## BLF (De-recognition) Act 1985 APPOINTMENT OF NEW CUSTODIAN AND EXTENSION OF PREVIOUS ORDERS

The Governor in Council, having been advised that Ian Gordon Sharp (the Custodian appointed by the Order dated 13 October 1987) died on 26 July 1996, orders under section 7 of the **BLF (De-recognition) Act 1985** and all other available powers that—

- possession, custody and control of the funds and property of BLF is committed to Stephen George Alley (in this Order called “the new Custodian”); and
- the new Custodian is given the same functions and powers as were exercised or held by Ian Gordon Sharp immediately prior to his death on 26 July 1996; and
