Building Act 1993

SECTION 6—APPOINTED DAY

I, Robert Maclellan, Minister for Planning, pursuant to section 6 of the Building Act 1993, appoint 14 June 1995 as the day on which the provisions of the Act relating to building practitioners shall apply to:

- (a) the Category of Builder—
- (i) Class 2—Demolition—single storey detached Class 1 and 10 buildings; and
 - (ii) Class 3—Demolition general; and
- (b) the Category of Supervisor (temporary structures)—

- (i) Class 1—Stages, tiered seating stands, equipment platforms or towers fabricated on site from metal tubes and fittings or other scaffolding components and other materials; and
- (ii) Class 2—Special structures—tents, marquees, safety barriers.

MINISTER'S GUIDELINE No. 95/02 Temporary Occupation of Buildings

Pursuant to section 188 (1) (c) of the Building Act 1993 I hereby issue the following Guideline concerning the functions of municipal building surveyors and private building surveyors in respect of section 64 of the Building Act 1993. Note that section 188 (7) provides that municipal building surveyors and private building surveyors must have regard to this Guideline in carrying out their functions.

Section 64 of the Building Act 1993 must not be used by a municipal building surveyor or a private building surveyor to permit the occupation of a building on a temporary basis where such occupation is to be an interim step to permanent occupation of the building under an occupancy permit for the same or similar use.
