- the applicant believes that if men are included this would stifle their expression and their true feelings and that for some women this could be embarrassing and certainly some women of non English speaking background will not be able to attend or share the problems that they face.

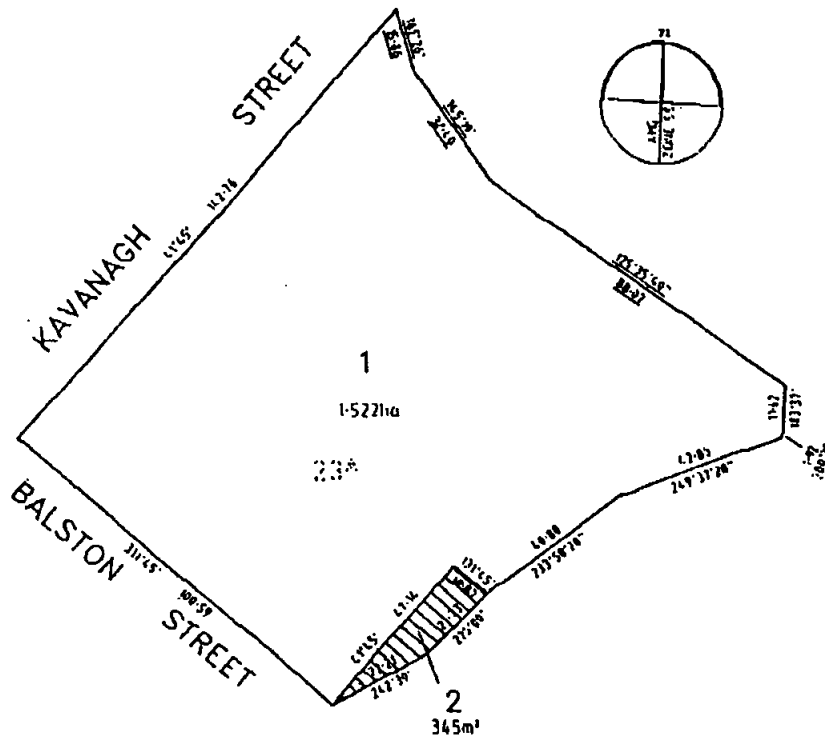

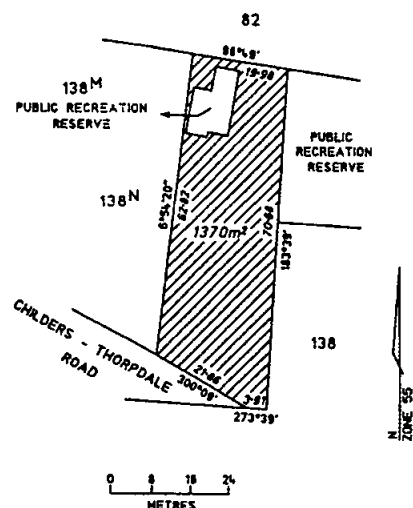

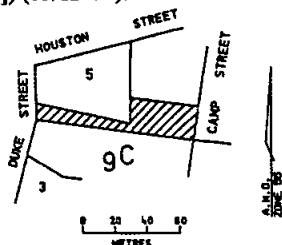
