Notice of Amendment to a Planning Scheme Amendment L90

The Wyndham City Council has prepared Amendment L90 to the Werribee Planning Scheme

The amendment proposes the inclusion of Overlay Controls into the Planning Scheme for three (3) Concept Plan Areas for Wyndham's major growth fronts, providing direction and guidance for future urban development, In addition, changes to the Werribee Urban Development Zone are proposed to recognise the Concept Plans with regard to the preparation of detailed Development Plans under the zone.

Planning and Environment Act 1987 KINGSTON PLANNING SCHEME Notice of Approval of Amendment

Amendment L6

The Minister for Planning and Local Government has approved Amendment L6 to the Kingston Planning Scheme.

The amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the Government Gazette.

The amendment introduces a site specific provision into the Local Section to allow land at the north-east corner of Thompson Road and Inner Harbour Drive, Patterson Lakes, to be developed and used for the purposes of a petrol

station and associated convenience shop and a manual car/boat wash facility. The development must be in accordance with a Development Plan prepared to the satisfaction of the responsible authority and associated requirements imposed by the responsible authority.

Planning and Environment Act 1987 MELBOURNE PLANNING SCHEME Notice of Approval of Amendment Amendment L199

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment L199 to the Melbourne Planning Scheme.

The amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the Government Gazette.

The amendment replaces Amendment L192 which provides for use and development of land at 33-61 Cathedral Place, 68-100 St Andrews Place and 14-20 Parliament Place, East Melbourne with a new Amendment L199 which includes all use and development approved under Amendment L192 but also incorporates removal of two restrictive covenants applicable to the Cathedral Place frontage of the development site. The use and development approved includes an international standard boutique hotel, car parking and accommodation for patients and carers of patients and other uses ancillary to the Peter MacCallum Cancer Institute.
