  - (iv) the use of recreational vehicles and surfboards;
  - (v) advertising, bill posting;
  - (vi) circuses, carnivals and festivals;
  - (vii) animals, including animal numbers and the keeping and control of animals; and
  - (viii) disposal of waste, including behaviour associated with landfill sites and recycling on waste transfer stations:
- (f) to provide the peace, order and good government of the municipal district;
