Electricity Industry Act 1993 EXEMPTION FROM REQUIREMENT TO OBTAIN A LICENCE Order in Council

The Governor in Council, under section 160 of the Electricity Industry Act 1993 (the "Act"), exempts the Walhalla General Store (the "Retailer") from the requirement to obtain a licence under section 159 of the Act in respect of the supply and sale of electricity to the Walhalla Post Office.

This Order is subject to the following terms, conditions and limitations:

- (a) The exemption contained in this Order commences on the date of the Order;
- b) The Retailer must undertake the exempt activity on either a cost

- recovery or a zero-cost basis, and not supply electricity to persons other than the Walhalla Post Office;
- (c) The Retailer must carry out any power supply modifications or extension works must be carried out by a registered electrical contractor in accordance with the State Electricity Commission Wiring Regulations 1992;
- (d) The installation must satisfy the applicable sections of the Electricity Supply and Construction Regulations 1988 apply to the construction of any electrical works;
- (e) The installation must meet the requirements of AS 3010.1: Electrical Installations—Supply by Generating Sets;
- (f) The location of any underground cable(s) must be marked on the relevant sub-division plans and these plans must be located adjacent to the main switchboard for each installation; and,
- (g) A notice of completion of any new work must be submitted to the Office of the Chief Electrical Inspector.
