- (f) to provide for the safe and efficient management and control of parking on roads in the municipal district;

Local Law No. 4—Environment

- (a) to provide a safe and healthy environment in which the residents of the municipal district enjoy a quality of life that meets the general expectations of the community;

- (b) to prohibit, regulate and control activities which may be dangerous or unsafe or detrimental to the quality of life in an environment of the municipal district;
- (c) to facilitate the provision of general public services, health and other community services, property services, recreational and cultural services, and other services in a way which enhances the environment and quality of life in the municipal district;
- (d) to control nuisances and noise, odour and smoke emissions, and other discharges to the environment which may adversely affect the enjoyment of life within the municipal district or the health, safety and welfare of persons within the municipal district; and
- (e) in a way which is consistent with, and in furtherance of, the objectives specified in paragraphs (a) and (d) of this clause to prohibit, regulate and control activities and circumstances associated with—
  - (i) fire hazards;
  - (ii) dangerous and unsightly land;
  - (iii) smoke emission, particularly emission from burning material and from chimneys;
  - (iv) the use of recreational vehicles and surfboards;
  - (v) advertising, bill posting;
  - (vi) circuses, carnivals and festivals;
  - (vii) animals, including animal numbers and the keeping and control of animals; and
  - (viii) disposal of waste, including behaviour associated with landfill sites and recycling on waste transfer stations;
- (f) to provide the peace, order and good government of the municipal district; and
- (g) to provide for the administration of the Council's powers and functions.
