Subordinate Legislation Act 1962 PROPOSED CORRECTIONS (POLICE GAOLS) REGULATIONS 1995 Regulatory Impact Statement

Notice is given that a Regulatory Impact Statement has been prepared in relation to the Corrections (Police (Gaols) Regulations 1995. The regulations are required to replace the Police Gaols Regulations 1993 which expire on 28 February 1995.

The objective of the proposed regulations is to remake with modifications the regulations providing for the management, administration and security of police gaols and for the safe custody and welfare of persons held in them.

The proposed regulations will establish requirements for the management of persons detained in a police gaol, provide police with specific powers to maintain order and good security and establish specific offences for persons who threaten the security, good order or management of a police gaol.

A Regulatory Impact Statement has been prepared which sets out the detail of the proposed regulations, including the anticipated impact on the community.

After considering possible alternatives to regulations the Regulatory Impact Statement concludes that the proposed regulations are the most effective means of achieving the objective.
