SPECIAL

Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 1988 GENERAL PERMIT FOR THE OPERATION OF B-DOUBLES

Regulation 724 of the Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 1988 authorises the Roads Corporation, by notice in the Victoria Government Gazette, to allow vehicles and loads which exceed mass or dimension limits prescribed in the Regulations to be used on roads.

Regulation 819 of the Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 1988 authorises the Roads Corporation to approve a person to use, or cause or permit to be used, on a road a motor vehicle which is towing more than one other vehicle.

Under the above two Regulations, I, Tony Fry, delegate of the Roads Corporation, approved the General Permit For The Operation Of B-doubles in the Victoria Gazette No. S59 on 26 June 1995, which allows B-doubles to be used on approved roads.

The following amendments are hereby made to the Victoria Gazette No. S59:

Clause 4. 1: Add to the list of excluded roads for B-double use:

Burke Road North in the City of Banyule;
Beech Forest Road between Beech Forest and Haines Junction.

Clause 4.1: Delete from to the list of excluded roads for B-double use:

Carlisle-Colac Road in the Shire of Colac-Otway.

Clause 4.2: Add the following undeclared roads that B-doubles may use:

Rural City of Ararat

Burn Street between Pyrenees Highway and Nott Road;

Nott Road between Burn Street and the abattoir.

City of Ballarat

Fussell Street between Victoria Street (Ballarat-Burrumbet Road) and Charlesworth Street;

Charlesworth Street between Fussell Street and Stawell Street.

Shire of Colac-Otway

Baillie Street Colac;
Bruce Street Colac between Forest Street and the railway line;
Douglas Street Colac;
Forest Street Colac between Parkinson Street and Wallace Street (Colac-Forrest Road);
Parkinson Street Colac between Baillie Street and Forest Street.

City of Greater Geelong

Avalon Road Lara between Princes Freeway and McClelland Avenue;
Beach Road Lara between Old Melbourne Road and Princes Freeway;
Gheringhap Street Geelong between Mercer Street and McKillop Street;
Heales Road Corio between Geelong-Bacchus Marsh Road and Forest Road;
McClelland Avenue Lara between Avalon Road and Old Melbourne Road;
Mercer Street Geelong;
Old Melbourne Road Lara between McClelland Avenue and Beach Road;
