
- (2) For the purposes of section 128 (1) of the Act, the financial statements for the former Council may be signed by two Commissioners of the newly constituted Council and a person designated by the Council as having relevant financial management responsibilities for that purpose and regulation 85 of the Local Government Regulations 1990 is modified accordingly.
- (3 Section 128(2) of the Act does not apply in respect of the financial statements for the former Council.
- 53. Modified Reporting Requirements for the 1994-1995 Financial Year
- (1) A newly constituted Council must prepare an annual report in respect of the 1994-1995 financial year containing—
 - (a) for the period commencing 1 October 1994 and ending on the day before the appointed day—
 - (i) a report of the operations of the former Council during that period;
 and
 - (ii) audited financial statements for the former Council for that period;
 - (b) for the period commencing on the appointed day and ending on 30 June 1995—
 - (i) a report of its operations during that period; and
 - (ii) audited financial statements for that period.
- (2) The provisions of the Act and the Local Government Regulations 1990 relating to the preparation and submission of annual reports, the preparation of reports of operations and the preparation, signing and audit of financial statements apply to a report prepared under sub-clause (1) with such modifications as are necessary, unless otherwise provided in this clause.
- (3) Clause 52 (2) applies to the financial statements prepared under sub-clause (1) (a).
- (4) The financial statements prepared under sub-clause (1) (b) must be prepared, to the extent it is reasonably practicable, in such manner and form as prescribed.
- (5) The auditor's report required to be attached to the financial statements prepared

COMMISSIONERS

under sub-clause (1)(b) by clause 9 of Schedule 8A of the Act may be signed by more than one auditor.

- (6) Except as provided in this clause, the requirements of section 126 of the Act do not apply to the newly constituted Council in respect of the 1994-1995 financial year.
- 54. Borrowings-Transitional Provisions

For the purpose of Part 7 of the Act until a new budget is made by a newly constituted Council any proposed borrowings included in a budget or revised budget of the former Council are deemed to have been included in a budget or revised budget made by the newly constituted Council.

55. Registrar of Titles

The Registrar of Titles, on being requested to do so and on delivery of any relevant certificates of title or instrument, must make any amendments in the Register that are necessary because of the operation of this Order.

- 56. Transitional Arrangements for Fire Prevention and Emergency Management
- (1) In this clause the reference to the first named former Council is a reference to the council the name of which appears first in the definition of "former Council" in clause 1 of this Order in relation to the newly constituted Council.
- (2) During the period commencing on the appointed day and ending on 31 January 1995, the person appointed under the Emergency Management Act 1986 by the first named former Council to be the municipal emergency resource officer for that Council is deemed to have been appointed by the newly constituted Council to be the municipal emergency resource officer for the newly constituted Council, unless that appointment is sooner revoked by the newly constituted Council.
- (3) During the period commencing on the appointed day and ending on 31 January 1995, the person appointed under the Country Fire Authority Act 1958 by the first named former Council to be the fire prevention officer for that Council is deemed to have been appointed by the newly constituted Council to be the fire prevention officer for the newly constituted Council, unless that appointment is sooner revoked by the newly constituted Council.

- 1. A Commissioner is entitled to receive—
 - (a) an annual remuneration;
 - (b) any travelling or subsistence allowances;
- (c) any other allowances in relation to expenses incurred in the discharge of his or her duties—

that the Minister may from time to time determine in respect of the Commissioner.

- Such remuneration, allowances and expenses are to be paid by the newly constituted Council.
- 3. A Commissioner must-
- (a) ensure that the operations of a newly constituted Council are carried out in the most efficient and economic manner possible;
- (b report to the Minister on such matters and at such intervals as the Minister may specify.
- 4. A Commissioner must exercise his or her powers and perform his or her functions subject to any written directions given by the Minister.
- 5. A Commissioner—
- (a) must not, without the consent of the Minister, while in office directly or indirectly engage in any paid employment outside the duties of his or her office;
- (b) may resign the office in writing signed by him or her and delivered to the Governor in Council:
- (c) may at any time be removed from office by the Governor in Council.
- 6. If a Commissioner—
- (a) becomes bankrupt or his or her property becomes in any manner subject to control under the law relating to bankruptcy;
- (b) is convicted of an indictable offence or of an offence which, if committed in Victoria, would be an indictable offence;
- (c) becomes incapable of performing the duties of office:
- (d) is removed from office or resigns the office: or
- (c) dies-

the office of a Commissioner becomes vacant.

7. During the absence from office or illness of a Commissioner, a person nominated by the Minister shall act in the place of the Commissioner and while so acting shall have, exercise and discharge all the responsibilities,

liabilities, rights, powers, authorities, duties and functions conferred or imposed on the Commissioner by or under this Order.

- 8. An act or decision of a Commissioner is not invalid by reason only of a defect or irregularity in or in connection with the appointment of a Commissioner or that Commissioner, as the case may be.
- 9. No person shall be concerned to inquire whether any occasion had arisen requiring or authorising a person to act in the place of a Commissioner and all acts or things done or omitted to be done by the person, while so acting, shall be as valid and effectual and shall have the same consequence as if the acts or things had been done or omitted to be done by the Commissioner.
- 10. Except as provided for in this Order, where provision is made in any Act, regulation, rule, by-law, local law, instrument or document
- (a) for the Mayor, a councillor or the Chairperson or a member of a committee of the newly constituted Council or the former Council, to be a member of or to be represented on a board, council, committee, commission or other body, or to be a trustee, or to be a member or director of a company, that provision has effect during the period of administration as if it provided for a Commissioner or some other person appointed by the Commissioners to be that member, representative, trustee or director;
- (b) for a Council to appoint a councillor to be the representative of the Council that provision has effect during the period of administration as if it provided for a Commissioner or some other person nominated by the Commissioners to be the representative; or
- (c) for a member of a board, council, committee, commission or other body to be appointed from a panel of councillors of municipal councils, that provision has effect during the period of administration as if it provided for a Commissioner or some other person nominated by the Commissioners to be included in the panel.
- 11. Sections 71, 74 and 75 of the Act do not apply to a Commissioner.
- 12. A quorum for a meeting of Commissioners is two Commissioners.
- 13. Except as provided in this Order, the procedure for meetings of newly constituted Councils may be determined by the Commissioners.

2. Commencement

This Order comes into operation on the day it is published in the Government Gazette.

3. Commissioners

- (1) The persons specified in column 1 of the Schedule are appointed to administer the Council specified in column 2 of the Schedule from the day this Order comes into operation until 9:00 a.m. on the day on which the first meeting of the Council specified in column 2 is held following the first election of councillors for the Council.
- (2) The person specified in column 3 of the Schedule is appointed the Chairperson of the Commissioners.

4. Chief Executive Officers

- (1) The person specified in column 4 of the Schedule is the person authorised to exercise the powers and perform the duties and functions conferred or imposed on Chief Executive Officers by any other Order, the Act and any other Act until revoked by the Council specified in column 2 of the Schedule.
- (2) Any authorisation given by a former Council under section 5 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 1993 has no effect.
