# Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978 ORDER GIVING APPROVAL TO GRANT OF LEASE


Under sections 17D and 17DA of the Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978 I, Marie Tehan, Minister for Conservation and Land Management, being satisfied that there are special reasons which make granting a lease reasonable and appropriate in the particular circumstances and to do this will not be substantially detrimental to the use and enjoyment of any adjacent land reserved under the Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978, approve the granting of a lease for the purposes of a golf course by the Bayside City Council over the area of Elsternwick Park in the City of Bayside described in the Schedule below and, in accordance with section 17D(3)(a) of the Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978, state that-

- (a) there are special reasons which make granting the lease reasonable and appropriate in the particular circumstances; and
- (b) to do this will not be substantially detrimental to the use and enjoyment of any adjacent land reserved under the Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978.

#### **SCHEDULE**

The land shown on the following plan, having an area of approximately 13.13 hectares and being part of the land permanently reserved as a site for Public Park and Recreation by Orders in Council dated 12 November 1872, 21 November 1875, 9 October 1876 and 22 September 1880 and published in the Government Gazettes of 20 December 1872, 14 January 1876, 13 October 1876 and 24 September 1880.
