Water Act 1989

I, Charles Geoffrey Coleman, as Minister administering the **Water Act 1989**, make the following Order:

TRANSFER OF WORKS TO THE CENTRAL HIGHLANDS REGION WATER AUTHORITY ORDER 1996

Citation

1. This Order is called the Transfer of Works to the Central Highlands Region Water Authority Order 1996.

Enabling powers

2. This Order is made under the powers conferred by Division 2 of Part 6 of the **Water Act 1989** and all other available powers.

Date of Effect

3. This Order takes effect from the date it is published in the Government Gazette.

Definitions

4. In this Order:

"Act" means the **Water Act 1989**.

"Authority" means the Central Highlands Region Water Authority.

Appointment of Central Highlands Region Water Authority

5. On and from the date on which this Order takes effect all the works used by the City of Ballarat in performing its functions and exercising its powers under the **Local Government Act 1989** in respect of the Cardigan Village Sewerage system are transferred to the Authority.

Pre-requisites for Making This Order

6. (a) This is an Order referred to in Section 98 (3) (a) of the Act;
- (b) Under Section 98 (4) (a) of the Act I have agreed to the terms and conditions for the transfer made by this Order, with the Authority and the City of Ballarat;

(c) Under Section 100 (2) (a) of the Act, the affected Authority and the City of Ballarat have applied to me for the Order to be made;

(d) Under Section 100 (2) (b) of the Act I have consulted with the Minister administering the **Local Government Act 1989** as a Council is affected; and

(e) Under Section 98 (4) (b) of the Act, I am satisfied that appropriate provisions have been made in relation to the disposition of the works, the rights and liabilities of the City of Ballarat and the manner of repayment of any money borrowed in respect of the works.

Electricity Industry Act 1993 NOTICE RELATING TO THE BUILDING ACT 1993

The Commissioner of the Building Control Commission under the **Building Act 1993** has determined pursuant to section 84AC of the **Electricity Industry Act 1993** that any building, or building work on land owned by Yallourn Energy Ltd ("Yallourn"), which is a generation company under the Electricity Industry Act, is exempt from the provisions of the Building Act and all regulations made under that Act. This determination applies to all buildings or building work on land owned by Yallourn that has commenced or has been completed on or prior to 10 April 1996 but does not apply to any buildings or building work that commences after 10 April 1996.

Title

1. This Notice may be cited as the Fisheries
(Scallop—Ocean Fishery) (Close Season)
Notice No. 2/1996.

Objectives

2. The objective of this Notice is to fix the
close season for the taking of scallops from all
Victorian waters other than Port Phillip Bay.

Commencement

3. This Notice comes into operation on 1
March 1996.

Authorising provision

4. This Notice is made under section 80 of
the **Fisheries Act 1968**.

Close season

5. A person must not use a dredge for taking
scallops from Victorian waters other than Port
Phillip Bay during the period commencing on 1
March 1996 and ending on 31 March 1996.

Penalty

6. Any person who contravenes this Notice is
liable to a penalty of 20 penalty units

Title

1. This Notice may be cited as the Fisheries
(Scallop Ocean Fishery) Notice No. 3/1996.

Objectives

2. The objectives of this Notice are to fix an
open season and a catch rate limit (bag limit) for
the taking of scallops from Victorian Waters
other than Port Phillip Bay.

Commencement

3. This Notice comes into operation on 1
April 1996.

Authorising provision

4. This Notice is made under section 80 of
the **Fisheries Act 1968**.

Definitions

5. "Act" means the **Fisheries Act 1968**;
"crate" has the same meaning as in the
Fisheries (Scallop) Regulations 1995;
"sack" has the same meaning as in the
Fisheries (Scallop) Regulations 1995.

Period when fishing is permitted

6. The holder of a scallop licence or a master
fisherman operating a registered fishing boat for
which an appropriately endorsed scallop licence
has been issued under the Act may dredge for or
take scallops from Victorian waters other than
Port Phillip Bay during the period commencing
on 1 April 1996 and ending on 14 April 1996.

Catch rate limit (bag limit)

7. (1) The holder of a scallop licence or a
master fisherman operating a registered
fishing boat for which an appropriately
endorsed scallop licence has been
issued under the Act must not—

(a) take from that boat from Victorian
waters other than Port Phillip Bay;
or

(b) have on board that boat in or upon
Victorian waters other than Port
Phillip Bay—

more than the fortnightly catch rate limit (bag
limit) of scallops specified in sub-clause (2).

(2) For the purposes of sub-clause (1) the
fortnightly catch rate limit (bag limit)
for the taking of scallops is—

(a) 20 crates of scallops per fortnight;
or

(b) 53 sacks of scallops per fortnight.

Penalty

8. Any person who contravenes this Notice is liable to a penalty of 20 penalty units.

Objectives

2. The objective of this Notice is to fix the close season for the taking of scallops from all Victorian waters other than Port Phillip Bay.

Commencement

3. This Notice comes into operation on 15 April 1996.

Authorising provision

4. This Notice is made under section 80 of the **Fisheries Act 1968**.

Close season

5. A person must not use a dredge for taking scallops from Victorian waters other than Port Phillip Bay during the period commencing on 15 April 1996 and ending on 1 June 1996.

Penalty

6. Any person who contravenes this Notice is liable to a penalty of 20 penalty units.

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
