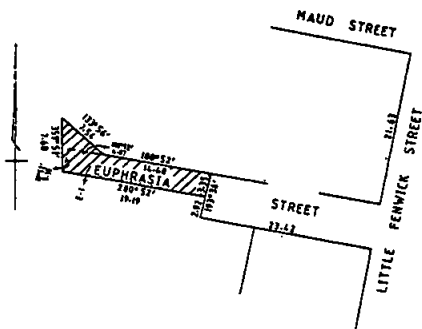

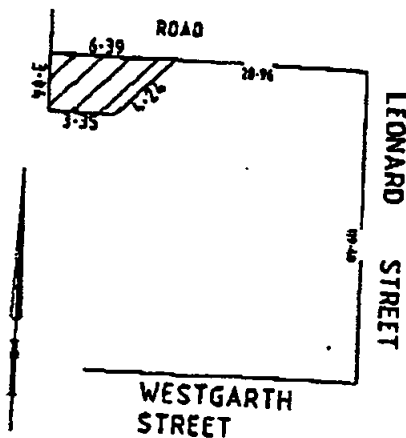

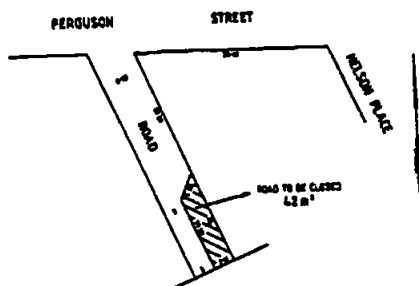

Title

1. This Notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Use of Floating Fish Traps) Prohibition Notice No. 3/1995.

Commencement

2. This Notice commences on 28 January 1995.

Objective

3. The objective of this Notice is to prohibit the commercial targetting of Yellowtail Kingfish (*Seriola lalandi*) by the use of floating fish traps in Victorian waters for the period commencing on 28 January 1995 and ending on 27 January 1996, except when a permit has been issued pursuant to section 45 of the Fisheries Act 1968.

Authorising Provision

4. This Notice is made under section 80 of the Fisheries Act 1968.

Prohibition on the Use of Floating Fish Traps

5. A person who holds a licence issued pursuant to Part 3 of the Fisheries Act 1968 must not use a floating fish trap to take Yellowtail Kingfish (*Seriola lalandi*) from Victorian waters for the period commencing on 28 January 1995 and ending on 27 January 1996.

(Amendment) Regulations

A Regulatory Impact Statement has been prepared in relation to the proposed Administrative Appeals Tribunal (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1995.

The major objective of the proposed regulations is to achieve a better allocation of public resources to the Tribunal by ensuring that those using the administrative and judicial resources of the newly created Land Valuation Division make an equitable contribution to the cost of provision of those services.

This is achieved by prescribing fees for applications to that division that are consistent with the usual fees in other divisions of the Tribunal. A lesser fee is established for certain rating valuation appeals. The statement discusses the implications that would flow from options of setting the fee at a higher level reflecting full cost recovery, or of not establishing a fee.

The regulations also increase existing AAT fees by the rate approved by the Treasurer reflecting CPI increases and remove several ambiguities in the existing regulations.
