Notice of Approval of Amendment
Amendment S42

The Minister for Planning and Local Government has prepared and approved the above amendment.

The amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the Government Gazette.

The amendment was requested by the former Minister for Energy and Minerals and ensures that planning schemes are consistent with the coming into operation of the **Extractive Industries Development Act 1995** on 1 June 1996.

The amendment inserts planning policy for extractive industry, inserts a number of referral authorities for extractive industry applications, incorporates a document relating to extractive industry interest areas in the Melbourne Supply Area and makes other provisions relating to extractive industry.

The Minister for Planning and Local Government has prepared and approved the above amendment.

The amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the Government Gazette.

The amendment alters the list, in Clause 8-4.4 of the State Section of all planning schemes in Victoria, of shopping complexes in which a gaming venue is prohibited. It:

- * Includes 3 additional shopping complexes in the list.
- * Alters the land description of 4 specified shopping complexes in the list to exclude land occupied by hotels. The hotels are quite separate, in building, ownership and land tenure terms, from the shopping complex.
- * Makes technical corrections to the land descriptions of a number of the shopping complexes in the list.

The amendment seeks to insert a new specific sub-clause (103A-5) to the Dandenong Planning Scheme, affected land at 39-41 Pultney Street, Dandenong, which allows a

permit to be granted for the use and development of the land for the purpose of a hotel/motel.

The Minister for Planning and Local Government has approved Amendment L111 to the Knox Planning Scheme.

The amendment rezones the former Boronia School Support Centre, located in Dorset Road, approximately 50 metres south of William Street, and adjacent to the Boronia Railway Station, from Public Purpose S (Primary School) to part Knox Office zone, and part Knox Commercial zone.
